

LGU Imus' Project Punla strengthens city's agricultural sector

IMUS, Cavite (PIA) -- The City Government here together with the City Agriculture Services Office takes pride in its agriculture program 'Project Punla' that was recognized recently and supported by the Department of Agriculture (DA).

Mayor Manny Maliksi said, "Project Punla was conceptualized to strengthen the agricultural sector, to help the farmers affected during the pandemic, to bring back the people's

interest in farming, and to give priority to till the idle lands in the city."

According to Vice Mayor Ony Cantimbuhan, the program has three plans: the short term is focused on the city's rice and vegetable farmers; the mid-term for those en-

gaged in backyard gardening, and the long term is the utilization of large idle lands in the city for organic farming.

The short term plan involves the purchase of all the farm produce of the rice and vegetable farmers particularly the fresh vegetables which in

turn will be distributed as relief packs to COVID-19 positive patients of the city.

The mid-term plan is the promotion of backyard gardening or urban farming to residents during the pandemic that somehow contributed to

18 Cavite LCEs commit to more than P30M budget for local TB enactment



TRECE MARTIRES CITY, Cavite (PIA) -- Eighteen local chief executives in the province recently participated and completed the USAID's TB Platforms Project Usapang Dibdiban Online Forum (one-on-one session) for a comprehensive analysis on the TB-related activities and the corresponding budget required to have a strength-

ened TB response during COVID-19.

With support from the Department of Interior and Local Government Unit (DILG), the mayors from the cities of General Trias, Dasmariñas, Bacoor, Imus, Tagaytay, and Trece Martires and the municipalities of Tanza, Maragondon, Amadeo, General Emilio Aguinaldo, Naic, Magallanes, Kawit, Carmona,

Alfonso, Mendez, General Mariano Alvarez, and Silang initially committed a total of P30M as counterpart budget to the Philippine government's allocation for TB for the year 2021 and welcomed the technical assistance packages proposed by USAID's TB Platforms which include strengthening of local TB response amid COVID-19 thru technical support in drafting or

amending the TB ordinance, capacity building on the preparation of TB classified cost elimination plan, orientation on the implementation of FAST strategy in health facilities, conduct of community TB screening and implementation of TB in workplace settings.

Sinabi ni DILG Undersecretary at Spokesperson Jonathan Malaya na ang Stay Safe.ph system na pinangungunahan ng pamayanan, pinagrereportan ng kalagayang pangakalusugan at nagsusulong ng social distancing ay lalong pinagbuti ng National Task Force COVID 19 at nananatiling nag-iisang aprubadong national digital contract tracing system ng IATF MEID.

Binuo sa pamamagitan ng pakikipagtulungan ng Inter-Agency Task Force at MultiSys Technology Corporation (MultiSys), ang

StaySafe app ay nagsilbing multi-purpose tool na tumutulong sa pagpapabuti ng kalagayan ng Covid sa bansa.

Six NPA terrorists surrender, turn over firearms in Quezon

CAMP CAPINPIN, Tanay, Rizal(PIA) --The Army's 2nd Infantry Division has recorded another breakthrough following the surrender of six NPA rebels with firearms in Quezon on October 1.

The former rebels turned over one carbine rifle, one Cal. 38, bandolier, five magazines, and ammunition to personnel of 85th Infantry Battalion in Brgy Cambuga, Mulanay, Quezon.

Brigadier General Norwyn Romeo Tolentino, Commander of the 201st Brigade mentioned that the unprecedented number of surrenders is due to the rebel groups' failure to regard their combatants' lives and support their families as promised.

"As per testimony of the former rebels, all of them

are active members and allies of the NPA, thus, we are expecting them to share valuable information that will help us deal with the few remaining terrorist that will push them toward their eventual defeat in this part of the country," added Tolentino.

The military upholds the former rebels' safety protocols by keeping their true identities in private to avoid NPA retaliatory acts to those who call for peace.

For his part, Major General Greg Almerol, Commander of Army's 2nd Infantry Division lauded the former rebels for choosing the path of peace over violence.

Almerol ordered his soldiers to provide necessary assistance to the former rebels while they undergo the
