

Doctors say e-cigs, vapes as risky as regular cigarettes

MANILA – Medical associations decried as fake news claims that e-cigarettes and vapes are healthier alternatives to regular cigarettes.

Dr. Michael Caampued of the Philippine Society of Public Health Physicians, in a news release on Monday, said it's dangerous to brand the novel products as helpful to those who want to stop cigarette smoking while there are still no high-quality evidence to back the claim.

"E-cigarettes and vapes should not immediately be viewed as healthier alternatives to cigarettes," he said.

Dr. Corry Avanceña of the Philippine Pediatric Society said the cigarette alternatives emit aerosols containing chemicals that harm the lungs of the users and even of those around them.

She said there have been cases of e-cigarette or vaping product use-associated lung injury (EVALI) in other countries while the Philippines recorded its first case in 2019.

"The best way to quit smoking is through a mix of safe and doctor-recommended methods, like nicotine replacement therapy, counseling, and family support," Avanceña advised. "You shouldn't replace an addiction with another addiction."

Dangerous

The medical associations also expressed their concerns against bills in Congress that seemingly seek to regulate the sale, promotion and distribution of vapes and e-cigarettes.

"In reality, the proposed measure in Congress on vapes and e-cigarettes weakens our policy milestone in to-

bacco control set by the sin tax law," Caampued said.

House Bill 9007, or the Non-Combustible Nicotine Delivery Systems Act, was recently approved on final reading in the House of Representatives. A similar measure will be deliberated in the Senate.

The bill seeks to regulate the manufacture, importation, sale, distribution, use, advertisement, promotion and sponsorship of electronic nicotine and non-nicotine delivery systems (ENNDS), and heated tobacco products (HTPs).

Among the key provisions are setting the minimum allowable age for the purchase, sale, and use of ENNDS or HTPs to 18 years old and allowing the sale or distribution of ENNDS or HTPs through the Internet subject to safeguards also for those aged 18 and above.

"If we are to regulate a product that is this dynamic, we should not weaken regulation, but rather encourage continuous review of evidence and afford the FDA (Food and Drug Administration) stronger regulatory roles," Caampued said. "We should not introduce policies that will weaken existing regulations on the sale, promotion, distribution, and use of vapes and e-cigarettes."

No Tobacco Day

Meanwhile, the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority (MMDA) is joining the observance of World No Tobacco Day on Monday, saying they are committed to help in raising awareness on tobacco control, highlighting the ill effects of smoking to the public.

"We must unceasingly promote a healthier environment and encourage tobacco users to quit smoking as the

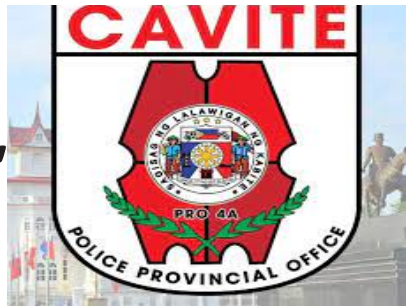

CAVITE PNP YIELDS 383 ARRESTS IN WEEKLY ANTI- CRIMINALITY DRIVE AND RECORDED 22, 618 GCQ VIOLATORS



Camp BGen Pan-taleon Garcia, Imus City, Cavite- Cavite Police Provincial Office under the leadership of Provincial Director, PCOL MARLON R SANTOS has achieved 383 arrests in their Weekly Anti-Criminality Drive and recorded 22,618 GCQ Violators from May 24-30, 2021. Out of 111 buy-busts and other drug related operations, Cavite Police neutralized 6 drug suspects in an armed encounter during buy-busts operation conducted in Bacoar City, Imus City, Alfonso, GMA, Mendez, Rosario and arrested 177 others seizing a total of 6 pieces of medium and 491 pieces of small heat-sealed transparent plastic sachet containing white crystalline substance suspected as shabu, 40 SHTPS of dried leaves suspected as Marijuana, seven short firearms (three units of caliber .45, two units of caliber .38 and one unit of caliber 357) and ammunitions, drug money and other drug paraphernalia.

Cavite Police has crackdown seventeen (17) Most Wanted Persons listed in the Regional, Provincial and City/Municipal Level) and forty-nine (49) other wanted persons. Notable among these were the arrest of Top 5, Top 6, Top 13, 16 in Police Regional Office CALABARZON for the crime of Murder, Rape Cases and Violation of PD 1689 (Swindling/Estafa) and another Top Nr. 4 and Top 7 MWP in Cavite Police Provincial Office for the crime of Rape and Violation of Sec. 11 Art. II of RA 9165 (Dangerous Drug Act of 2002).

As police intensifies its efforts on anti-illegal gambling operations, one hundred seventeen (117) individuals were arrested while engaging in illegal cockfighting "Tupada" and Online Sabong; playing illegal card games "Pusoy" and "Tong-its"; illegal coin games "Cara y Cruz"; and Bingo Games. Confiscated were cash money amounting to Php 17,793.00 in different denomination as bet money. Twenty-three other suspects were arrested for their involvement in various crime incidents.

In the implemen-

tation of Minimum Public Health Safety (MPHS) Protocols during GCQ, Cavite PNP recorded 22,618 violators for not wearing face masks, social distancing, and violation of curfew hours. Cavite Police gave warning to 19,709 violators, 2,077 paid fines, 1,532 undergone community services and 20 others were charged for other criminal offense. the statement include Archbishop Romulo Valles of the Catholic Bishops' Conference of the Philippines; Bishop Rhee Timbang, head of the Iglesia Filipina Independiente; Bishop Reuel Norman Marigza, National Council of Churches in the Philippines; and Bishop Noel Pantoja, national president of the Philippine Council of Evangelical Churches.

Archbishop Angelito Lampon of the CBCP's Commission on Ecumenical Affairs; Archbishop Antonio Ledesma of the CBCP's Commission on Mutual Relations; Bishop Melzar Labuntog, general secretary of the United Church of Christ in the Philippines; Bishop Vicente Salvador Ballesteros of IFI Diocese of Greater Manila Area; and Rev. Justice Raoul Victorino, chairperson of Iglesia Unida Ekyumenikal.

Over the past two years of interfaith meetings, Lampon said the “historic document” showed “a gesture of genuine dialogue and solidarity”.

It is also “a step towards healing not only among Christian brothers and sisters but also across the nation,” he said.

The churches then reaffirmed their “preferential option for the poor” and their commitment to protect the exploited and the oppressed.

They also vowed to defend the sacredness of life and the fundamental rights of every human being, support gender equality in morally legitimate

assistance of P15,000 plus essential goods as they start their new life in the new community.

Likewise, Naic Mayor or Junio Dualan was present during the activity to welcome the families to the town and assured LGU's support for their needs particularly in terms of livelihood.

Meanwhile, 40 families still remain in the city of Dasmariñas in which 20 of them are temporarily renting while the other 20 are still sheltered in the covered court.

According to Baran-

gay Sta. Cruz 1 Head Kirby Andrada, the transfer of these families will take about two to three months, thus they will continue in supporting them particularly those staying in the covered court.

In an agreement with the National Housing Authority (NHA), the Naic LGU provided relocation sites for displaced families from neighboring cities and towns in the province, and in NCR who are affected by disasters like fire, typhoons and even for right of way on government projects like road

construction and widening.

A unit has a floor area of 36-square meters, and lot area of 40-square meters with pre-approved installation for electric power, water supply, and the required understanding with the NHA.

public deals with stress especially during this Covid-19 pandemic," MMDA Chair Benhur Abalos said in another news release.

The MMDA is working with all local government units in Metro Manila in monitoring public compliance on advertising and promotion, selling and display, and use of tobacco in public establishments, particularly near school premises.

"We really have to work hand-in-hand. Hence, we encourage all the Metro Manila mayors to strictly enforce their respective ordinances prohibiting smoking in public places," he added.

Smoking is prohibited in schools, playgrounds, health facilities, stairwells, public utility vehicles, transportation terminals, food preparation areas, among others.

Dr. Loida Alzona, Director of the MMDA Health and Environmental Protection Office, urged all smokers to permanently quit tobacco consumption as it contributes to

serious health problems.

"There is a need to protect our present and future generations from the devastating consequences of tobacco use. Let me also remind the public that second-hand smoke is as dangerous as smoking," she stressed.

To further promote smoke-free public transportation terminals, “No Smoking” signages will be posted in all Edsa Busway stations in coordination with the Department of Transportation.

World No Tobacco Day, a global campaign initiated by the World Health Organization, is celebrated annually every 31st of May. (PR)

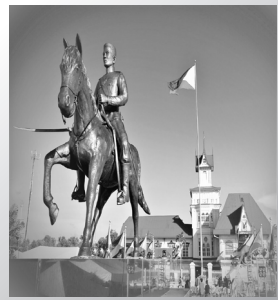
