

### **SENATE CORNER October 5 is National Teachers' Dav Pia: Raising teachers'** pay to affirm dignity of teaching profession

Senator Pia S. Cayetano today said raising the compensation of teachers is the best affirmation of government's high regard for the country's educators and their contributions to nation-building

The senator issued the statement in time for National Teachers' Day, which is being observed on October 5 (Saturdav)

A staunch education advocate, Cayetano authored Senate Bill No. 70, or the 'Additional Support and Compensation for Educators in Basic Education Act.'

The measure proposes a salary increase of P10,000 per month for public school teachers, locally-funded teachers, and non-teaching personnel of the Department of Education (DepEd).

The salary hike shall be granted over three years in three tranches, starting with a P4,000 monthly pay hike on the first year, an additional P3,000 per month on the second year, and a final increment of P3,000 per month on the third year.

The bill is currently being deliberated with similar measures by a technical working group under the Senate Committee on Civil Service, Government Reorganization and Professional Regulation.

"Raising the compensation of teachers affirms the dignity of the teaching profession. This will not only improve their lives, but also inspire them to further improve," she explained.

"We have so many hardworking teachers who deserve more support. Also, we can still do better to make the teaching profession more attractive to the best and brightest," she stressed.

"I want to be able to leave that kind of legacy to our children - that they can go to any school in the Philippines, and get the best education possible because they will be mentored by intelligent and dedicated teachers," she added.

Cayetano pointed out that empowering teachers to successfully fulfill their role in society is part of the country's commitments to the United Nations' Sustainable Development Turn topage 3

## Exhibit revisits Cavite town's early 20th century livelihood

KAWIT, Cavite -- The historical town of Kawit may be synonymous to General Emilio Aguinaldo's declaration of Philippine independence in 1898 and his iconic abode, which now turned into a shrine and museum in his honor. Aside from this, the town is also known for its leading livelihood activities in the early 20th century.

This is the highlight of the National Historical Commission of the Philippines' (NHCP) free exhibit, dubbed "KA(la)WIT: Baldomero and the Livelihood of early 20th century Kawit" at the Museo ni Baldomero Aguinaldo (MBA) in Binakayan village which opened here on Friday.

"The exhibit aims to inform the present generation and the public not just about the town's origin but its livelihood activities back at the era when it was still considered a predominantly agricultural town," MBA curator Ahzel Miral said.

From Ka(la)wit to Kawit

Founded in the 16th century, what is now known as a first-class municipality is considered one of Cavite's oldest towns

It was popularly referred to as Cavite el Viejo (Old Cavite) during the Spanish era, where its name was derived from the word "kalawit" or hook, "in reference to the small hooked-shaped peninsula jutting out to Manila Bay from Cavite," Miral said.

Limketkai\_Atrium Even as the standards of quality and the way people learn have transformed in the 21st century, Briones emphasized that "the battle for quality basic education will be fought and won in our classrooms, by our teachers. Ultimately, it is in the class-rooms where the day-to-day learning of our students happen."

The Secretary further emphasized that expectations for learning outcomes are no longer confined to reading, writing, and counting. With myriad types and sources of information available to learners, they should now be able to read, comprehend, an-alyze, process, and integrate from multiple sources – whether

digital or in print. "This is what the 21st century skills in the K to 12 curriculum are all about. It is not enough for learners to have mastery of concepts ad subject matter. They also need to have digital iteracy, and have the skills for problem solving and critical thinking," she remarked. Battle vs low education quality

As the Department pivots from improving access to enhancing the quality of education, the Secretary reported the low proficiency levels attained by Grade 6, 10, and 12 learners in all subject areas and 21st century skills in the latest Nation-al Achievement Test (NAT). Low proficiency means learners, on average, were able to correctly answer between three and five

questions for every 10 questions in NAT. The Education chief added that the Department already anticipates the said result to be confirmed by the Program for International Student Assessment (PISA) by the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD), which the country joined for the first time in 2018.

According to her, the challenge is for teachers to think of innovative ways of teaching. ## 5 die in Quezon road mishap ByGemi Formaran

GUMACA, QUEZON- Six persons died after the vehicle they were riding in collided with a speeding truck along Maharlika Highway, Bgy. Bamban, here.Town police commander, Major Rodelio Calawit identified the fatalities as Jimmy, 42, Razel and JM, all surnnamed Bron and residents of Makati City, Francisco Butardo and Emmanuel Sagrit, both of Antipolo City, Rizal.

Calawit said those who suffered injuries were sisters Fritcie Joyce, Fatima, and Edna, all surnamed Butardo, and residents of Antipolo City and Ulpiano Clores of Camarines Sur.

He said the incident transpired at 5:45 a.m. while the victims were aboard a Tamaraw FX driven by Jimmy on their way to Manila.

Calawit said initial investigation showed that the vehicle partially occupied the left lane of the highway while a Bicol-bound Isuzu truck loaded with cows and driven by Gerome Villar, 40, of Tarlac City was fast approaching from the opposite direction.

"At that point, both vehicles accidentally collided head on", said Calawit over the phone.

On impact, he said Emmanuel and JM died on the spot while Jimmy, Francisco and Razel died on arrival at Gumaca District Hospital by responding policemen.

Of the four injured, he said Clores sustained severe injuries and is now in critical condition.

Calawit said Jimmy reportedly fell asleep while driving.

The truck driver was detained and will be charged with reckless imprudence resulting multiple homicide and physical injury.

Sinabi ni Marcos na dapat imbestigahan ng Department of Energy (DOE) ang malalaking kompanya ng LPG at alamin kung ano ang naging batayan ng mga ito sa ginawang napakalaking increase sa halaga ng LPG.

"Huwag nilang idahilan ang pagbomba sa mga oil facility sa Saudi Arabia dahil sa malinaw na humupa na ang tensyon sa Middle East. Maawa naman sila sa mga maliliit na mamimili. Tumaas na nga ang presyo ng mga bilihin, ngayon LPG naman, ano ba yan!" pahayag ni Marcos.

Idinagdag pa ni Marcos na delikado ring gamitin ang ilang tangke ng LPG na ipinagbibili sa merkado dahil sa bulok at mahinang klase ang mga ito na kalimitan ay pinipinturahan na lamang para magmukhang bago.

"Kung minsan kulang din ang timbang ng LPG na ipinagbibili... dapat kasi 11 kilos, pero pag tinimbang mo... aabot lang sa 9 kilos o 10 kilos," pagbubunyag ni Marcos.
