

# LGU Imus City inoculates senior citizens thru house to house

**IMUS CITY, Cavite (PIA) --** The city government here commenced the house-to-house inoculation of senior citizens who are not capable of being physically present in the city's vaccination site.

Mayor Emmanuel L. Maliksi together with Vice Mayor Ony Cantimbuhan, City Health Officer Dr. Randy Calingasan and the CHO staff personally visited the houses of identified senior citizens in Barangays Pa-song Buaya 2 and Buhay na Tubig on April 22.

Dr. Calingasan administered the CoViD-19 vaccine jab to Danny Felomino and to his 65 year old wife who had been bedridden for four years now after suffering a stroke.

"Katulad kong may pasyente pang inaalagaan, mahirap na sa akin para lumabas kaya mas mabuti ngang magbahay-bahay na lang," Felomino said during his interview by ABS-CBN reporter Dennis Datu.

(Like me, I still have a patient being cared for, it's hard for me to get out so it's better to just go from house-to-house,)

Vice Mayor Ony Cantimbuhan explained, "As long as they are sick and it is difficult for them to go out and of course, it is safer that they do not go out. So, we will just go to their house and administer the vaccine."

The house-to-house vaccination is part of the four established measures of the city government under the #BidaAngMayBakuna cam-

## DOH-10 sends 12-member medical team to assist Calabarzon

**CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY -** The Department of Health in Region 10 (DOH-10) deployed Monday another 12-member team to help medical front-liners in the provinces

of Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, and Quezon (Calabarzon) in their coronavirus disease 2019 (Covid-19) response.

The volunteers, who will be deployed to

Daniel O. Mercado Medical Center at Tanauan, Batangas consisted of Dr. Emerald Holly B. Tago, a medical officer from Clarin, Misamis Oriental, and 11 nurses from this city and Lanao del

Norte, Misamis Oriental.

DOH-10 Director Jose Llacuna Jr. said the group is the fourth batch of front-line healthcare volunteers dubbed "Covid-19 Legionnaires" to the Calabar-

zon area.

They will assist health workers in Calabarzon from April 25 to May 31.

Llacuna said the deployment is in response to

the call for help from other regions to augment manpower shortage.

Llacuna said he was elated knowing that the healthcare workers volunteered to help other regions, even amid the risk.

## PhilHealth’s Debit-Credit Payment Method now applies to all high and critical risk areas

The Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) approved on Thursday, April 22, 2021, the application of the Debit-Credit Payment Method (DCPM) of the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) in all high risk and critical risk areas. These other high risk and critical risk areas will also be prioritized in the COVID-19 vaccine allocation, human health resource deployment, and other relevant COVID-19 response, as applicable.

PhilHealth, in its Circular 2021-0004, provides for the use of the DCPM to facilitate the settlement of accounts payable to healthcare facilities during the State of Public Health Emergency brought about by the COVID-19 pandemic.

PhilHealth initially applied DCPM only to areas identified by the IATF/National Task Force Against COVID-19 (NTF), particularly in the National Capital Region, Batangas, Bulacan, Cavite, Laguna, Pampanga, and Rizal.

The IATF likewise directed the NTF – Task Group Treat, through the One COVID Referral System, to utilize the Feasibility Analysis of Syndromic Surveillance Using Spatio-Temporal Epidemiological Modeler for Early Detection of Diseases (FASSTER) projections on target beds and human resources for health. These projections shall identify health capacity needs required to lower health care and intensive care unit (ICU) utilization rates.

The NTF shall also review and implement the recommended Prevent-Detect-Isolate-Treat- Reintegrate strategies to reduce the health utilization rates and augment the needs of human resources for health.

## POE: DON'T DELAY REIMBURSING HOSPITALS

Hospitals awaiting due reimbursement from the Philippine Health Insurance Corp. (PhilHealth) must not be made to wait any longer as they struggle to protect and save lives amid the pandemic, Sen. Grace Poe said.

The senator made the call following repeated pleas from the Private Hospitals Association of the Philippines Inc. (PHAPI) to the state health insurer to expedite and facilitate the release of their valid reimbursement claims.

PHAPI president Jose de Grano earlier said that the amount of reimbursement applications with

PhilHealth has reached P26 billion to P28 billion as of December 2020.

The amount is an “extrapolation” from their 114 hospital-members which submitted their claims, excluding private health institutions outside Metro Manila, De Grano said.

“This situation weighs heavily on our medical frontliners, patients, and the most vulnerable among our people,” Poe lamented.

“Wag na natin silang pahirapan pa, antagal na nilang nagsasakripisyo at nagtititais.”

medical frontliners put their lives on the line amid the systemic ills that affect our overall capacity to get back on our feet," Poe reiterated.

Not only private hospitals, but even government COVID-19 frontline institutions are having a hard time claiming PhilHealth reimbursements due to tedious documentation technicalities.

Poe reminded PhilHealth authorities that under Administrative Order No. 23 dated Feb. 21, 2020 of the Office of the President, all national government agencies are directed to hasten the reform of their processes in order to eliminate over-regulation. They shall retain only such steps, procedures and requirements as may be necessary to fulfill their legal mandates and policy objectives. All processes in excess, including those which are redundant or burdensome to the public shall be deemed manifestation of overregulation and shall be removed accordingly.

Poe noted that even the President himself has instructed due reimbursement to hospitals. "Buhay ang patuloy na ibinubuwis ng ating mga kababayan sa bawat araw ng pandemya. Walang lugar ang patuloy na panggigipit at pagpapabaya," Poe said.

"We must assist our frontline healthcare institutions in the same efficacious way that our people expect them to diligently attend to their patients," she added. Earlier, at least 22 provinces reported high intensive care unit bed utilization rates and nine provinces with high isolation bed utilization rates.

CALAMBA CITY, (PIA) - Construction of the Northern Tagalog Regional Hospital (NTRH) will finally begin after Department of Health (DOH) - CALABARZON (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, Quezon) Assistant Regional Director Paula Paz Sydiongco and Rizal Second District Rep. Juan Fidel Felipe Nograles led the groundbreaking last April 23.

Located in Montalban town, NTRH is a two-storey Level 2 hospital with 200-bed capacity and will be constructed in a 10,000 square meter lot purchased by the municipal government.

"Hindi na pupunta pa ng Metro Manila ang ating mga kababayan upang makapagpagamot at makakuha ng mas magandang serbisyong medikal dahil ang ospital na ito ang siyang tugugon sa lahat ng kanilang pangangailangan," Sydiongco said, emphasizing the importance of the health facility in improving the healthcare service in the province,

[Our fellowmen no longer need to go to Metro Manila to get better medical services because this hospital will provide their needs.] Meanwhile, Rep. Nograles expressed his confidence that the national hospital to be managed by the DOH-CALABARZON will improve the healthcare system in their province especially during the pandemic.

"It's a national hospital na pangangasiwaan ng DOH-CALABAR-

ZON kaya makakasiguro tayong mas mataas ang kalidad ng serbisyong medikal at teknolohiya na maibibigay nito. Magkakaroon din ito ng "Infectious Disease Laboratory," na mangangasiwa sa lahat ng mga kaso kaugnay ng COVID at iba pang nakakahawang sakit," he added.

[This is a national hospital which will be managed by the DOH-CALABARZON, so we can be sure that it will provide quality medical services and technology. It will also have an Infectious Disease Laboratory which will oversee all cases related to COVID and other infectious diseases.]

With an initial allocation of P85 million for the first phase of the project, which consists of the construction of the Out Patient Department, Emergency Room, and the main lobby will start in August 2021 and is expected to be completed in August 2022.

The signing of the development plan and unveiling of the perspective plan were witnessed by DOH Chief of Staff, Used. Leopoldo J. Vega, DOH Rizal Provincial Team Leader Gerardo G. Mejorada, One Pacman Partylist Rep. Michael Romero, as well as officials from the provincial and municipal government.

In an official statement, the DOH-CALABARZON said the Northern Tagalog Regional Hospital will be the first DOH hospital in the province, as well as the fifth apex hospital in the region established under the tenure of Director Eduardo Janairo. (PB/DOH 4-A)

In addition, the NTF, through its TG Treat with the One COVID Referral System, along with the Department of Health - Health Facility Development Bureau and concerned agencies, shall identify target additional beds on a weekly basis that will substantially reduce health care and ICU utilization rates, determine and list specific health facilities and infrastructure to contribute these additional beds, and operationalize how these beds become functional with adequate human resources for health and equipment.

The NTF shall further engage the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority to develop training and instructional materials of available COVID-19 response frameworks to enhance the enforcement of COVID-19 strategies at the barangay level. The said materials shall be cascaded to the barangay, purok, sitio, and zone levels through the Department of the Interior and Local Government and the regional counterparts of the NTF for immediate and intensified implementation through barangay empowerment. The IATF, in the same meeting, also approved the request of the Philippine National Police, through its Air Unit, to conduct an Initial Type Rating Training for Pilots, provided that training will be done in a non-quarantine hotel. ###

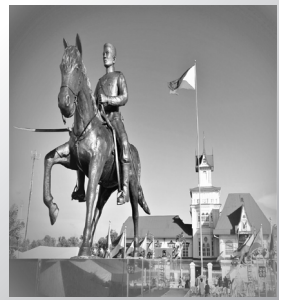

## 8,422 TOURISM WORKERS BENEFIT FROM DOT-DOLE CASH ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

The province recognizes the efforts of the tourism offices of Carmona and the cities of Tagaytay and Trece Martires for the successful applications of the Tourism Support Services (TSS) sector in their respective localities to the DOT-DOLE Cash Assistance Program.

Recipients of the financial assistance program received their certificates during the ceremonial awarding held via Zoom last April 12, 2021, where DOT Secretary Puyat expressed her hopes that such aid may provide relief to some affected tourism stakeholders. On the other hand, DOLE Secretary Silvestre Bello said that their agency will continue to support workers and help the economy bounce back.

Based from the records of DOT and DOLE, a total of 8,422 tourism workers in Cavite have already benefited; while others who applied last March will be scheduled to receive the one-time Php 5,000 cash aid. magulang ang nagsabing internet at kawalan ng gadgets ang problemang nararanasan nila sa distance learning.
