After eight grueling months of hard work and seemingly endless debates and public consultations since the Universal Health Care Act was signed into law in February this year, its implementing rules and regulations (IRR) is finally made public through a simple and yet meaningful ceremonial signing ceremony led by Health Secretary and PhilHealth Board Chair Francisco T. Duque III on October 10, 2019 in Manila.

In his speech, Duque said that the coming in of the IRR is a proud moment for all Filipinos, and that the (public) conversation should now progress from vision to actual execution of the vision. # **DENR working to ensure fish kill won't** affect Manila Bay rehab-Cimatu

QUEZON CITY--The Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) has assured that appropriate measures will be undertaken to make sure the recent fish kill in the Las Piñas-Paranaque Wetland Park (LPPWP) will not affect the ongoing rehabilitation efforts in Manila Bay.

In a statement, DENR Secretary Roy Cimatu said the agency is "looking deeply" into the cause of the fish kill in the protected wetland area fiscated vehicles; and no use of situated within the Manila Bay region.

> DENR-NCR Regional Executive Director Jacqueline Caancan said the water test results will be out "in the next few days."

The results, she said, would complement studies being done by experts from the Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources of the Depart-

ment of Agriculture and the city governments of Las Piñas and Paranaque. "While agriculturists initially assessed that the state of some of the fishes indicate dynamite fishing, our parameter tests on the water quality in the area could pinpoint other factors that may have contributed to the fish kill," Caancan said.

The DENR-EMB tested the LPPWP waters for dissolved oxygen, pH level, nitrates, phosphates, fecal coliform and cyanide. The results could show whether the fish died through toxic means, or through oxygen satura-

tion that is determined by the level of dissolved oxygen in the water, which is essential to sustain aquatic life

As of the morning of October 11, personnel from the DENR, the local governments of Las Piñas and Paranague, and the so-called "bakawan warriors" assigned to LPPWP had already cleared the shore of dead fish, which was causing a heavy stench in the area.

They were able to gather more than 200 sacks and over 5,000 kilograms of different marine species, such as fish, shrimps and crabs.

"The cleanup was necessary to reduce hazards to both human and environmental health." Caancan said. "We must remove the dead fish before

## **Bong Revilla proposes** 'Rescue-in-Tandem' motorcycle first responders measure to public, private hospitals

Sen. Bong Revilla on Monday proposed a measure to all public and private hospitals in the country to delegate the 'Rescue-in-Tandem' motorcycle first responders to reduce response time and improve health care in both rural and urban areas in the country

He filed a bill (S. No. 1120), "An Act Mandating All Public and Private Medical Institutions and Hospitals to Provide for Motorcycle Medical Emergency First-Responders," recognizing the urgent need to provide medical response to both medical patients and victims of vehicular accidents.

The veteran legislator pointed out that as traffic worsens in the country everyday, emergency response is often delayed because ambulances are trapped in heavy traffic jam.

In under-served and unserved far-flung and mountainous areas, many suffer serious illnesses and injuries without being attended to by medical personnel. In some areas, committed medi-

cal personnel have to walk long

distances for several hours just to service these far-flung areas.

The large fish kill appeared the next morning, with tons of various marine species crowded along a half-kilometer stretch of LPPWP's Long Island, and about half-ton spread out over Freedom Island.

Personnel from the EMB-NCR, BFAR, Philippine National Povironment offices immediately conducted an on-site inspection, identifying at least 33 marine species, including tilapia, talakitok, sapsap, lapu-lapu, eel, malakapas, crabs and shrimp.

In 2013, the LPPWP, formerly known as the Las Piñas-Paranaque Critical Habitat and Ecotourism Area, was recognized as a Wetland of International Importance by the Ramsar Convention because of the critical role it plays in the survival of various migratory bird species.

LPPWP is one of only two protected areas in the highly urbanized Metro Manila, the other being the Ninoy Aquino Parks and Wildlife Center in Quezon City. (PIA-NCR/DENR)

"That mental council would set a standard of patients' referrals, the way we [DOH] help and support the patient's mental needs which mental health care will be sustainable forever," Janairo added.

Janairo also laid out DOH Calabarzon's action plans upon the creation of the regional council.

"We will make a database to know how rampant it is [mental health problem] in Calabarzon, if we get the number, we will be able to plot the plans for our patients," he said.

"We will be able to see the needed budget required for the implementation of this program in the entire region, we can now attend to the needs of the patients as well as to integrate the universal health care program needed by the community," he added.

The DOH-led council is composed of government and non-government agencies, local health units and partner hospitals in the Calabarzon re-

The implementing rules and regulations (IRR) of Republic Act No. 11036, otherwise known as the Mental Health Act, was signed into law on June 20, 2018, and took effect on July 5, that same year

The law highlights a balanced delivery of mental health services -- both community and hospital-based -- and more focused on individuals with psychiatric, neurologic, and psychosocial health needs, and overcoming society's challenges.

Janairo urged people who experience mental health issues to "live free from stigma and discrimination".

"I'm appealing to those people not to be afraid, we have trained health workers in Calabarzon to assist you and identify your mental needs," Janairo said.

He added that medical consultation related to mental health is free of charge.

"We will organize a regional council for mental health to provide mental health services from barangay health station to rural health units up to hospitals as this will be part of the referral system under the Mental Health Act," Janairo said.

The regional council grants protection to persons availing psychiatric, neurologic and psychosocial health services.

The council will be organized after a twoday event regional mental Health Summit recently.

## 3 cops in Quezon town mayor's son slay sacked

LUCENA CITY— The three Quezon policemen who have been charged for the murder of a town mayor's son and his aide were ordered dismissed from the police service.

In a resolution dated October 17, signed by Police Regional Office 4-A Brig. General Edward Carranza, the Regional Internal Affairs Service (RIAS) ordered the dismissal from the service of former Tayabas City police commander Lt. Col. Mark Joseph Laygon and his subordinates Cpl. Lonald Sumalpong and Pat. Robert Legazpi.

The trio were found guilty of two counts of grave misconduct in connection with the killing of Christian Gayeta, the 21-year-old son of Sariaya, Quezon Mayor Marcelo Gayeta, and his aide Christopher Manalo, 38.

However, the nine other Police Non- Commissioned Officers who were administratively charged before the RIAS were exonerated. Apart from the administrative complaint, Laygo, Sumalpong and Le-

gazpi were charged with double murder by the National Bureau of Investigation before Tayabas City Prosecutor's Office.

The case is now being heard at Lucena City Regional Trial Court, Branch 53 under Judge Dennis Orendain.
