NIA-Calabarzon to sell rice at P29 per kilo

CALAMBA CITY, Laguna – The National Irrigation Administration (NIA) in Region 4A (Calabarzon) will offer rice at PHP29 per kilogram (kg) starting in August, following a harvest under its rice contract farming program for Cavite and Batangas irrigators' associations.

Vince Santoalla, NIA-4A's public relations officer, confirmed in a phone interview on Wednesday that the Cavite-Batangas Irrigation Management Office (IMO) has begun packaging rice in 10-kg bags, which will be sold at PHP290 each.

The palay (un-husked rice) harvest represents the third cropping cycle from NIA's pilot contract

farming program, which covered 10 hectares in July out of the 100 hectares contracted farm lots with various irrigators' associations within the Cavite-Batangas area.

The bulk of the harvest is expected to be available in August and September from additional areas, Santoalla added.

In Sariaya, Quezon, he said, a total of 10,435 kilograms of palay were harvested from a 3.14-hectare area on July 26-27 under a contract agreement with the Nagkakaisang Magsasaka Samahan ng Magpapatubig, Inc. This will undergo drying and milling before being sold.

Harvesting is an-

ticipated to begin in late August or early September for a 79-hectare farm in Infanta, Quezon contracted and cultivated by Agos River Farmer Irrigators Association, Inc.,

Santoalla added.

Meanwhile, farmers in Laguna are preparing to plant for the wet cropping season.

Under the contract

farming agreement, NIA allocates PHP100,000 per hectare for an anticipated yield of 5 metric tons per hectare. The irrigators' associations receive an initial

PHP50,000 per hectare for land preparation, planting materials, fertilizers, and other expenses until harvest.

The NIA purchases

PhilHealth urged to cover leptospirosis treatment for disaster victims

MANILA – Deputy Majority Leader and ACT-CIS Party-list Representative Erwin Tulfo on Tuesday called on the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) to step up and cover the costs of medical treatment for leptospirosis and tetanus in the light of natural disasters and other challenges frequently occurring in the nation.

Under House Resolution No. 1811 he and four colleagues filed on Monday,

PhilHealth is being required to ensure that victims of natural calamities do not face additional hardships in accessing treatment for these serious diseases by covering the medical expenses.

“The intervention is crucial as it provides to those who are already burdened by the trauma and loss caused by the disaster,” Tulfo said in his privilege speech.

He said the challenge of accessing and affording necessary medical treatment can become over-

whelming for many victims after the disasters.

“As a result, there is an urgent need to address this gap in our disaster response strategy,” he said.

Tulfo’s co-authors include fellow ACT-CIS Party-List Reps. Edvic Yap and Jocelyn Tulfo, Benguet Lone District Rep. Eric Go Yap and Quezon City 2nd District Rep. Ralph Wendel Tulfo.

“It is essential that we act on this matter not only out of compassion but

also out of a sense of justice. No one should have to struggle with life-threatening diseases simply because they are already suffering from the effects of a disaster,” he said.

The Deputy Majority Leader urged his colleagues to reaffirm their commitment to safeguarding the health and well-being of the Filipino people, especially those who find themselves in the most vulnerable positions by addressing the medical needs of disaster victims./source: (PNA)

Public hearing on Calabarzon minimum wage adjustment set

MANILA – The Regional Tripartite Wages and Productivity Board (RTWPB) - Calabarzon will hold a public consultation on a possible minimum wage adjustment in the region next week.

In an advisory Thursday, the wage board said the public consultation would be held on Aug. 8 at 10 a.m. at the 2nd Floor Locator's Hall of the First Cavite Industrial Estate

(FCIE) Administration Office in Dasmariñas City, Cavite.

Calabarzon is composed of the provinces of Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal and Quezon.

“The purpose of this consultation is to obtain comprehensive feedback

from both management and labor representatives to ensure the formulation of fair and effective wage policies for Calabarzon,” the wage

board said.

The RTWPB-Calabarzon called on all stakeholders including labor groups, employers to join the public consultations.

The last wage adjustment in Calabarzon took effect on Sept. 24, 2023.

Wage Order No. IVA-20 provided a wage increase ranging from PHP35 to PHP50 for private sector workers.

Cayetano calls out DPWH over incomplete flood control projects amid Typhoon Carina

The effects of Typhoon Carina could have been mitigated if the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) had completed its long overdue flood control projects, according to Senator Alan Peter Cayetano.

This came after Metro Manila and 5 neighboring provinces were placed under a state of calamity after being submerged by heavy flooding due to the typhoon, affecting 882,861 individuals or 183,464 families from 686 barangays nationwide as of July 24, 2024.

“It’s a direct result of years of inaction on crucial flood control projects. This delay isn’t just a failure, it’s a disservice to our communities that are now left unprotected and vulnerable,” Cayetano said on July 26, 2024.

During last year’s Senate hearing on the 2024 national budget, Cayetano criticized the DPWH for years of delays in completing crucial flood control

projects. He questioned the allocation of resources to these unfinished projects and suggested shifting efforts towards new infrastructure.

“Natuklasan n’ung hearing na y’ung [na] may flood control part na hindi tinuloy ng gobyerno. And this was more than 10 years ago and after that I thought maaayos na lahat,” he said at the time.

With the rainy season underway and flooding in the metropolis being a recurring

issue, Cayetano questioned the DPWH’s maintenance and rehabilitation budget, which exceeds P200 billion – about a third of its total budget of P737 billion – and how these projects have failed to address the issue.

“We’re not building better, we’re maintaining and rehabilitating. You’re not putting money into building more networks, you’re putting money into maintaining it,” he said.

“Is there something wrong with the kind of public works we do? Kasi kung parang one is to one na y’ung bago sa pine-preserve mo, ibig sabihin, either hindi maganda y’ung pagkagawa or napakaluma na,” he added.

Cayetano, as chair of Senate on Science and Technology, also urged the Philippine Institute of Volcanology and Seismology (PHIVOLCS) in its modernization program to strengthen its hazard mapping to assist the DPWH in



goods with the support of Mayor Dino Chua, the municipal council, and Board Member Davey Chua.

On the second day in Cavite City, food packs were distributed to 2,867 beneficiaries across four distribution sites, with Mayor Denver Chua and local officials providing hands-on assistance.

In Kawit, a second round of relief distribution

was held at Freedom Park, where another batch of fisherfolk received aid.

The coordinated efforts during these simultaneous distribution activities were further bolstered by the Office of the Provincial Agriculturist, the Provincial Government-Cavite Office of Public Safety, and the Municipal Agriculturist Offices, all working in close collaboration with the respective LGUs.

Meanwhile, the Incident Management Team continues to play a proactive role in consolidating information, pooling resources, and organizing the overall

operational response to the incident.

The Office of the Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Officer (OPENRO), in cooperation with the Philippine Coast Guard and DENR-Cavite, is actively conducting shore assessments along the affected coastal areas. Additionally, the OPSWDO and the Office of the Provincial Tourism Officer are conducting Rapid Disaster Assessment and Needs Analysis (RDANA) to evaluate the oil spill's impact on residents’ livelihoods, living conditions, and local tourism establishments. The funds will help workers access Health Maintenance Organization (HMO) or HMO-type benefits, she said. The last time government worker salaries were increased was in 2023, the final phase of the Salary Standardization Law of 2019 that began in 2020. (PIA-NCR)

Salary of gov't employees to be increased –DBM

MANILA (PIA) — Department of Budget and Management (DBM) Secretary Amenah Pangandaman said on Thursday that the DBM is currently drafting an executive order to detail the salary increase announced

by President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr. in his recent State of the Nation Address.

The raises will be phased in over four years, from 2025 through 2027, Pangandaman said. The DBM has allocated P70 billion in the 2025 national

budget to cover the initial wage hike tranche.

The wage hike is expected to benefit over 1.3 million government workers, including sub-professionals, professionals such as teachers and lawyers, and
