

#### MANILA

Around 8,402 job openings are still available in Cavite and Laguna provinces, Malacañang said on Wednesday.

In a Palace press briefing, Presidential Communications Office (PCO) Undersecretary and Palace Press Officer Claire Castro said jobseekers may apply for the vacant positions offered during the recent job fair held in Dasmariñas, Cavite and Biñan, Laguna.

"May available pa pong jobs sa Dasmariñas 4,120 at sa Biñan po ay 4,282 (There are still 4,120 jobs available in Dasmariñas and 4,282 in Biñan)," Castro said.

Castro noted that

only 63 applicants in Dasmariñas and 45 in Biñan were hired on the spot in the job fairs organized by the government.

President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr. led the "Trabaho at Serbisyong Pangkalusugan sa Bagong Pilipinas" job and health fair in the two provinces last week.

In February, Marcos vowed to expand job fairs nationwide to create more employment opportunities, particularly for beneficiaries of the Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps) and the Tulong Panghanapbuhay sa Ating Disadvantaged/Displaced Workers (TUPAD) program.

During the job and

health fair in Laguna, Marcos expressed elation over the high number of jobseekers who were hired on the spot, saying the event in the province was the "most successful" so far.

"Please be informed that during the 27 March 2025 referendum/ consultation, the Commission has extended the registration of Online Campaign Platforms (OCPs) for a final and non-extendible period, until 31 March 2025, 11:59 PM," the Commission on Elections (Comelec) said in Memorandum 250507. According to

Comelec Task Force KKK sa Halalan Commissioner-in-Charge Nelson Celis, the reopening of the registration period is in response to the numerous requests from stakeholders.



In celebration of World TB Day, Barangay Tua in Magallanes became the latest site for the Department of Health's (DOH) PuroKalusugan services on March 25, 2025. The comnunity-based initiative aims to bring essential healthcare services directly to underserved communities, ensuring accessible and quality medical care for all.

During the event, a range of vital health services was provided. A total of 137 residents underwent chest X-ray screenings, while 80 individuals received skin consultations under the Kilatis Kutis program. In addition, 76 individuals underwent HIV testing and counseling, and tuberculosis (TB) prevention efforts were strengthened through Purified Protein Derivative (PPD) testing. Pregnant

"The DOST scholarship programs are already wide-ranging. However, they still need to be expanded because we see that there are even greater benefits that our current and future scholars can receive through this program."

Jawili cites the positive effects of providing educational support to students who come from poor families in further developing their livelihoods.

"[DOST scholarship] is a big help because it supports many children, especially those from poor families, in overcoming poverty. We believe that if at least one child in a family can graduate from college, it will already be a significant help to the family. Especially if the applicants or children are truly intelligent," the director adds.

What the DOST-SCI and the DOST system are doing is allowing them to take the exam first, and if they passed, that's when we require them to submit the necessary documents to qualify as awardees." Data released by DOST Calabarzon said that there are 4,071 scholars under the Republic Act No. 7687 or the Science and Technology Scholarship Act of 1994: 2,755 scholars under the Republic Act No. 2067 or the DOST-SEI Merit Scholarship Program; and 177 scholars under the Republic Act No. 10612 or the Fast-Tracked S&T Scholarship Act of 2013.

The scholarship programs of DOST aim to encourage Filipino youths to pursue productive careers in science and technology including basic sciences, engineering, other applied sciences, and science and mathematics teaching.

After graduation, scholars are obligated to stay in the Philippines and work in science and technology sectors to ensure a steady, adequate supply of qualified S&T human resources which can steer the country towards improved competency and national progress. (CH/PIA-Laguna)
