M E N DEZ-NUNEZ, Cavite (PIA) -- Mayor Eric Aure Vida is encouraging his constituents to get vaccinated, exercise discipline and stay steadfast in faith to help everyone beat this CoViD-19 pandemic.

In a recent public address, Mayor Vida said that the alarming rate of infection led to a total of 134 Confirmed cases for a period of two weeks from August 1–14, which is comparatively highter than the earlier months of the first half of the year led to the overwhelming use of t isolation facilities and hospitals in their

Vida disclosed that preparations of the CADIP-SA Retreat Center is currently being undertaken for the inspection and approval of the Department of Health. Once finished, the center will be used as the new isolation facility of the town in response for the upsurge in the number of cases

On the other hand. the local chief executive said that getting the protection given by the CoViD-19 vaccines is the most responsible thing to do that would make a huge difference to staying safe and alive.

vaccine statistics of the Municipal Health Office show that a total of 17,308 doses of CoViD-19 vaccines had been administered, amounting to around 65 percent of target vaccinees with 1,792 target residents receiving the 1st dose, and 15,516 or 58% are fully vaccinated against the coronavirus disease.

"We are already

vaccinating all Mendezenos 18 years and older with the vaccination program strictly following the Master List, and the Barangay schedule," said Vida.

He asked his constituents to be responsible by informing the Rural Health Unit, and the Barangay Health Workers once CoViD-related symptoms start to manifest with oneself, or with any member of the household or had close contact with a person who tested positive with CoViD.

Despite the strict implementation of the quarantine protocols, more than 600 violations for not wearing face masks, face shields, and non-observance of curfew hours were recorded by the local PNP.

"Scary, alarming, and dreadful," the local chief executive said of the current situation in their town. However, Vida assured his constituents that they can overcome the pandemic through their collective efforts and

SSS to pensioners: avoid loan sharks, apply for Pension Loan **Program with low-interest rate**

The Social Security System (SSS) is encouraging its pensioners to use its Pension Loan Program (PLP) for their immediate financial needs instead of going to loan sharks that offer high-interest rates and uses their ATM cards

The PLP, launched in September 2018, allows qualified retiree-pensioners to avail of a loan of up to three, six, nine, or 12 times their basic monthly pension (BMP) plus the P1,000 additional benefit, but not to exceed the maximum loan amount of P200,000. Moreover, their net take-home pension must be at least 47.25 percent.

Pension loans of three and six times the pensioners' BMP plus the P1,000 additional benefit have respective payment terms of six and 12 months, while pension loans of nine and 12 times the BMP plus the P1,000 additional benefit have a payment term of 24 months.

The PLP has an interest rate of 10 percent per annum. The first monthly amortization for pension loans is due on the second month after the loan was granted. Further, a one-percent service fee is waived as a means to subsidize the payment for the premium of the Credit Life Insurance (CLI) of the borrower.

To qualify for the loan program, a retiree-pensioner: • must be 85 years of

age or below at the end of the last month of the loan term; • must have no deduc-

tions such as outstanding loan balance, benefit overpayment payable to the SSS, etc., from his/her monthly pension; must have no exist-

ing advance pension under the SSS Calamity Assistance Pack-

• must be receiving his/her regular monthly pension for at least one month and the status of pension is "Active".

PLP applications for first-time availees must be coursed through SSS branches, following community quarantine protocols and servicing guidelines (number coding

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viously availed the program and have already paid their loans in full may submit their applications online through the E-Services tab of the My.SSS Portal in the SSS website (www.sss.

Based on its initial data, the SSS approved the release of P1.47 billion pension loans for 33,007 retiree-pensioners from January to June

Of the said amount, P1.38 billion were approved for 30,772 retiree-pensioners who filed their applications through SSS branches, while the remaining P96.62 million were approved for 2,235 retiree-pensioners who filed their applications online

Currently, the SSS is working on enhancements to the online facility to also accommodate initial (first-time)

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SC names 24 sites for November Bar exams

The Supreme Court (SC) on Wednesday released the list of 24 local sites for the regional Bar examinations scheduled in November.

In a bulletin, the High Court said aside from the 24 sites, four more venues -- three in Metro Manila and one in Central Luzon are also being evaluated for the exams.

This is the first time that multiple sites will be used for the Bar examinations.

Manila universities, including the Manuel Luis Quezon University (MLQU), De La Salle University (DLSU), and the University of Santo Tomas (UST) were the past sites of the exams.

Under the measure, each bar applicant will select their local testing center through the Bar Personal Login Unified System (PLUS).

Venue-matching will not be on a first-come, first-served basis and instead, applicants from remote areas will be prioritized.

Applicants may select their chosen local testing centers after their applications have been approved by the Supreme Court en banc. The Office of the Bar Confidant will send separate emails to the approved applicants.

The SC advised applicants to choose the testing center that is closest to their residence.

"This will not only reduce their expenses, but will also free up the slots in vicinities closest to those with the least resources." the Court said.

Earlier, the SC has approved other changes, including the possibility of including bar examinees in the list of priority individuals for anti-coronavirus vaccination.
