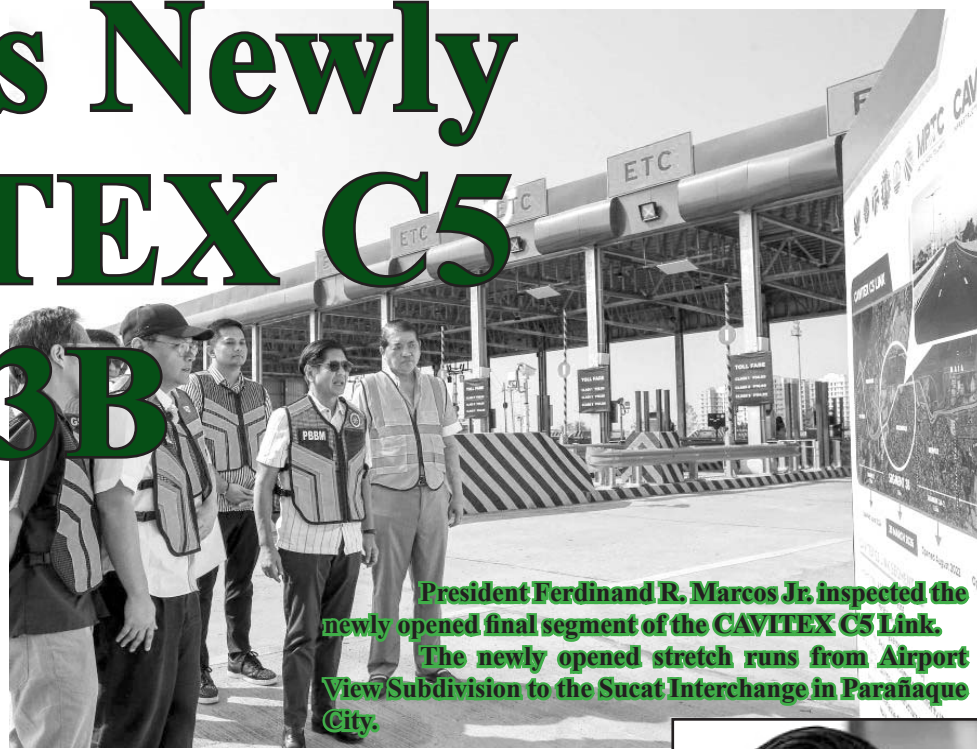

## Cayetano to Filipino youth: Crises train you for future leadership

As the season of end-of-school-year rites come in full swing amid the oil crisis, Senate Minority Leader Alan Peter Cayetano on Tuesday encouraged young Filipinos to treat the many crises their generation have lived through as “train-

ing” for future leadership. Cayetano told this to hundreds of graduating and moving-up students, together with their parents, in the City of Taguig on March 31, 2026.

He explained that effective leaders often draw their drive and heart for ser-

vice from what they lacked or the hardships they endured.

## GSIS offers 'Balik Ginhawa' loan moratorium to members, pensioners

PASIG CITY (PIA) — State insurance fund, Government Service Insurance System (GSIS), is offering the 'Balik Ginhawa' program to help ease the financial burden of its members and pensioners amid the fuel crisis.

While loan deductions continue, GSIS will refund the three months' loan payments, covering December 2025 until February 2026.

Funds will be credited back to the member's account for immediate use.

Through the program, GSIS explained that loan terms will be extended

ed by three months with no added interest or penalties.

The voluntary program is applicable via the GSIS Touch App. Log in to the app and choose "Member's Request Form for Loans." Select "Loan Moratorium Through Refund." Check and confirm the Member's Data.

After validating the data, select the loans to be included in the moratorium, then click the "Submit" button.

The refund will be credited to the member's account once the application is approved via the GSIS

## PRESYO, PINABABA: DILG PUSHES KADIWA AS DIRECT RELIEF FOR FILIPINO FAMILIES

The Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) urged Filipinos to support and purchase affordable goods from KADIWA outlets now operating in 784 local government units (LGUs) nationwide, as the government steps up efforts to cushion the impact of rising fuel costs on basic commodities.

In line with the directive of President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr. following the declaration of a National Energy State of Emergency, KADIWA ng Pangulo continues to provide direct access to low-cost food and essential goods.

KADIWA, or Katuwang sa Diwa at Gawa para sa Masaganang Ani at Mataas na Kita, operates as a direct producer-to-consumer market under the Department of Agriculture, cutting layers in the supply chain to lower prices while increasing the income of farmers, fisherfolk, and micro, small, and medium enterprises.

The DILG called on LGUs to identify and secure strategic locations for KADIWA sites to ensure sustained access to fresh, affordable products in communities.

Consumers can purchase rice, vegetables, fruits, processed food, non-food items, and ready-to-eat meals at reduced prices, with P20-per-kilo rice available for vulnerable sectors.

Lim; MPTC President and CEO Gilbert Santa Maria; and Transportation Undersecretary Steve Pastor. Segment 3B completes the 7.7-kilometer CAVITEX C5 Link. It connects Manila-Cavite Expressway (CAVITEX) to C5 Road in Taguig City, reducing travel time from the usual 1.5 hours to just 15 minutes. The opening follows the earlier completion of Segment 3A-1 (C5 Flyover to Merville), Segment 3A-2 (Merville to RSG and Airport View), and Segment 2 (Sucat Interchange to R1 Expressway) between 2019 and 2024.

The CAVITEX C5 Link provides efficient access to NAlA and C5, via key interchanges at the R1 Expressway (Coastal Road), Sucat Road (Dr. A Santos Avenue), and C.P. Garcia Avenue (C5 Road). The expressway is projected to serve around 36,000 motorists daily. By diverting heavy traffic, including commercial trucks, the expressway eases congestion on major arterial roads across Cavite and southern Metro Manila. It also strengthens the logistics link between the industrial hubs of Cavite and the commercial centers of the National Capital Region, supporting regional economic growth.

Segment 3B will be free for all classes until further announcement. Motorists will only pay the existing toll fees for CAVITEX C5 Link Segments 2, 3A-1, and 3A-2. Any updates will be announced by the Toll Regulatory Board (TRB) in coordination with CAVITEX management. Designed as a six-lane expressway (three lanes per direction), the at-grade section will temporarily operate with four lanes (two lanes per direction) while Right-of-Way (ROW) concerns are being addressed. Once the DPWH acquires the pending ROW, the remaining

## PH LAUNCHES INTEGRATED DISASTER INFO WEBSITE

MANILA – The government launched on Monday an integrated website containing disaster-related information.

Called "Handa: The Integrated Platform for Preparedness, Early Warning, and Response," the website is accessible via [handa.georisk.gov.ph](http://handa.georisk.gov.ph).

The Department of Science and Technology (DOST), through the Philippine Institute of Volcanology and Seismology (Phivolcs),

led the integration of existing platforms into a unified system for early warning, disaster preparedness and response.

During the website launch in Quezon City, DOST Secretary Renato Solidum Jr. said the integrated platform seeks to bridge the gap in real-time risk intelligence.

"One of the most persistent challenges in disaster risk reduction is not the absence of data but the frag-

mentation of information," he said.

"Across institutions, we generate vast and valuable datasets on hazards, exposure and vulnerability. Often, these remain dispersed across systems, limiting their full potential," Solidum continued.

The website integrates advisories from Phivolcs, weather bureau and the mines and geosciences bureau.

It also offers near

real-time monitoring, location-based alerts, AI-assisted tools and interactive dashboards.

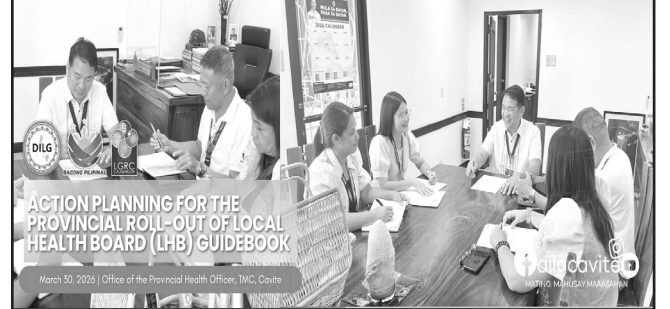
"We developed tools, making risk information more accessible to communities," Solidum said.

Users can report incidents to accelerate response coordination and emergency operations.

They can report flooding, fires, road accidents, or other on-the-

## Bacoor City LGU pushes for community carpooling to save on fuel costs

BACOR CITY, Cavite (PIA) — The City Government of Bacoor is pushing for a community-based carpooling arrangement for its travelling residents to help reduce traffic congestion and save fuel.

In an interview last March 31, Mayor Strike Revilla said he signed city ordinances regulating community-based carpooling

arrangements as part of their bid to promote the use of private and city government-owned vehicles to help save energy and reduce traffic, especially in major thoroughfares.

To ensure the safety of car owners and passengers, the ordinance requires that vehicles to be used in the carpooling initiative must secure insurance.

"Kapag naaprubahan ito, ipapatupad natin ang carpooling system. Pero of course, i-re-require natin na mayroong insurance [ang mga sasakyan]."

Revilla added that through the ordinance, residents will adopt a carpooling scheme when travelling to help minimize expenses.

"Para makatulong tayo sa pagtitipid ng gasoli-

na at diesel, ipu-pool natin 'yung mga magkakapitbahay para makabawas sa gastos. Napakaimportante rin nitong carpooling at ibababa natin ito sa mga community at mga barangay natin."
