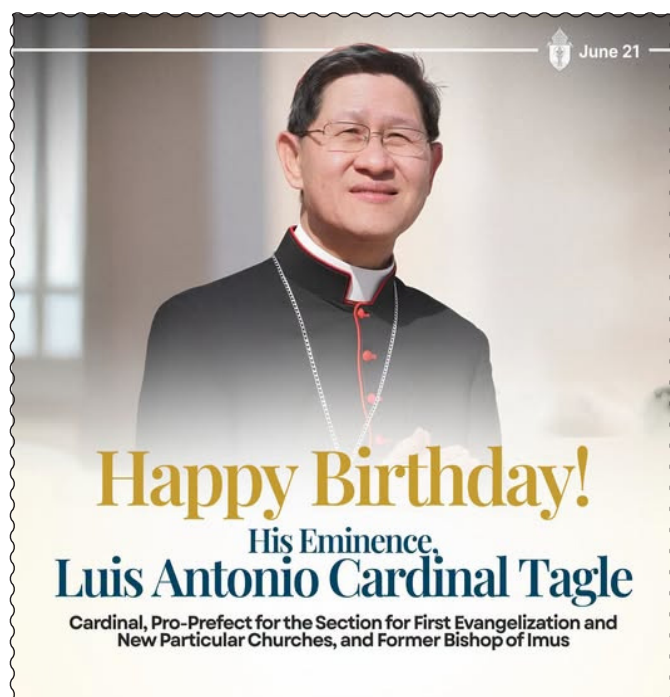

Senator Villar Calls for Stronger Accountability, Member Protection Amid PhilHealth Controversy

Senator Mark A. Villar has called on the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) to strengthen its policies, improve accountability mechanisms, and enhance the delivery of benefits to ensure that no Filipino is denied access to healthcare assistance when they need it most.

The senator issued the call following a viral case involving a widow who alleged that her family was unable to claim PhilHealth benefits after her husband, a long-time contributing member, was denied coverage due to the agency’s 24-hour confinement requirement. The incident has sparked public outrage and renewed calls to review existing policies and their implementation.

bro. Walang pamilyang dapat mabigla na hindi nila magagamit ang benepisyonang mataagal nilang pinaghirapan dahil lamang sa teknikalidad,” Villar said.

He also urged PhilHealth to undertake a comprehensive review of its claims processing system including the revocation of a 24 hour confinement policy as well as strengthening public information and education campaigns, and ensuring that members are clearly guided on the benefits and services due to them.

According to Villar, these reforms are necessary to prevent confusion, minimize delays, and ensure that the principles of the Universal Health Care Law are fully realized through an efficient, transparent, and member-centered healthcare delivery system of PhilHealth.

4th Leg of Cavite Service Caravan Delivers Essential Services to Caviteños

The Provincial Government of Cavite continued its commitment to bringing accessible and responsive public service closer to communities as the Cavite Service Caravan rolled out its fourth leg on June 18, at the Montano Hall in Cavite City.

Led by Governor Abeng Remulla, the service caravan further strengthened the provincial government's dedication to inclusive and people-centered governance through the delivery of various frontline services directly to Caviteños.

The one-stop caravan gathered provincial offices, national government agencies, and partner organizations to provide a comprehensive range of programs and assistance aimed at addressing the immediate needs

of residents, particularly those with limited access to government services.

Among the key services offered were free medical consultations, dental and oral health care, laboratory services such as ECG and fasting blood sugar tests, pharmacy assistance, and fluoride varnish application for children. Employment and livelihood opportunities were also highlighted through job matching activities, career coaching sessions, and assistance from participating agencies including PhilHealth, TESDA, PSA, DTI, Pag-ibig Fund and Land

Bank of the Philippines. Entrepreneurship support, co-operative assistance, and the promotion of local products through a trade fair formed part of the caravan.

Agricultural support services, including the distribution of vegetable seeds and seedlings, educational materials, and technical assistance for farmers and fisherfolk, were likewise extended during the activity.

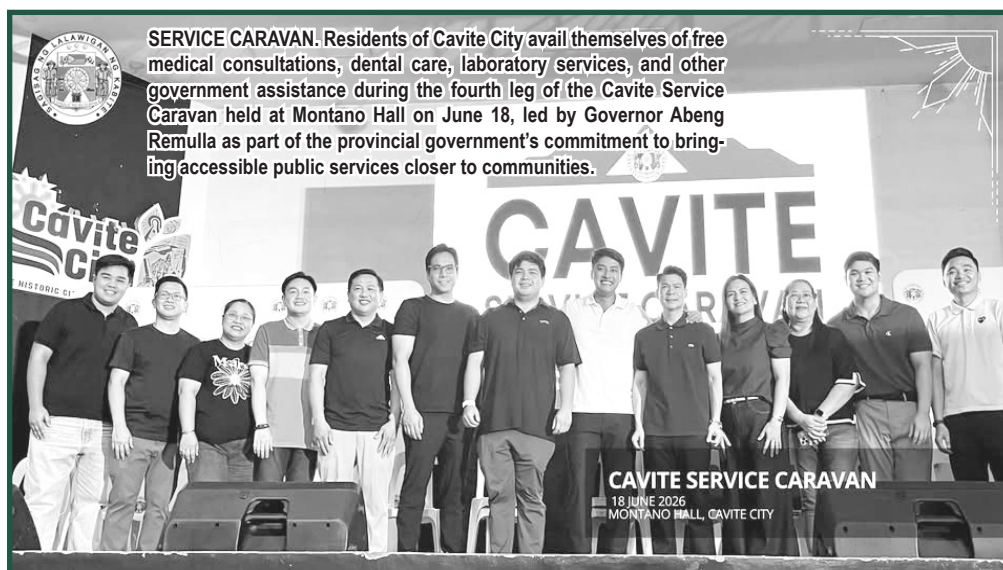
