

POPE NAMES CARDINAL TAGLE TO EASTERN CHURCHES CONGREGATION



Cardinal Luis Antonio Tagle

Pope Francis recently appointed Cardinal Luis Antonio Tagle as a new member of the Vatican body that supports the Eastern Catholic churches throughout the world. The cardinal was the sole addition to the Congregation for the Eastern Churches, which also assists the Latin-rite Catholic dioceses of the Middle East. As prefect of the Congregation for the Evangelization of Peoples or Propaganda Fide, which oversees the church's vast "mission territories," Tagle's new appointment was not surprising.

Formerly known as the Congregation for the Oriental Churches, it began as part of the Propaganda Fide, established by Pope Pius IX in 1862.

In 1917, Pope Benedict XV declared it independent and named it Congregation for Eastern Churches. **Turn to page 6**

REVILLA LAUDS CEBU GOV'S SWABBING POLICY

I laud the provincial government of Cebu for extending humanitarian considerations to our OFWs (Overseas Filipino Workers) and ROFs (Returning Overseas Filipinos) who are besieged with various challenges during this time of the COVID-19 pandemic. Their anxieties with their job and financial security, health and safety while away from their families cannot be appeased by any amount or article. Indeed, allowing them to immediately reunite with their families upon their arrival in the province under the "Swab-Up-on-Arrival-Policy" is a commendable initiative." This is how Senator Ramon Bong Revilla, Jr. in his letter to Cebu Governor Gwen Garcia welcomed Cebu's "Swab-Up-on-Arrival Policy" for arriving OFWs and ROFs in the province of Cebu. It was first implemented through Executive Order No. 17, Series of 2021 issued by Garcia, which was subsequently adopted as a local law through Cebu Provincial Ordinance No. 2021-04. The solon expressed his belief that Cebu's policy does not contradict the purpose of the IATF's (Inter-Agency Task Force on Emerging Infectious Diseases) guidelines, saying this in fact complements and improves upon the practice. Under the policy, Cebu residents, OFWs, and ROFs are subjected to an RT-PCR swab test upon arrival. When they test negative, they are sent home and undergo home quarantine.



Aguinaldo also wanted a monument for himself at Luneta

MANILA – Did you know that Gen. Emilio F. Aguinaldo, considered as the first president of the Philippines after the end of the Spanish rule, also wanted a monument for himself like that of Dr. Jose P. Rizal at the old Luneta, now better known as Rizal Park in Manila?

Such a wish was personally conveyed to President Diosdado P. Macapagal by the then 92-year-old revolutionary general during the first-ever celebration of Philippine Independence on June 12, 1962 instead of the former July 4 as granted by the United States in 1946.

In his nationwide address on that occasion at the Luneta, Macapagal, as quoted by the monthly Philippine Geographic magazine of November 1993 (Vol. 1, No. 2), explained why and how he changed the celebration of Independence Day from July 4 to June 12, the day in 1898 when the Filipinos

no people first declared their freedom from foreign rule.

In the process, it was believed that "he not only corrected a historical error but also did justice to the known heroes and many faceless Filipinos who fought and died or suffered in the Revolution of 1896."

As a result of Macapagal's proclamation, the Philippines celebrated the centennial of its Independence from Spain on June 12, 1998, or during the administration of President Fidel V. Ramos (June 30, 1992-June 30, 1998).

Macapagal, who was then barely five months in his Malacañang office following his election in the November 1961 polls, narrated:

"In the discharge of my responsibility as President of the Republic, I moved the observance of our Independence Day because a nation is born into freedom

on the day when such a people molded into a nation by a process of cultural evolution and a sense of oneness born of common struggle and suffering, announces to the world that it asserts its natural right to liberty and is ready to defend it with blood, life and honor."

Macapagal noted that the change was justified by the first successful June 12, 1962 celebration.

He said Aguinaldo was the guest of honor and at least 1 million people attended whereas in previous celebrations on July 4, only from 200,000 to 300,000 people came.

Macapagal also said bespeaking the nobility of the American people, then President John F. Kennedy was among the first to extend the congratulations of the US to the Filipino people in celebrating their day of freedom on June 12.

"In a message to me, President Kennedy said it is with pleasure that I join the people of the United States in extending our best wishes and warmest congratulations to Your Excellency and the people of the Republic of the Philippines on the occasion of the Philippine Independence Day."

According to Macapaqal, it was while he and Aguinaldo were seated at the Luneta grandstand during the ceremonies when the general thanked him again for the rectification of an erroneous historical practice and then asked:

"When will there be

an Aguinaldo monument at the Luneta like that of Rizal?"

Macapagal said he could not answer the question, adding that the next generation might have the answer.

According to the New Webster Dictionary, "a generation is the average time in which children are ready to replace their parents, or about 30 years."

Aguinaldo died on Feb. 6,1964 at the age of 95. On the other hand, President Macapagal passed away on April 21, 1997 at 86 years old.

Since both leaders were already dead more than 50 years and 20 years, respectively, it is now doubtful if there would ever be a monument for General Aguinaldo at the Rizal Park.

Proof of this is that no one from the past or present generations of Filipinos has proposed to put up such a monument alongside that of Dr. Rizal in the area.

Meanwhile, the revolutionary general has been honored with the lengthy Aguinaldo Highway in his Cavite home province. This highway begins from Bacoor City near Las Piñas City in Metropolitan Manila and extends all the way to Tagaytay City near Batangas, passing through the big cities of Imus and Dasmariñas and the town of Silang. There are also at least two municipalities named in his honor. These are General Emilio Aguinaldo town, formerly Bailen, in Cavite, and the town of Aguinaldo in Ifugao province, Cordillera Administrative Region in Northern Luzon./source (PNA)

antine for the remaining balance of the 14 days required and will be monitored by the barangay. After seven days, the second swab will be done by the local government unit of residence in Cebu. "Wala nang mandatory 2-week quarantine sa hotel na sadyang napakagastos," Revilla said. "There are even experts saying that there is no substantial difference between testing upon arrival and testing after seven days

- na gusto ng IATF," he added. Revilla stressed that the swab-after-7-days/10-day-quarantine of the IATF imposes a great and additional burden on OFWs and ROFs, and deprives them of precious time to be with family.

"Hindi naman sila pauwiin kung hindi negative 'yung swab test, at itutuloy naman nila ang home quarantine. So wala namang dapat ipag-alala," he ended.

Gordon to file measure that legislates wage adjustments for nurses

Following Malacañang's reversal of a Department of Budget and Management (DBM) circular on the adjusted salaries for Filipino nurses, Senator Richard J. Gordon said he will file a measure that will legislate the just salary of nurses from entry-level to senior nurses.

"We care for our nurses as they are vital to our healthcare system; they are at the forefront. We are glad that finally, they will get what they deserve, but we want to make sure that the memo issued by Malacañang will not be easily amended or retracted, so, we

will file a bill that will make that regulation a law. This is one significant way of protecting our nurses," said Gordon.

As an advocate of Filipino nurses, Gordon pushed for the measure that increased their salaries. On July 17, 2020, he filed the bill amending Republic Act No. 9173 or The Philippine Nursing Act of 2002 that states that the minimum base pay for nurses working in the government hospitals and health institutions should start at salary grade 15 or roughly P33,000 per month. Before the enactment of the bill, an entry-level

nurse only receives a salary of P8,000 to P13,500 on a monthly basis. This, Gordon stressed, is not commensurate to their labor, thus, they are forced to work abroad where they can earn more.

"I always say that our nurses should be compensated fairly so that they would no longer go overseas to work. The Philippines is a major source in exporting nurses. In the United States alone, about 150,000 nurses are Filipinos. And so, it is imperative that we create policies that are beneficial to them and will make them choose to stay in our country because we want them to be

with their families and we are also in need for health-care workers especially now that we are facing a pandemic," said Gordon.

DBM Circular No. 2020-4, issued on July 17, 2020, raised the salary of entry-level nurses to SG 15 but also demoted the positions of Nurses II to VII to one rank lower. The memorandum issued by Malacañang on June 1, 2021 reverted the circular and increases the salary of Nurse II from SG 15 to SG 16, while it retains the position titles of Nurse III to Nurse VII with their corresponding salary grades. Chief Justice Alexander G. Gesmundo is paid a virtual courtesy call by the Supreme Court's development partner Judicial Reform Initiative (JRI), led by Chair Ms. Sherisa P. Nuesa and President Mr. Jose Jerome R. Pascual III last June 7, 2021.

Joining the Chief Justice virtually are Justices Alfredo Benjamin S. Caguioa, Ramon Paul L. Hernando, Henri Jean Paul B. Inting, Rodil V. Zalameda, Mario V. Lopez, Edgardo L. Delos Santos, Samuel H. Gaerlan, Ricardo R. Rosario, and Jhosep Y. Lopez, Philippine Judicial Academy (PHILJA) Chancellor Arturo D. Brion, Judicial Integrity Board (JIB) Chairperson Romeo J. Callejo, Sr., and Court Administrator Jose Midas P. Marquez.

Chief Justice Gesmundo was joined in person by Assistant Court Administrator and Public Information Chief Brian Keith F. Hosaka and Deputy Clerk of Court and Judicial Reform Program Administrator Laura C.H. Del Rosario.

In his message to the JRI, the Chief Justice discussed the Supreme Court's initiatives to address the need for speedy disposition of cases such as the revision of the Internal Rules of the Supreme Court and the adoption of measures to ensure the safety of judges and court personnel while making sure that justice is

He also presented the Court's short-term goals which include the review and assessment of the organization structure and administration of the Philippine Judiciary, as well as long-term goals such as the development and establishment of an Information and

Communication Technology infrastructure for the Philippine Judiciary and strengthening judicial recruitment.

Ms. Nuesa, in behalf of the JRI, lauded the various initiatives by the SC such as the creation of JIB, the decongestion of jails with the release of thousands of Persons Deprived of Liberty (PDLs) during the pandemic, and the digital processes implemented, and the extension of the validity of notarial commission, among others.

According to her, these highlight the Court's commitment to uphold judicial independence, the Rule of Law, and fundamental rights.

For his part, Mr. Pascual proposed the holding of a Justice Summit to

be scheduled in the fourth quarter of 2022, for which pre-summit consultative workshops or web conferences on different components of the justice system will be held over a period of several months.

The Chief Justice expressed gratitude to the members of the JRI for their continuous support in behalf of the Judiciary and requested for further support and assistance in terms of budget augmentation especially for the JIB and PHILJA, fast-tracking the passage of the bills creating the Judiciary Marshals Service, and the increase of the jurisdiction of the first and second level courts.

During the courtesy call, the JRI expressed its
