Pag-IBIG home loan program benefits over 100K members

MANILA – A total of 105,212 Home Development Mutual Fund or Pag-IBIG Fund members were able to avail of its home loan program for the year 2022.

In a press release issued on Jan 19, Pag-IBIG announced that they have released a record-high PHP118 billion in home loans last year, which is higher by 21 percent, or a total of PHP20.57 billion, compared to the PHP97.28 billion in home loans released in 2021.

With the amount, Pag-IBIG financed the ac-

quisition and construction of 105,212 homes for its members, equivalent to an 11 percent increase from the 94,533 homes financed in 2021, setting a new record high.

“This is very good news because as the amount of home loans we release increases, so does the number of Filipinos who now have

homes of their own,” said Department of Human Settlements and Urban Development (DHSUD) Secretary Jose Rizalino Acuzar, who also heads the 11-member Pag-IBIG Fund Board of Trustees.

“Pag-IBIG Fund’s performance is a testament to our united and unwavering efforts to resolve the

country’s housing backlog, in line with the objective of President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr. under the Pambansang Pabahay Para sa Pilipino Program,” he said.

The Pambansang Pabahay Para sa Pilipino Program is a flagship pro-

gram of Marcos that is aimed at addressing the country’s housing needs by building 1 million houses each year for the next six years.

Marcos earlier expressed the need to provide families with shelter most especially the poor residents,

as well as those employed people who struggle to have decent housing.

Meanwhile, Pag-IBIG Fund Chief Executive Officer Marilene Acosta noted that the number of housing units financed in 2022

SENATOR'S Corner

Senators eyeing
to amend ASIN
Law, boost local
salt production

MANILA – The
Senate Committee on Ag-
riculture is now pushing to
amend Republic Act 8172,
or An Act for Salt Iodization
Nationwide (ASIN), seeking
to revive the country's salt
industry.

According to Sen-
ator Cynthia Villar who
chairs the committee, the law
should not require all local
producers to iodize salt as
most of the demand are being

used as fertilizers by farmers
and not for food consump-
tion.

During a hearing
conducted by the committee
recently, Villar said the law,
which was passed in 1995,
became a deterrent in the
development of the local salt
industry instead of promot-
ing it.

"It has neglected to
develop new areas and in-
vite new investors. It made

all salt food grade. In 2021,
it was reported that, we
only produced seven per-
cent of our salt requirements
and imported 93 percent or
550,000 metric tons," she
noted.

Villar recalled that
in the 1950s, the Philip-
pines' salt industry boomed
as new fishponds and salt
farms were constructed in
the provinces of Pangasinan,
Bulacan, Occidental Mind-
oro, Cavite, Paranaque City,
Negros, Cebu and other
provinces.

"Salt producing
areas in the Philippines,
reached an estimated peak
of 5,000 hectares national-
ly, producing an estimated
240,000 metric tons annu-
ally. This boom in growth
supported a growing popula-
tion and the development of

the salt industry in the 1960s
and 1970s.

One of the mea-
sures discussed in the hear-
ing was Senate Bill No.
(SBN) 1450 or An Act Pro-
moting and Revitalizing the
Salt Industry of the Philip-
pines filed by Senate Major-
ity Joel Villanueva, which
seeks to amend the ASIN
Law.

Villanueva said
the bill seeks to revive the
local salt industry, increase
the productivity and income
of local salt producers, pre-
serve the country's local and
traditional production tech-
niques, and promote Phil-
ippine artisanal salt, among
others.

"We have an enor-
mous, untapped, and ne-
glected resource that could
change the lives of about
60 percent of our total pop-
ulation, who live in coastal
zones. Aside from the urgen-
cy of addressing the needs of
the industry, it is also signif-
icant to this representation

TRECE MAR-
TIRES CITY (PIA) – Pro-
vincial health executives
in Cavite recently broke
ground for the first public tu-
berculosis culture and drug
susceptibility testing labora-
tory at the ancillary building
of the General Emilio Agu-
inaldo Memorial Hospital here.

Dr. Eva Marie To-
rio, Department of Health
(DOH) infectious diseases
unit head, said tuberculosis
is one of the major health
problems in the province.



"The establish-
ment of the TB culture lab
is essential in the diagnosis,
monitoring, and treating of
drug-resistant TB as well as
improving the TB manage-
ment turnaround time," she
added.

During the ground-

breaking, district Board
Member and health commit-
tee chair Reyniel Ambion on
behalf of Governor Jonvic
Remulla and Vice Governor
Athena Tolentino thanked
everyone involved in the
project.

"This project will

benefit healthcare providers
and those who are infected
with TB as they need not
travel to other hospitals out-
side Cavite for laboratory
testing," Ambion said.

The Department of Public Works and High-
ways (DPWH) Regional Office No. IV-A hopes to
complete the Construction of the Dasmariñas—
General Mariano Alvarez (GMA)—Carmona By-
Pass Road in Dasmariñas City, Cavite, by 2026 af-
ter it began construction in 2020.

The 4.9-kilometer concrete road will connect Das-
marinas City to the Municipality of Carmona, tra-
versing through General Mariano Alvarez. The
project begins along Paliparan Road, a tertiary
national road in Dasmariñas City, and ends along
Governor's Drive in Carmona, which is a primary
national road.

This project aims to reduce the travel distance be-
tween the city and municipalities and reduce the
travel time as well.

They include:

-- Wearing of face masks among high-risk individuals (healthcare workers, elderly and immunocompromised) and in places that are crowded or have poor ventilation.

-- Shortening of isolation period. If with symptoms, isolation will be 10 days until symptoms are gone for three days, instead of 14 days. If asymptomatic, the total number of isolation days is five days instead of 10 days. One can isolate in a hospital or self-isolate at home and take an antigen test afterwards.

-- Available treatment for high-risk individuals, antiviral Paxlovid, to prevent severe and critical cases.

When asked if the country is ready for the lifting of the public health emergency, Solante answered in the affirmative saying Covid-19 cases nationwide have become manageable, health facilities are not overwhelmed with admissions and many are fully vaccinated and have received their booster shots.

On Tuesday, Department of Health officer-in-charge Maria Rosario Vergeire said the country is prepared in case the WHO ends the declaration of global health emergency due to Covid-19 as Filipinos remain "cautious and vigilant" and protocols and safeguards are in place anytime infections increase. source:(PNA)

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PRODUKSYON NG SIBUYAS SA CALABARZON, PALALAKASIN NG D.A...

Ang presyo ng sibuyas sa kasalukuyan ay nananatiling mataas kada kilo na umaabot ng P500 - P550 hanggang P650. Kaya naman ang Department of Agriculture (DA) ay nag-sisikap na gumawa ng mga aksyong nararapat upang matulungan ang mga magsasaka ng sibuyas at mga konsumedores. Ayon sa DA, palalakasin nito ang produksyon ng sibuyas sa CALABARZON Re-

gion (CAVITE, LAGUNA, BATANGAS, RIZAL at QUEZON) sapagkat ang sibuyas ay isang high value crop.

Sinabi ni Regional Director Milo delos Reyes sa isang interview noong nakalipas na Miyerkules na ang kanilang ahensya ay patuloy na namamahagi ng mga pangangailangan sa mga magsasaka ng sibuyas upang mapalakas ang produksyon at supply nito sa pamilihan.

“Hindi natin pinapabayaan ang mga magsasaka natin ng sibuyas dito sa rehiyon kahit iilan lamang sila dahil patuloy tayo na nagbibigay ng binhi at abono. Bagkus, patuloy nating palalakasin ang produksyon ng ating lokal na sibuyas sa mga susunod na mga buwan,” dagdag ni delos Reyes.

Calabarzon region is considered an onion consumer compared to the onion-producing regions

like Ilocos, Cagayan Valley, Central Luzon and Mimaropa. According to DA IV-A, only 70 hectares of farmland are planted to onions in CALABARZON resulting in a higher demand of the crop due to a lower amount of supply.

“In terms of demand, syempre apektado din tayo with the same reason na hindi malaki ang produksyon natin ng sibuyas,” dagdag na sabi nito.

SUPPLEMENTAL ANNOUNCEMENT (For Vacant Judgeship Positions in Regions VI, VII and VIII)

The Judicial and Bar Council (JBC) announces that for the recently opened vacant judgeship positions in Regions VI, VII and VIII, dated 7 January 2023, and pursuant to Rule 3, Section 2 of the 2020 Revised Rules of the JBC, all applicants are required to have undergone, completed and passed the PreJudicature Program (PJP) of the Philippine Judicial Academy (PHILJA).

Under Paragraph 3, Section 2 of Rule 3 of the 2020 Revised Rules of the JBC, the "PJP passing result shall have a validity period of three (3) years reckoned from the date of release by the PHILJA." The application of the said rule, however, is still suspended.

Accordingly, as recommended by PHILJA, the PJP results shall have a validity period of five (5) years. Thus, the PJP certificates of completion with passing rate, released from the year 2018 onwards are valid. Whereas, the PJP results released on or before the year 2017 shall no longer be considered valid.

Interested applicants with expired PJPs must register and enroll in the PJP for Trial Courts to be conducted by PHILJA exclusively for them.

All those with expired PJPs may still register with the Online Application Scheduler not later than the deadline for the submission of application and documentary requirements on 21 February 2023 (Tuesday), from 8:00 o' clock in the morning to 4:30 in the afternoon. 18 January 2023.

Masks still needed once public health emergency ends: expert

MANILA – A health expert on Wednesday (Jan. 18) recommended the retention of the face mask mandate should the state of public health emergency due to coronavirus disease 2019 (Covid-19) be lifted.

“Kung anuman iyong magbabago dito sa public health emergency o iyong state of calamity, mananatili pa rin ang face mask dahil ito ang importanteng tool natin na hindi tayo magkakahawa-hawaan. Wala pa rin tayong sinasabi na wala na tayong Covid (Whatever changes in the public health emergency or state of calamity, face mask will stay because this is an important tool, so we don't get infected. Covid is still here),” infectious disease expert Dr. Rontgene Solante said in a televised public briefing.

Solante said the World Health Organization (WHO) has set new Covid-19 guidelines which include three important interventions as countries continue to move on and live with the virus.

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
