



DTI pro-active in support to Cavite micro entrepreneurs

TRECE MARTIRES CITY, Cavite (PIA) --The Department of Trade and Industry (DTI)-Cavite had been pro-active in its advocacy in support to entrepreneurs and the consumers as well as it offers the many services of the department for free in all Negosyo Centers established in the different municipalities across the province.

Thru the Livelihood Seeding Program-Negosyo Serbisyo sa Barangay (LSP-NSB), the DTI Cavite distributed 55 starter kits to micro enterprises in the municipalities of Magallanes, Gen. Emilio Aguinaldo, and Alfonso July 19.

The program targets small businesses and reaches out to aspiring entrepreneurs in remote barangays in the province to encourage and support them to be self-sufficient, creative, and innovative as they earn

a living while pursuing their dreams for a better life.

DTI 4A Regional Director Marilou Q. Toledo along with DTI-Cavite Provincial Director Revelyn Cortez led the distribution of the starter kits such as additional wares for sari-sari stores, equipment and tools for air-conditioning services, upholstery, and coffee shop businesses.

Toledo said, under the program, a total of 86 starter kits were awarded to program beneficiaries since March this year and targets to distribute another 250 kits before the year ends.

Aside from the starter kits, micro entrepreneur beneficiaries also undergo skills training and educational know-how to equip them with the necessary knowledge before venturing on their new small business.

Currently, DTI-Cavite has conducted LSP-NSB in 13 barangays out of its 50 targets this year.

Banks must take responsibility for their cash agent--Poe

Holding banks accountable for the actions of their cash agents will provide better protection for consumers, especially those who rely on the "padala" of their relatives to help them get by during these trying times.

Sen. Grace Poe said the central bank's push for financial inclusion will benefit from the necessary safeguards and encourage more to consider tapping the services of formal channels.

"Many of our countrymen are intimidated to go to banks, that's why there is this informal economy and underground lenders. Even if the terms aren't good, they gravitate toward them out of familiarity," Poe said.

At the hearing on proposals for a Bangko sa Baryo led by the Senate committee on banks, financial institutions and currencies, the Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas (BSP) said there are 17,000 cash agents in the country now serving 79 percent of the country that suggests 21 percent remain unserved. The BSP said that 13 banks have cash agent operations and it is purely up to the banks on how they would choose their cash agents based on their selection criteria. While the BSP requires banks to get its approval when getting cash agents, the choice of which cash agents to get and the parameters of their engagement also rest with the banks.

OFFICIAL STATEMENT IN RESPONSE TO THE ISSUE SURROUNDING THE PHILIPPINE HEALTH INSURANCE CORPORATION

Secretary Francisco T. Duque III issued a statement in response to the issue of fraud surrounding the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth):

"I am deeply disappointed about the recent events surrounding PhilHealth and WellMed. PhilHealth was founded with the vision of providing Filipinos with universal health coverage because it is our belief, as public health practitioners, that financial status should never hinder any Filipino from receiving quality health service. For the system to be taken advantage of and used in corruption is utterly unacceptable. These nefarious activities must end and PhilHealth should further strengthen its zero tolerance policy on overpayments.

As the Health Secretary and ex-officio Chairman of PhilHealth, I am warning all health providers and PhilHealth officials in the strongest possible terms: do not cheat the system nor even attempt to do it. Tama na ang hocus pocus. Maraming Pilipinong may sakit ang umaasa sa tulong na ibinibigay ng PhilHealth. I will ensure that justice will be served to those who defraud the system.

President Rodrigo Duterte has instructed for a clean slate in PhilHealth, hence I have ordered a revamp of PhilHealth's accreditation committee. All false claims are to be investigated and when warranted, charges will be filed. Board members have also been asked to submit their courtesy resignation upon the order of the President.

Moving forward, I have instructed my colleagues at the Department of Health to ensure anti-corruption measures are in place for the implementation of the Universal Health Care as we write the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR). This is to highlight the provisions in the UHC Act that were intended to improve the health financing system.

I am grateful to President Rodrigo Duterte for his robust leadership and swift action in this matter. I call for all of us to work together — the medical community, health providers, government units in the national and local levels, and the Filipino people — to fix the system and put an end to corruption and fraud."

TESDA sees influx of domestic workers this year

MANILA – The Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA) is anticipating more applicants for domestic work assessment this year compared to 2020.

The agency announced in a news release on Saturday that it has already assessed 54,233 domestic work applicants just halfway into the year.

The total is higher by 7,980 compared to the 46,253 assessed applicants in 2020.

Secretary Isidro Lapeña explained that the rise is made possible by the accessible services provided by TESDA and the considerations made by the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-EID).

During the height of the restricted community quarantine last year, TESDA launched the online registration for assessment for outbound overseas workers to ease the process.

A National Certificate (NC) is one of the requirements for a Filipino to work overseas.

IMUS CITY, Cavite (PIA) --The city government thru the City Agriculture Office (CAO) developed a communal garden that will serve as small farms in subdivisions and managed by its residents.

City Agriculturist Robert Marges spearheaded the initiative at Summer Marges explained that the communal garden will follow a democratic food production scheme where residents choose the crops they will plant.

The CAO also conducts basic gardening seminars to prepare community volunteers and distribute seedlings for free as requested by residents to jumpstart farming in villages.

"The communal garden will help build a good community, add to the promotion of a healthy lifestyle, and will give therapeutic benefits to residents affected by the quarantine lockdown thru the development of a productive hobby," said Marges.

He added that thru the communal garden, residents will be equipped with agricultural skills such as crops production using sustainable methods that in turn can provide economic support during pandemic.

Another subdivision in the city, the Palace Athena Classic is also being prepared for the establishment of a communal garden, said Marges.

He also revealed that CAO will launch "Agri-Mustahan," a program that will be streamed live on Facebook every last Friday of the month, focusing on agricultural developments, issues, and other information that will benefit local farmers.

GSIS now rents out housing units with lessee given option to buy

PASAY CITY -- The Government Service Insurance System (GSIS) is now offering its housing units for lease. Under the scheme, GSIS will rent out its housing units to interested parties who will be given the priority to purchase it any time during the lease agreement.

"Sa ilalim ng programang ito, prioridad ng GSIS ang mga kasalukuyang naninirahan sa residential properties ng GSIS upang magkaroon sila ng pagkakataong maging lehitimo ang pamamalagi doon at tuluyang mabili ang kanilang tinitirhan. Hindi natin hahayaang tuluyan silang mawalan ng tahanan mauwian lalo na ngayong nasa gitna pa rin tayo ng pandemya," GSIS President and General Manager Rolando Ledesma Macasaet said.

The program, dubbed "Lease With Option to Buy" (LWOB) Program, offers a lease agreement that will be valid for one year, renewable at the option of GSIS. If the unit is occupied, the occupant will be given the priority to lease with an option to buy the property. If the property is unoccupied, it will be open for rental to anyone who will qualify for the program. To qualify for the program, an interested lessee must be a Filipino citizen who is legally authorized to enter into a lease agreement and financially capable to pay rental obligations.

If lessees will opt to buy the property, they must submit an option-to-



buy proposal for approval of GSIS. The purchase amount is equivalent to the current market value of the property at the time of approval or any offer received for same property, whichever is higher.

"Prospective lessees only need to submit a properly accomplished application form and two valid government-issued identification (ID) cards," Macasaet added. (GSIS)

CARMONA BEST PRACTICES (PERSONS WITH DISABILITY)

Comprehensive Approach Responsive Education and Rehabilitation Program at Tele-Rehabilitation Program ng Persons with Disability Affairs Office (PDAO)

One of the aspirations of the Local Government is to promote the rights of the disabled. Through Persons with Disability Affairs Office (PDAO), the Town Government has launched various programs and projects for sector members. This includes the educational and rehabilitation programs under the Comprehensive Approach Responsive Education and Rehabilitation Program or CAREER that started in the year 2008. The goal of CAREER is to shape the personality, and academic and adaptive skills of individuals with disabilities so that they can graduate from Kindergarten to College.

These students can be placed in a Center-based program or Normalization program depending on their needs and according to the evaluation of developmental pediatric doctors or government doctors.

Center-based program puts students who more need to strengthen adaptive skills. Meanwhile, the Normalization program puts students who are ready for the academic program of the Department of Education, a shadow or monitoring teacher. But due to the change caused by the pandemic, an online tutorial class was launched where 90 learners can continue their studies under a blended learning system.

Local Government assistance to disabled individuals doesn't end in learning. After they graduate, PDAO is helping through job coaching, training, and monitoring, which is part of Disability Inclusive Employment for Persons with Disability.

Aside from education and employment programs, one of the main services provided by PDAO is helping with the recovery or development of the disabled. Due to the limitations of physical training caused by the pandemic, PDAO launched the TELEREHABILITATION PROGRAM in collaboration with De La Salle Medical and Health Sciences Institute (DLSMHSI) on July 2020.

Under this, clients receive free Occupational, Physical, and Speech Therapy. Intern therapists with clinical preceptor teach clients along with their parents or guardians exercises that will help with their physical, sensory, cognitive, and emotional needs.

The Information Technology Unit that provides computer and internet free use in Tech4Ed Centers in every barangay to clients without gadgets or internet connection is also a part of this program.

Poe's committee is looking at formalizing accountabilities and making banks take responsibility for their cash agents by spelling out safeguards in the proposed law.

"We must ensure full accountability as we seek to institutionalize the inclusion of cash agents in serving the unbanked," Poe said.

Aside from the "padala" to relatives within the Philippines, overseas Filipino workers (OFWs) will also benefit from such safeguards.

The Philippine Statistics Authority estimated the number of OFWs at 2.2 million in 2019 and their remittances amounted to over \$33.5 billion. Some of them would still require the services of a cash agent if their hometown is not currently serviced by a bank as a number of towns still remain unserved.

Red Cross vax program continues despite rains

MANILA – Torrential rain and flooding will not stop the Philippine Red Cross (PRC) from vaccinating as many people as it can.

Even at the height of the combined rainfall caused by Typhoon Fabian and habagat (southwest monsoon), PRC's Bakuna Centers continue to go full speed with its vaccination program.

"Hindi tayo titigil (We will not stop). As long as there are vaccine doses, the men and women of the Philippine Red Cross will continue to vaccinate people come hell or high water. We just received 5,000 Sinovac doses from the government ready for administration. We are waiting for additional doses to increase the implementation of the program. right must be kept right; what is wrong must be set right."

He reiterated the need for fiscal discipline - a trait that the government can learn from the private sector to maximize limited resources - and doing away with wasteful and unnecessary government spending.

The nation is struggling to recover from its harsh beating from the pandemic, ranking second to the last out of 53 economies in terms of resilience to the COVID-19 pandemic, he noted at the meeting of the Rotary Club of Alabang Madrigal Business Park.

On the other hand, he pointed out a recent Social Weather Stations survey showed 48% of Filipino families consider themselves poor; while some 4.2 million Filipinos experienced hunger in the past three months; and jobless Filipinos hit 4.14 million in April 2021.

Lacson said it is imperative for the next administration to address the challenges of the pandemic and eradicate graft and corruption. "The top priority in these trying times is the pandemic. There are things to be attended to with urgency. For example, we have not been proactive in responding to the pandemic that hit us way back in January 2020," he said.

He added it is high time the government adopt a proactive approach in addressing the pandemic and its effects, and learn from the lessons of early 2020, when it allowed the virus to spread due to its lack of efficient contact tracing and failure to bar the entry of visitors from Mainland China.

On the other hand, he said another priority should be eradicating graft and corruption, with leaders practicing leadership by example, which he said is second to none.

He recalled that when he headed the Philippine National Police from 1999 to 2001, he solved the problems of the PNP with a disciplined and reformed police force: "no more 'kotong' cops in the streets, no kickbacks in procurement under a strictly supervised 'no-take policy' imposed from top to bottom."

"After I got elected as a senator of the Republic, whenever I am confronted with a similar question about the biggest problem of government, my response has not changed - it is government, bad government. And, the solution lies in the face of the problem itself - it is called good government," he said.

"Unless government officials see people at the top practicing what they preach, any effort to fight graft and corruption will not succeed," he added.

said in a news release.

As of Sunday, PRC has already vaccinated 48,742 people -- 45,560 through the 13 Bakuna Centers and the rest via the three mobile vaccine centers, also called the Bakuna Bus

PRC is adamant in helping the government reach its vaccination goals, establishing inoculation hubs in the National Capital Region

and the provinces of Bulacan, Tarlac, Olongapo, Cavite, and Iligan in Mindanao. Another center is set to open along EDSA near Boni Avenue and the PRC national headquarters in Mandaluyong City.

PRC also vaccinated 829 overseas Filipino workers under the government's Moderna initiative while 758 were inoculated under the PRC Moderna Program. (PR)

EID allowed the resumption of face-to-face competency assessment.
“We want to ensure that our kababayans (compatriots) who need to undergo assessment would not have any difficulty in finding an assessment center. In fact, from May to June this year, we opened additional as-sessment centers in the NCR (National Capital Region), Region III and Region IV-A,” he added.
From the total number of assessed domestic

work graduates from January to June this year, 49,283 were certified which is equivalent to a 90.87% certification rate.
Meanwhile, due to the continuing pandemic, La-peña is reminding qualified outbound domestic workers to avail the agency’s existing Online Portfolio Assessment. Leonila De Mesa, an outbound overseas worker, secured her NC after passing her Portfolio Assessment in October last year.
She lauded TESDA for extending the right ser-



vices for OFWs.
“I want to thank Secretary Lapeña and every-one in TESDA for answering my queries and helping me all throughout the process. You taught and guided me on what to do and what’s good for me when I work abroad,” she said in a news release. (PR)
