



Drug rehab center opens in Cavite under DOH-JICA program



MANILA – The Department of Health-Center for Health Development (DOH-CHD) in Calabarzon (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, Quezon) region, in partnership with Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) and the City Government of Trece Martires, has put up a Drug Abuse Treatment and Rehabilitation Center (DATRC) in Barangay Osorio.

The construction of the DOH-DATRC is a component of a JPY1.85-billion (PHP734 million) undertaking called “Consolidated Rehabilitation of Illegal Drug Users” (CARE), a bilateral project in line with the Japan-Philippines Joint Statement on Bilateral Co-

operation to combat illegal drugs, as part of the efforts to uphold public safety.

According to DOH officer-in-charge Undersecretary Leopoldo Vega, DATRC will be the apex or an end-referral of all rehabilitation centers in the country.

CHED urged to lift moratorium on new nursing programs

MANILA – A lawmaker called on the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) to lift the 11-year ban on new nursing programs in the country to provide a workforce to continue the battle against the coronavirus disease (Covid-19).

In a statement, Cavite Rep. Elpidio Barzaga warned that "the present acute and dramatic escalation" of shortage of nurses may worsen in the future both at a national and global level.

He cited the World Health Organization (WHO) report State of the World's Nursing 2020 projects that without action, there will be a shortfall of 4.6 million nurses worldwide by 2030.

He further noted that the projected shortfall of nurses in the country is expected to be 249,843 by 2030.

"It's high time that CHED lifted the 11-year-old ban on nursing programs. We're still in a pandemic



harm than good, especially since the students of Kolehiyo ng Lungsod ng Dasmariñas do not pay any fee.

The public college was established and being maintained with the funds of the city government, primarily intended to provide educational opportunities to poor but intelligent students in the city, he noted.

He said long-term planning dictates the creation of additional institutions that will cater to aspiring nurses regardless of their families' socioeconomic status.

"We cannot surrender the future of the country's nursing workforce to the whims and caprices of some individuals. The country needs a CHED chairman who takes time to study and understand the real situation on the ground," Barzaga said.

Quezon Rep. Angelina Tan also urged the CHED to review its Memorandum Order No. 32 issued

and we've seen how badly we need more nurses and health workers as we continue to battle Covid-19. The CHED's stubbornness is hurting the country; this is unthinkable," Barzaga said. He said CHED has refused to act on his request for the agency to allow the newly established Kolehiyo ng Lungsod ng Dasmariñas to open a nursing program that aims to expand the country's workforce in the face of the ongoing pandemic.

Barzaga said continuing to ban new nursing programs is doing more

President Duterte hopes new sports academy could produce Olympians, champions

President Rodrigo Roa Duterte expressed optimism Tuesday that the National Academy of Sports (NAS) in New Clark City (NCC) in Tarlac could hone world-class athletes and champions who will bring honor to the country and spur sense of nationalism among Filipinos.

In his speech during the inspection of the main campus of the academy, President Duterte said the NAS is envisioned to be a world-class facility that will serve as a forefront in the country's efforts to provide a conducive environment for the academic, sports training, and character

development for young Filipino athletes.

"It is therefore my hope and maybe my prayer that the pioneer batch of student-athletes become well-rounded Olympians and champions who will carry our flag in the international sports arena and inspire a deep sense of patriotism among Filipinos," he said.

"Let us continue to work with one another to sustain our present golden era of sports—even beyond my term—keeping in mind that the legacy we are building will not be ours alone but also for the succeeding generations to come."

He cited the feat

of Hidilyn Diaz, who beat the odds and paved the way for more aspiring athletes to excel and win medals for the country.

Diaz made history two years ago by winning the most-coveted gold medal in the Olympics — the first-ever for the Philippines.

The success of Diaz in weightlifting has encouraged the public, especially the youth, to take notice of the many talented athletes who are making waves in international sports, according to the President.

"It is thus an opportune time for me to help them maximize their potential with constant comprehensive projects and activities that promote the welfare and development of our athletes," the President pointed out.

President Duterte also commended the NAS, the Bases Conversion and Development Authority (BCDA), and all government and private partners that contributed to the construction of the new institution despite the limitations brought by the coronavirus pandemic.

The NAS was institutionalized by virtue of Republic Act (RA) No. 11470 to recognize and develop talented students from all sectors, including those from indigenous communities and persons with disabilities (PWDs), and other marginalized groups.

It is an attached institution of the Department of Education (DepEd) in partnership with the Philippine Sports Commission (PSC).

lected. "The nucleic acid will then be amplified, which requires only a single temperature of 37 to 42 degrees Celsius and can be completed in as little as 30 minutes. The product will be allowed to pass through the product Vertical Flow Microarray (VFM) paper. The paper microarray will be visualized after passing through the samples. The causative agent in the sample will then be identified," she said.

The project is still under development, but as soon as the primer sequences pass the statistical analysis, the researchers envision creating two multiplexable one-step RT-RPA kits that could each detect three enteric viruses.

In addition to that, a separate paper-based microarray will be produced to detect six enteric viruses in one device. The two technologies can be combined into a single product.

The product can be licensed into technology for commercialization through the Manila Healthtek Incorporation, Santos said.

The project was funded by the Philippine Council for Health Research and Development for PHP15.2 million

Meanwhile, Department of Science and Technology Secretary Fortunato de la Peña said these diagnostic kits will be helpful both in the detection of causative agents of the disease in patients and for detecting contamination in water sources.

"Diseases caused by contamination of water resources are a critical concern globally. Enteric viruses are one of the leading causes of acute diarrhea outbreaks in the Philippines, he said. source:(PNA)

fer a cheaper and faster way
to detect enteric viruses,
commonly blamed for water
and foodborne diseases like
gastroenteritis.

Marcos made the appeal after the Department of Health (DOH) warned of the possible rise in severe and critical Covid-19 cases by August because of the waning immunity from the coronavirus vaccine and reduction in adherence to minimum public health standards.
“We have to wear face masks and comply with other health standards to ensure our safety and that of our loved ones,” he said in a statement issued Friday.
The Cebu provincial government earlier issued an ordinance on the optional use of face masks, but Malacañang clarified that the local directive was not supported by President Rodrigo Duterte.
The Palace said the policy on mandatory wearing of face masks crafted by the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases and approved by Duterte prevails over the local ordinance.
