Bong Go continues to extend support, sends aid to fire-hit community in Cavite City



Start of work week for Economic Frontliners

On the same day that the Bicameral Conference Committee Report for the Bureau of Fire Protection Modernization Act was ratified by the Senate, Senator Christopher "Bong" Go continued to support fire victims as he sent his team to deliver assistance in Cavite City on Wednesday, August 4.

Go expressed his concern to 21 families, composed of 65 individuals, whose houses were damaged by the recent fire incident in Samonte Park, Cavite City.

In his video message, Go stressed the importance of enhancing the capabilities of the BFP especially since there are grow-

ing numbers of reported fire incidents in the country even at the height of the pandemic.

Go then mentioned that the modernization of the bureau will include the acquisition of modern fire equipment, hiring more firefighters, and provisioning of specialized trainings, among others.

"Sa mga nasunugan naman po, huwag ho kayong mag-alala. Magtutulongan lang tayo. Ang gamit po'y nabibilil, ang pera po'y kinikita. Subalit ang perang kinikita ay hindi po nabibili ang buhay. A lost life is a lost life forever. Kaya mag-ingat po tayo, mga kababayan ko,"

Go remarked.

Go's team conducted the relief efforts at Porta Vega Elementary School as health and safety protocols were fully implemented after the team grouped the beneficiaries into smaller batches to avoid the further spread of the virus.

The fire victims received financial assistance, grocery packs, meals, masks, face shields, and vitamins. Some were also given new pairs of shoes, bicycles, and computer tablets.

To further help the beneficiaries recover, staff from the Department of Social Welfare and Development

Ensure 'ayuda' during lockdown - Bong Revilla

As the National Capital Region (NCR) reimposes a two-week Enhanced Community Quarantine from August 6 to 20, Senator Ramon Bong Revilla, Jr. reminded the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) of Malacañang's commitment to provide cash aid, more popularly referred to as 'ayuda', to those who would be affected. In the President's talk to the people earlier in the week, President Rodrigo Duterte assured that affected individuals in Metro Manila will receive one thousand pesos (P1,000.00) each, with a maximum four thousand pesos (P4,000.00) per family.

Equally important,



the lawmaker stressed the crucial cooperation between the National Government and the various Local Government Units (LGUs) so that the 'ayuda' is distributed efficiently, reaching those who are most in need in a timely manner.

DA-4A, organic agri farmers magkatuwang sa paghahanda sa implementasyon ng PGS sa rehiyon

CALABARZON --Katuwang ng mga organic agriculture (OA) farmer sa CALABARZON ang Department of Agriculture IV-CALABARZON (DA-4A) sa paghahanda sa implementasyon ng Participatory Guarantee System (PGS) sa rehiyon.

Ang PGS, alisunod sa Republic Act No. 11511 o ang "Act Amending the Organic Agriculture Act of 2010, ay naglalayon na matulungan ang maliliit na magsasaka at mangingisda na magkaroon ng sertipikasyon ang kanilang mga organikong produkto nang hindi na kinakailangang dumaan sa third party certifying bodies.

Ang PGS ay binubuo ng mga organic farmers cooperative and associations (FCAs) at pribado at pampublikong sektor na layuning makapagbigay ng lehitimong sertipikasyon sa mga organikong produkto sa mas mababang halaga.

Tungkulin din ng mga grupong mapapasama sa PGS na bantayan ang

buong proseso ng sertipikasyon ng mga organikong produkto mula sa produksyon hanggang pagbenta ng mga produkto sa merkado.

Sa PGS, kasama na ang mga napiling asosasyon at kooperatiba sa pagse-sertipika ng mga produkto at pagbibigay ng mga rekomendasyon sa mga dapat isaalang-alang sa pagsesertipika.

Patuloy ang OA Program ng DA-4A sa pakikipag-ugnayan sa mga FCAs na maaaring mapabilang sa PGS.

Ang Baras Bido-fa FA, HERBS Inc., Tanim Agriculture Cooperative, at San Pablo Cooperative – Ube, ang ilan sa mga FCAs sa CALABARZON ang sumailalim sa Internal Control System towards PGS Training noong Hulyo. Tinalakay dito ang kahalagahan ng pagkakaroon ng PGS at ang mga gampanin ng mga samahan na mapapabilang dito.

"Nagpapasalamat kami sa DA dahil sa pagpa-

patupad nitong PGS. Nagbibigay ito ng pag-asa na ma-certify ang produkto namin. Kasi dati hindi namin kayang magbayad ng halos fifty to hundred thousand para sa pag-process ng certi-

Duterte signs proclamation creating IT center in Cavite

MANILA — President Rodrigo Duterte has signed a proclamation creating an Information Technology Center Special Economic Zone in Bacoar City, Cavite.

Proclamation 1196, signed by Duterte on Thursday and released to the media on Friday, also designated a building that would be named

CBC Asia Technozone.

The planned special economic zone will be situated along Emilio Aguinaldo Highway, Barangay Talaba VII in the city.

It will have a gross floor area of 50,277.76 square meters situated in a land area of 7,000 square meters.

The President creat-

ed the special economic zone at the recommendation of the Board of Directors of the Philippine Economic Zone Authority (PEZA).

Special economic zones are defined in Republic Act 7916 or The Special Economic Zone Act of 1995 as "selected areas with highly developed or which have

the potential to be developed into agro-industrial, industrial tourist/recreational, commercial, banking, investment, and financial centers."

An ecozone may contain any or all of the following: industrial estates, export processing zones, free trade zones, and tourist/recreational centers. (PNA)

Red Cross food trucks to go to communities affected by ECQ

MANDALUYONG CITY -- As the enhanced community quarantine starts today, August 6, 2021, the Philippine Red Cross has organized rolling kitchens through its Hot Meals on Wheels fleet across Metro Manila and nearby provinces to provide ready-to-eat meals for communities affected by COVID-19.

PRC Chairman and CEO Sen. Richard Gordon envisioned a food truck fleet and that is now a reality as 23 of PRC's Hot Meals on Wheels will be deployed to the cities of Caloocan, Manila, Las Pinas, Malabon, Marikina, Navotas, Pasay, Quezon City, Valenzuela and areas in the

provinces of Rizal, Valenzuela, Cavite, and Bulacan.

This initiative by PRC is in response to the imposition of strict community quarantine measures that restrict the residents to their access to food and other basic

needs.

PRC's food trucks will be deployed to its 12 chapters in Metro Manila and nearby provinces and aim to distribute hot meals to 13,000 individuals.

"Dahil sa paglaga-

nap ng Delta variant sa ating bansa, at pagbalik sa Enhanced Community Quarantine sa Metro Manila, kaagad natin ipinadala ang ating mga food truck upang makapagbigay ng makakain sa mga taong maapektuhan ng lockdown," Gordon said.

"Magugutom ang mga tao, hindi lahat may kakayahan na itawid itong ECQ na ito. Kaya naman naghanda tayo dito sa Red Cross at ipa-deploy natin ang mga food trucks," added Gordon. PRC will also set up a welfare desk and first aid station to ensure the safety of the residents and will strictly observe prevention control measures. (Philippine Red Cross)

ment gave additional financial assistance while the Department of Trade and Industry and the National Housing Authority conducted an assessment where qualified recipients will benefit from their respective livelihood and housing programs.

A former worker in a foam factory, Ernesto Erediano shared how he now struggles to provide for his six children after being displaced from his job of more than 20 years.

He then expressed his gratitude towards President Rodrigo Duterte and Senator Go, saying "Maraming-marami hong salamat. Nagpapasalamat ho ako nang marami sa ating Pangulo at sa kanyang mga kaalakbay. Nagpapasalamat din po ako kay Senador Bong Go sa binigay na tulong

sa akin."

Apart from the assistance provided, Go reached out to the beneficiaries, and their loved ones, who have health concerns to visit any of the two Malasakit Centers in Cavite located at Southern Tagalog Regional Hospital in Bacoar City, and General Emilio Aguinaldo Memorial Hospital in Trece Martires City.

The Malasakit Centers Act was enacted in 2019 through a measure that Go authored and sponsored in the Senate. The program aims to assist poor and indigent patients pay for their medical expenses by providing convenient access to medical assistance from various agencies organized inside each Malasakit Center.

"Mga kababayan

ko, kung mayro'n ho kayong mga pasyente at kailangang dalahin sa Maynila magsabi lang ho kayo. Tutulungan ho namin kayo, halimbawa, sa (Philippine) Heart Center, sa NKTl, sa (Philippine) Orthopedic (Center) po tutulungan ho namin kayo," said Go. "Nandiritto lang po kami ni Pangulong Duterte na handang magserbisyo po sa inyo sa abot ng aming makakaya," he added.

As Vice Chair of the Senate Committee on Finance, Go also helped boost infrastructure development in various localities. In particular, he pushed for funding for the rehabilitation of a National Road System within Cavite City.

He also supported initiatives for road improvements in Bacoar City, Dasmariñas City, General Emilio

Aguinaldo, General Trias City, Imus, and Tagaytay City; construction of slope protection in Bacoar City, Carmona City, and Dasmariñas City; construction of multi-purpose buildings in Bacoar City, General Trias City, Imus, Mendez, and Trece Martires; acquisition of ambulance units in Bacoar, Indang, and Trece Martires; rehabilitation of fire station in Noveleta; and upgrading of drainage systems in Imus, and General Trias City.

Concluding his message, he thanked Representative Francis Gerald "Boy Blue" Aguinaldo Abaya, Governor Jonvic Remulla, Vice Governor Jolo Revilla, Mayor Totie Paredes, and other local government leaders for their untiring service to their community even amid the global pandemic. (OSBG)

CAVITE PNP WEEKLONG ANTI-CRIME DRIVE OPS 251 ARRESTED AND 33,686 QUARANTINE VIOLATORS RECORDED

Camp BGen Pantaleon Garcia, Imus City- Cavite Police Provincial Office spearheaded by PCOL MARLON R SANTOS, Provincial Director has recorded 33,686 quarantine violators and 251 Law breakers on its intensified weeklong anti-crime drive operation conducted from August 2-8, 2021 with significant results.

A total of 33,688 quarantine violators were recorded, 4,224 for not wearing face mask; 5,555 for improper wearing of facemask; 13,678 for not wearing face

shield; 6,238 for improper wearing of face shield; 3,461 for violation of curfew hours; 506 for violation of social distancing and 24 for mass gathering.

Out of 251 arrested, most of those arrested are involved in illegal drugs with a total of 102 individuals; 62 were involved in illegal gambling; 44 wanted persons, 10 of which are included in the list of Most Wanted Persons (Regional, Provincial, City & Municipal Level) while 34 others were involved in various crimes.

Cavite PPO intensi-

fied campaign against illegal drugs likewise resulted in the confiscation of 102 pieces small and 1 piece medium heat sealed transparent plastic sachet containing suspected shabu and 4 pieces of HSTPS marijuana and other drug paraphernalias.

Authorities also collared 62 persons for involvement in illegal gambling and confiscation of bet money amounting to P12,172.00 and two for possession of illegal firearms.

"These accomplishments particularly in the arrest of people involved

in illegal drugs, illegal gambling, wanted persons and other crimes were the results of active involvement of all local chief executives and the community in our anti-criminality campaign in accomplishing our mission to enforce the law, prevent and control crimes, and maintain peace and order in the province of Cavite." PCOL SANTOS added.

ASEAN celebrates 54th anniversary

JAKARTA -- Today, ASEAN marks its 54th anniversary. As the fight against the COVID-19 pandemic continues, the observation and commemoration of this year's ASEAN Day was once again held online. The message of this year's anniversary highlights Brunei Darussalam's ASEAN Chair 2021 theme - "We Care, We Prepare, We Prosper."

The Secretary-General of ASEAN, Dato Lim Jock Hoi, opened the online ceremony with his welcome remarks, where he highlighted that "ASEAN has taken the opportunity to consolidate and become a more inclusive and resilient community since the strike of the COVID19 pandemic in ASEAN in March 2020." In her keynote address, Foreign Minister for the Republic of Indonesia Retno Marsudi urged ASEAN Member States to assume an active role in shaping regional dynamics and promote the principle and values enshrined in the ASEAN Outlook on the Indo-Pacific region. "The pandemic is hardly our only challenge, regional peace and stability also demand our attention. Great power rivalries show no signs of diminishing anytime soon and has the potential to sow division among us. Rather than being a pawn in this new Cold War, ASEAN must be at the driving seat in shaping regional dynamics," she said.
