NIA-Calabarzon sells P29/kilo rice to priority buyers in Cavite

Calabarzon-The National Irrigation Administration (NIA) in Region 4A (Calabarzon), through the Cavite-Batangas Irrigation Management Office (IMO), held Thursday its “KabayanIAN Agri-Trade Fair” in Naic, Cavite, where it offered rice at only PHP29 per kilogram (kg).

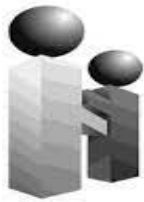
Vince Santoalla, the public relations officer for NIA 4A, said in a phone interview that the fair made available 1,000 bags of rice, each weighing 10 kilos, for PHP290 each at the Cavite-Batangas IMO in the town.

He said this initial stock is reserved for senior

citizens, Pantawid Family-ang Pilipino Program (4Ps) members, solo parents, and persons with disability (PWDs) in coordination with the Naic local government unit (LGU).

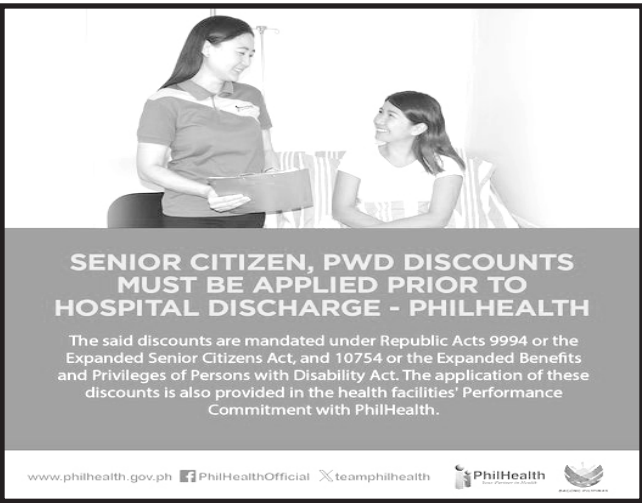

Dengue deaths lower this year: DOH

The number of patients dying from dengue, a viral disease spread by mosquitoes, is lower this year despite an increase in cases, the Department of Health (DOH) said Thursday.

"The case fatality rate for this year is very small actually, 0.27 percent. In terms of absolute numbers, that is 364 deaths," DOH spokesperson Albert Domingo said in a Bagong Pilipinas Ngayon interview.

The recorded deaths are from the 136,161 cases from Jan. 1 to Aug. 3.

The country has logged 102,374 dengue cases with 401 deaths for the same period last year.

Domingo said the decrease in deaths is partly attributed to the help-seeking behavior of patients.

"Maaga na pong komunsulta ang ating mga kababayan (Early consultation is observed among our fellowmen)," he said.

Two Filipino language pioneers honored with ‘Dangal ng Wikang Filipino’ 2024

MANILA (PIA) — The Komisyon sa Wikang Filipino (KWF) or the Commission on the Filipino Language (CFL) will confer the prestigious Dangal ng Wikang Filipino (Honor of the Filipino Language) 2024 award to two esteemed academics: Dr. Raquel E. Sison-Buban and Dr. Dolores R. Taylan.

Dr. Buban is an educator, translator, researcher, interviewer, writer, and language advocate. She has delivered various lectures and interviews at different academic institutions, covering topics such as the following:

- Espesyal na Maikling Kurso ng Pagsasalin (Special Short Course on Translation);
- Pagbasag sa mga Mito ng Pagsasalin at Pagsasalin ng Metapora (Debunking Translation Myths and Translating Metaphors);
- Pagbuo ng Programa para sa Pagsasanay sa Pagsasalin: Estado, Proseso at Disenyo (Developing a Translation Training Program: Status, Process, and Design);
- Isyu, Bugso, at Direksiyon ng/sa Pagsasalin sa Ika-21 Siglong Edukasyon (Issues, Trends, and Directions in/of Translation in 21st Century Education);
- Lipat, Danas, and Lapat: Praktika at Estratehiya sa Pagsasalang Teknikal (Shift, Experience, Fit: Practices and Strategies in Technical Translation); and
- Mga Teorya at Praktika sa Pagsasalin (Theories and Practices in Translation)

Dr. Taylan, on the other hand, is a pillar of the Department of Filipino at De La Salle University, championing the promotion and development of the Filipino language.

With over two decades of university teaching experience, she has demonstrated her dedication and advocacy in helping Lasallian students understand the importance and power of the Filipino language in social transformation.

She has made significant contributions to the intellectualization of the Filipino language nationwide.

She is actively involved in various national organizations, such as the Propesyonal na Asosasyon ng mga Tagasalin at Tagapagtaguyod ng Salin (PATAS) and the Pambansang Samahán

Cayetano, tinutulak ang mas mahusay na pamamahagi ng ayuda

Itinulak ni Senador Alan Peter Cayetano nitong Miyerkules ang mas mahusay na pamamahagi ng tulong ng gobyerno dahil aniyay kinakaa-in ng administrative costs ang pondo sa halip na makinabang ang mga nangangailangang Pilipino.

Sa Senate briefing nitong August 14 ng Development Budget Coordination Committee (DBCC), sinabi ni Cayetano na sa P590 billion na pondo ng ayuda ng mga ahensya ng gobyerno sa 2025 national budget, “theoretically... makapagbigay ng P20,000 sa bawat mahihirap na pamilya sa bansa.”

Pero ayon sa senador, hindi umaabot sa maximum na bilang ng mga

pamilya ang kabuuang halaga dahil sa mga gastos sa pangangasiwa ng ayuda.

“As a rule of thumb, how much ang admin costs kapag dumaan pa sa government agencies? Usually mga 20 to 30%? Even sa start nung AICS (Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation) nung maliit siya, sinabi na ng DSWD na parang 18 to 20% ang admin costs. Pero nung lumaki ang

AICS, humingi pa sila ng additional funds,” wika niya.

Dagdag na porsy-

ento din aniya ang kukunin kung ang tulong ay idadaan pa sa mga bangko. Tugon ni Budget

Secretary Amenah Pangandaman, para sa 4Ps (Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program), ang gastos ng administrasyon ay nasa 2 porsiyento; sa social pension para sa mga mahihirap ay 1.5 porsiyento; at para sa AICS ay 2 porsiyento.

Ngunit itinuro ni Cayetano na ang mga bilang na ito ay hindi kabilang ang mga suweldo at mga umuulit na gastusin sa pamamahagi ng ayuda.

“Hindi pa kasama diyan ang sweldo at MOOE (Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses). Meaning if I tell the mayors, ‘Mayor, ito y’ung pera per family,’ walang admin costs ‘yon kasi the families are in the

gym and binibigay na nila. Sa LGU, they will not hire additional [manpower] kasi nandoon na sila. Pero y’ung DSWD and everything, lala-ki,” wika niya.

Upang mapakinabangan ang kabuuan ng pondo ng ayuda, hinimok ng senador ang mga finance managers na suriin kung aling mga tulong ang dapat manatiling naka-target at alin ang direktang ibibigay sa mga beneficiary.

“We should really look at which ayuda we should keep targeted, and which we should just directly give,” wika niya sa DBCC panel. ###

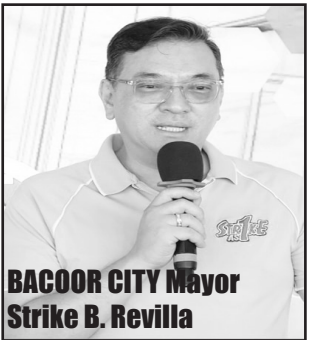

CAVITEX segment to remain toll-free

MANILA – A segment of the Manila-Cavite Expressway (CAVITEX) will remain toll-free until the Toll Regulatory Board (TRB) approves the resumption of toll collection, the Philippine Reclamation Authority (PRA) said Tuesday.

In a statement, the PRA said the toll holiday

declared by President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr. for all CAVITEX segments in Parañaque, Las Piñas, Taguig, Bacoor, and Kawit ended on July 31.

"However, all motorists coming from Cavite exiting to Segment 2 of C-5 Link and vice versa remains toll-free and continues to

benefit thousands of motorists," it said.

The PRA noted a rise in the average daily vehicle count across all segments of CAVITEX – from 171,000 to 200,000 – during the toll holiday

"This uptick underscores the positive externalities associated with im-

proved infrastructure, as the new segment is anticipated to enhance travel efficiency and reduce transaction costs and traveling time for commuters, thereby boosting overall economic productivity," it said.
