



Senate asks Comelec to extend voter registration deadline to Oct. 31

The Senate on Tuesday night asked the Commission on Elections (Comelec) to extend the voter registration period for one month to prevent disenfranchisement of voters, especially the new voters.

During the hybrid plenary session, the Senate

adopted Resolution No. 851 urging the Comelec to extend the deadline for voter registration from September 30, 2021 to October 31, 2021 "to prevent voter disenfranchisement brought about by the COVID-19."

In a privilege speech, Sen. Francis

"Kiko" Pangilinan, who is also sponsor of the resolution, said the September deadline was set before the pandemic.

"It is a pre-pandemic deadline. Nobody could have anticipated how this public health emergency would severely impact our daily lives, let

alone voter registration," he said.

Pangilinan presented video footage taken by news channels showing the plight of Filipinos who queued in long lines when voter registration resumed in Metro Manila last September 6 after the enhanced community

quarantine (ECQ) was lifted in the National Capital Region+ and other cities which were placed under ECQ.

While the Comelec announced that volunteer registration hours would be from 8 a.m. to 7 p.m. on weekdays, and 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Saturdays and hol-

idays, registrations were cut-off on an earlier hour.

Pangilinan cited the case of a youth volunteer who was told that the cut-off was 2:30 p.m. after he arrived at the Comelec office in Quezon City at 3 p.m. He was also told that only 300 registrants were accommodated.

Aside from the fear of being infected with COVID-19, Pangilinan said there are other stumbling blocks why people could not register, such as filled-up slots, lack of time and money to go to the Comelec offices, and worse, some policemen manning the long lines discouraged them to line up.

"While it is important for Comelec to be given enough time to prepare a final list of voters that is a prerequisite for the preparation and completion of its Project of Precincts or POP, we believe that a one-month extension will not delay Comelec's preparation," he stressed.

The senator pointed out that in previous elections since 2001, voter registration deadlines were set on or beyond October 31.

"The Supreme Court itself recognized the Comelec's power to set the deadline of voter registration, so long as no registration may be done during the period starting 120 days before a regular election," Pangilinan said.

"Based on this alone, Comelec has the prerogative to set the deadline of voter registration before January 9, 2022. But we are not asking that, Turn to page 5

Smarter MSMEs key to post-pandemic recovery: Lopez

MANILA – Innovation-driven and creativity-packed owners of micro, small and medium enterprises (MSMEs) are expected to help fuel the recovery of the sector from the pandemic.

In his speech during the virtual launch of Project Match on Thursday, Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) Secretary Ramon Lopez said the program addresses small businesses' need to have linkage and access to appropriate digital solutions and financing.

More importantly, linking them with financing institutions is a good way for their businesses to realize their plans for growth and expansion that have been cut off by the pandemic," he said.

Project Match is an endeavor being implemented by DTI, Startup Village, and United States Agency for International Development (USAID) in support of DTI-Laguna's program called Boosting Innovation and Technology Start-up: A Project on MSME Digitalization.

Continuing professional development: Sen. Ramon Bong Revilla Jr. presides over Tuesday's virtual hearing of the Committee on Civil Service, Government Reorganization and Professional Regulation, September 14, 2021, on several measures calling for a review of Republic Act (RA) 10912 otherwise known as the Continuing Professional Development (CPD) Act of 2016. RA 10912 is an act requiring CPD as the mandatory requirement for the renewal of professional identification card (PIC). Revilla stressed that the CPD should not just be a requirement for the renewal of PIC but an instrument to update and upgrade the competencies of the professionals. "We have to revisit the CPD law to see its necessity, effectiveness and responsiveness to our current needs," Revilla said, noting that three bills call for its amendment and another three are calling for the repeal of the law. The committee also discussed measures on conducting board examinations under the pandemic, augmenting the employee benefits for the solicitors of the Office of the Solicitor General (OSG) --the retirement, death and survivorship benefits of the solicitor general, assistant solicitors general, senior state solicitors, and state solicitors of the OSG. SSS enhances its online application of SS number

The Social Security System (SSS) announces the enhancement of the online application of Social Security (SS) number which now offers uploading of supporting documents, also via online.

"Instead of visiting our branch offices, members can now upload supporting documents online such as copy of their birth certificate from the Philippine

Statistics Authority (PSA), marriage contract if married, or baptismal certificate if with children. They don't have to submit the supporting documents via the drop-box system to make their SS Number application status permanent," SSS President and Chief Executive Officer Aurora C. Ignacio said.

The SSS Chief emphasized that uploading of basic supporting documents is necessary to obtain a permanent status of their issued SS Number and apply for SSS benefits and privileges.

"Considering the current quarantine protocols, new applicants and SSS members can visit the website at their preferred time and day to avoid experiencing long queues in our offices," added Ignacio.

This process serves as a double purpose for SS Number application and My.SSS Registration. Upon receiving the email for a successful SS Number online application, the applicant will also receive another email containing the credentials for My.SSS Account, for activation within thirty (30) calendar days.

ents, partners, and investors.

NCR courts to keep 'online' ops under Alert Level 4

MANILA — The Supreme Court on Wednesday said all lower courts in the National Capital Region (NCR) will remain physically closed indefinitely during the pilot of the quarantine Alert Level 4 in Metro Manila starting Sept. 16.

In an administrative circular on September 15, Chief Justice Alexander Gesmundo said courts in the NCR "shall continue to operate online and conduct videoconferencing hearings on pending cases and all other matters, whether urgent or not, as far as practicable, so as not to delay the trial of cases and court processes."

He also said a previous directive which said the SC will remain open with a limited workforce will still be enforced as NCR shifts to the new classification format.

The time for filing and service of pleadings and motions during this period remains suspended and shall resume after seven calendar days counted from the first day of the physical reopening of the relevant court, unless otherwise expressly or-

dered by the relevant court. Gesmundo said the no personal filing policy will be allowed unless for exceptionally urgent matters and only after having been properly communicated and cleared with the proper office is further extended.

The Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-EID) earlier approved the pilot of alert levels system and granular lockdowns in Metro Manila to prevent the spread of the Covid-19 while providing

DICT cites major increase in PH Internet speed, digital reforms under Duterte administration

MANILA — Philippines has seen significant improvements in its digital speed and interconnectivity services since President Rodrigo Roa Duterte assumed office, an official from the Department of Information and Communications Technology (DICT) said Monday night.

The DICT has worked steadfastly in cooperation with the country’s telecommunications (Telco) companies and Bases and Conversion and Development Authority (BCDA) to fulfill President Duterte’s marching order to provide free, equitable, and reliable Internet service for all Filipinos, DICT Secretary Gregorio Honasan II said during a meeting on government’s COVID-19 interventions.

This collaborative effort has resulted in faster and cheaper Internet connection for the Philippines, according to the DICT chief.

For instance, between 2016 and 2021, Honasan reported an 800-percent increase in average fixed broadband Internet speed from 7.91 megabytes per second (Mbps) to 72.56 Mbps, while mobile Internet speed has increased by 300 percent from 7.44 Mbps to 33.77 Mbps.

Additionally, more than 4,000 Wi-Fi sites were established in the year 2020 alone, raising the country’s total number of free Wi-Fi spots to 10,966, which provides free Internet to public hospitals, quarantine centers, as well as public schools among others, he noted.

To ensure people’s cyber safety, Secretary Honasan said the Cyber-crime Investigation and Coordinating Center (CICC) has been tapped to oversee network security.

DOH-CALABARZON ASSURES SAFETY OF EMPLOYEES FROM COVID-19, CONDUCTS MASS TESTING

To ensure protection of its employees, the Department of Health (DOH) CALABARZON (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, Quezon) has been conducting mass antigen and RT-PCT testing to all its employees.

1K workers hired nationwide under DPWH jobs program

MANILA – A total of 1,090 workers were hired nationwide by the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) for 'Build, Build, Build' (BBB) projects.

Based on the latest data of the agency on Thursday, 457 of these workers are from Luzon -- 10 in the National Capital Region; eight in the Cordillera Administrative Region; 137 in the Ilocos Region; 133 in Cagayan Valley; 29 in Central Luzon; 63 in Calabarzon; 52 in Mi-

maropa, and 25 in Bicol.

Meanwhile, 302 workers are from the Visayas -- 174 in Western Visayas; 78 in Central Visayas, and 50 in Eastern Visayas.

Some 225 workers are from Mindanao -- 17 in the Zamboanga Peninsula; 18 in Northern Mindanao;

99 from Davao Region and 91 from Caraga.

Meanwhile, the DPWH's Unified Project Management Office hired 85 workers while its Public-Private Partnership Office hired 21 workers.

"As we build out of this crisis, our 'Build, Build, Build' Program will continue to create employment opportunities with Bigay Trabaho that are still open for jobseekers," DPWH Secretary Mark Villar said in a statement.

Among the jobs in various construction firms that are available include welders, laborers, civil engineers, materials engineers and technicians, equipment operators, foremen, carpenters among others.

"Jobseekers may still contact our different channels for available job positions that are vital to the success of our BBB Program. This is also our way of helping contractors so that they have enough manpower to implement and complete massive projects on time," Villar said.
