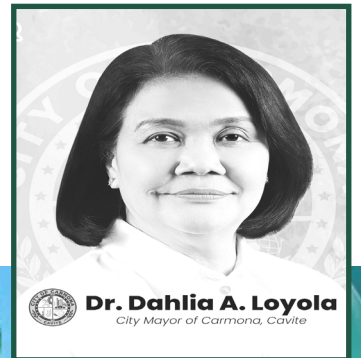


CITY OF CARMONA, NAGWAGI SA 2026 UNITED NATIONS PUBLIC SERVICE AWARDS



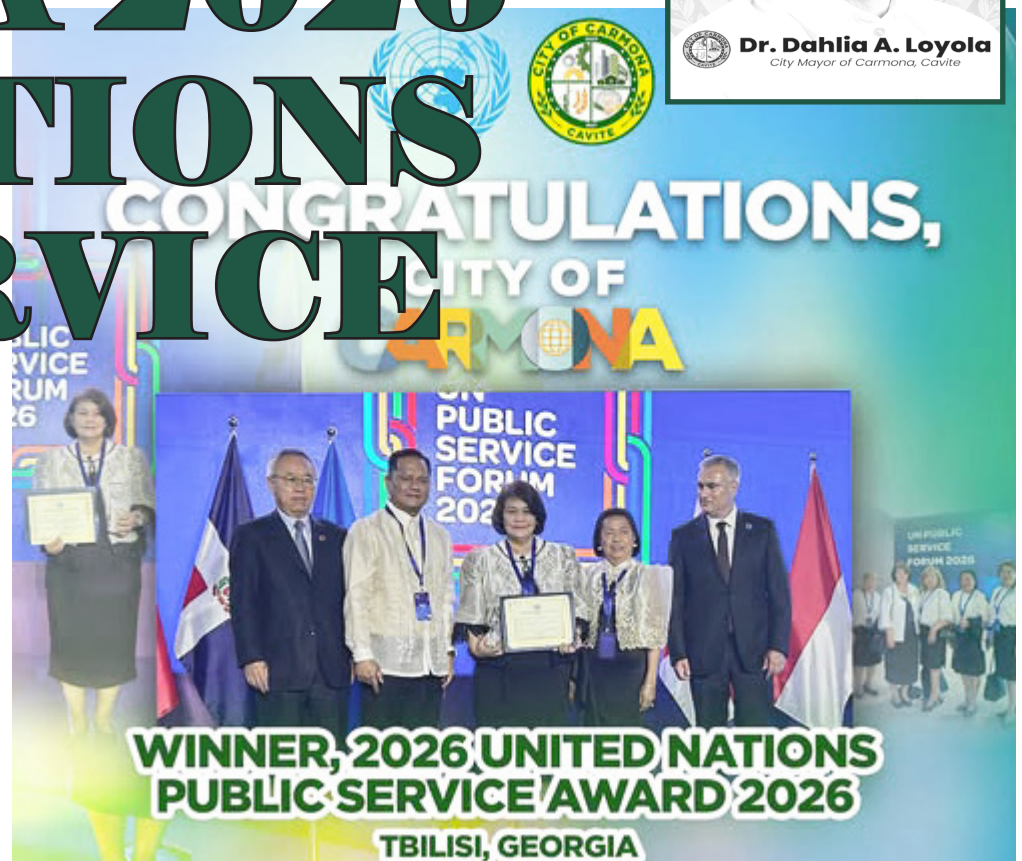

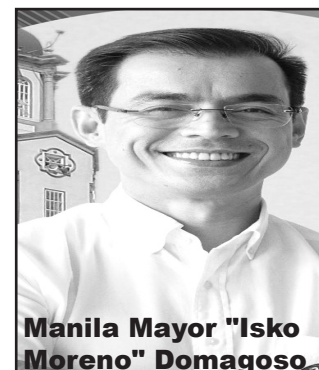

Manila to ban juvenile delinquents in city-run colleges, universities



MANILA — Manila Mayor Francisco "Isko Moreno" Domagoso on Friday warned juvenile delinquents that they would be

barred from enrolling in city-run universities and colleges.

Under a proposed city ordinance, students who are caught carrying weapons to school, engage in riots, or are officially found guilty of bullying will face expulsion from Manila's public schools, particularly the Universidad de Manila and the Paman-tasan Lungsod ng Maynila.

The proposal aimed at strengthening campus discipline and safety.

New school buildings end classroom shifting in Silang, Cavite

SILANG, Cavite (PIA) — Students in the Municipality of Silang, Cavite will no longer have to adopt class shifting schemes following the inauguration of new buildings in key local schools.

Last June 23, the Municipal Government led the simultaneous inauguration of school buildings across the municipality as part of its ongoing efforts to address classroom shortage.

Milano Garzon, school head of BLISS Ele-

mentary School noted that the newly opened classroom building will help end class shifting, a practice that has been adopted by several public schools in an effort to address the lack of teaching facilities.

“Sa bagong school building, natuldukan na ang shifting classes.”

With its additional classrooms, Garzon noted that classes can now end by one o'clock in the afternoon for Grades 1 and 2, while Grade 3 pupils will end their

classes two o'clock in the afternoon. Older students, including Grades 4 through 6 will end their classes by three o'clock in the afternoon.

BLISS Elementary School currently serves 525 pupils from Kindergarten through Grade 6.

Teachers at Gen. Vito Belarmino Integrated National High School, Pulong Bunga Elementary School, Brgy. Munting Ilog Elementary School, and Brgy. Balite II Elementary School, who also inaugurat-

ed their own six-classroom buildings also welcomed the additional infrastructure.

Mayor Ted Carranza, in a statement, emphasized the school infrastructure program in the local government's continuous efforts to address classroom shortage. With a more conducive learning environment, Carranza assured their commitment to invest in school infrastructure.

“Through these initiatives, the Municipal Government of Silang moves closer to its goal of completely eliminating class shifting and providing every student with access to quality education in a safe and conducive learning environment.”

In partnership with local government units all over the country, the Department of Education (DepEd) launched its localized school building program in a bid to decentralize infrastructure development especially in

dents found responsible for bullying inside educational institutions would likewise undergo due process that could result in expulsion.

"I believe in the right of the individual, but we also have a responsibility to the people," Domagoso said at the Kapihan ng Samahang Plaridel at the Luneta Hotel.

He said the proposed measure seeks to protect the majority of students, parents, and teachers, adding that those who commit serious offenses should be removed from Manila schools while disciplinary proceedings are conducted.

He called for greater authority for teachers to enforce discipline, saying educa-

tors should be empowered to maintain peace and order inside schools.

"Empower our teachers para magkaroon ng power ang teacher na makapagdisiplina ng mga students (so that they have the power to discipline the students)," he added.

School safety task force

Meanwhile, Domagoso said the Manila School and Community Safety Task Force, which he formed on Thursday, is set to convene next week.

He signed Executive Order No. 29, Series of 2026 titled the "Manila Schools Safety Initiative" on June 24, adopting

a prevention-first approach built on three principles: eliminating illegal firearms and armed threats, acting on every credible warning sign of violence, and preparing every school and community for emergency response.

The task force is tasked to monitor emerging threats against schools, public gatherings, and critical facilities, and to submit quarterly reports to the Office of the Mayor.

The initiative is the response of the Manila City government amid several violent incidents in schools, which claimed the lives of students and injured several others. source:(PNA)

PhilHealth has increased the consultation benefit under the YAKAP program to ₱1,700 per individual, for both public and private healthcare facilities. This is higher than the previous coverage to encourage greater utilization and improve access to affordable healthcare services.

Dr. Orina then emphasized that the program is not only for individuals experiencing health concerns but also for those who wish to regularly monitor their health status and consult with accredited healthcare facilities under the program, promoting preventive care and early detection of potential health conditions.

“Magpa-register pokayo sa Philhealth pero gamitin niyo po ang PhilHealth through YAKAP para mabantayan po ang kalusugan ninyo, because this is preven-

tion rather than cure,” Orina stated.

Meanwhile, additional services that PhilHealth members can avail themselves of through YAKAP are dental and optometric, reinforcing its preventive healthcare approach by helping detect health risks before they develop into serious conditions.

The expansion of PhilHealth services is part of President Marcos administration’s directive to strengthen the country’s healthcare system by ensuring the delivery of more comprehensive, accessible, and inclusive health services for all Filipinos. (COP,ML/PIA CALABARZON)

Pag-IBIG cuts home loan rates to 4.5% to make more houses affordable under PBBM’s Expanded 4PH

Home Development Mutual Fund (Pag-IBIG Fund) has lowered housing loan rates to 4.5 percent for homes priced above the socialized housing ceiling as part of President Ferdinand “Bongbong” Marcos Jr.’s push to expand affordable homeownership.

In a statement, Pag-IBIG said the 4.5-percent interest rate would apply to the housing loans or installment payments above the socialized housing ceiling of P950,000 for house-and-lot units, P1.8 million for condominium units, and P2.5 million for low-cost housing.

The cheaper financing is being offered to qualified borrowers until the end of 2026, according to Pag-IBIG.

“We continue to heed the directive of President Marcos to make decent and affordable homes more

accessible to Filipino families,” Department of Human Settlements and Urban Development (DHSUD) Secretary and Pag-IBIG Fund Board Chairman Jose Ramon Aliling said.

The state-operated fund said that the reduced rates would lead to smaller monthly payments for borrowers during the initial years of their loans.

For example, a P2.5-million housing loan paid over 30 years would result in a monthly amortization of about P12,667, which is around P2,700 less than the previous rate of 6.25 percent.

“We know that buying a home is one of the biggest and most important decisions a family will make,” Pag-IBIG Fund Chief Executive Officer Marilene Acosta said.

PhilHealth set to accredit 500 YAKAP facilities in CALABARZON

In a bid to expand access to free medical consultations and medicines, the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) Calabarzon aims to accredit 500 healthcare facilities by the end of 2026, under its Yaman ng Kalusugan Program (YAKAP), bringing preventive healthcare services closer to residents across the provinces of Cavite, Laguna, and Quezon.

Dr. Edwin Orina, Acting Vice President of PhilHealth Region IV-A, said the region currently has 289

accredited YAKAP Clinics providing healthcare services to members. Despite the number, the facilities remain insufficient for nearly 11 million residents of the three provinces.

"Dito po sa Region IV-A [mayroong] at least 289 YAKAP providers. I assure you po, kulang po yung 289, kasi napakalaki po ng ating tatlong probinsya – Cavite, Laguna, and Quezon. At the same time, we have at least 10-11 million population, so maliit po yung 289," Dr. Orina stated during an interview

with the Philippine Information Agency.

He added that the PhilHealth aims to establish 500 YAKAP Clinics across the region and expand the number of Guaranteed and Accessible Medications for Outpatient Treatment (GAMOT) providers to serve more Filipinos, particularly its members, and ensure wider access to healthcare services, benefits, free medical care, and medicines.
