458 Cavite barangays now drug-cleared

TRECE MAR-
TIRES CITY (PIA) – The Cavite Provincial Police Office (PPO) reported that a total of 458 barangays in Cavite are now considered "drug-cleared" as no drug-related activities were reported.

Cavite PPO Provincial Director Col. Christopher Olazo confirmed in

an interview with the media that out of 829 barangays that were declared drug-affected, 725 are classified as slightly affected, 101 are moderately affected, and one is seriously affected.

These classifications are based on drug-related activities observed and reported in the barangays.

DOH CALABARZON LEADS THE BLESSING OF SUPER HEALTH CENTER AND GROUNDBREAKING OF BIRTHING HOME IN DOLORES, QUEZON

The Department of Health (DOH)- CALABARZON (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, and Quezon) led the blessing of Dolores Super Health Center and the Ground-Breaking Ceremony of the new Dolores Birthing Home in Dolores, Quezon, held at Brgy. Bulakin II, Dolores, Quezon, on May 24, 2023.

The facility is a P6.5 million project funded through the DOH Health Facility Infrastructure Project under GAA 2022.

Under the project, DOH also turned over medical equipment such as a blood monitoring device, Blood Pressure Apparatus, EENT Diagnostic, Emergency Cart, Emergency Light (Portable, Rechargeable), Gang Chair, Hemocytometer, Hematology Analyzer, Microscope Binocular, Nebulizer, Neurologic Hammer, Pharmaceutical Refrigerator, Portable Mobile X-ray Machine, Pulse oximeter, Spectrophotometer, Stethoscope, Thermometer Infrared Non-Contact, Urine Analyzer, Vaccine Refrigerator, Wheeled Stretcher, and others, amounting to P5 million. DOH will also provide one (1) radiologic technician to be assigned to the facility.

Dolores Super Health Center will primarily serve its residents. It has a pharmacy, primary clinical laboratory, x-ray, and consultation likewise accessible to nearby barangay residents.

“This Super Health Center will address the gate keeping of residents needing primary medical services. Hindi na kailangan pang magtungo sa malalayong ospital para lamang magpa x-ray at blood chem. Sa pamamagitan nito ay makakat-ulong tayo para ma decongest ang mga ospital,” Regional Director Ariel I. Valencia stated during the ceremony.

PBBM : Gov’t always ready to help LGUs in times of calamity

President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr. said on Friday that the national government is always ready to help and is in constant communication and coordination with the local government units (LGUs) most especially in times of emergencies and natural disasters.

The chief executive made the remarks amid the approaching supertyphoon Mawar, which battered most of Guam recently.

“The national government is here to assist. We are in constant contact with the local governments para makita natin what is the situation in their place pagka nakadaan na ‘yung bagyo, pagka natapos na ‘yung mga ulan, mabawasan na ‘yung ulan,” the President said in a media interview following the 125th anniversary celebration of the Philippine Navy in Manila.

“Dito sa bagyong ito...although dadaan lang north of the Philippines, apparently hihilahin niya ‘yung habagat para — and there is a chance na magkaroon ng malakas na ulan pati hanggang — hindi lang southern Luzon, Visayas, pati baka Mindanao. Kaya’t we have already warned the LGUs to prepare in case of heavy rains and flooding,” the President added.

Marcos said concerned national government agencies including the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (NDRRMC) earlier this week said they are expecting northern Luzon to bear the brunt of the typhoon.

“Nakapag-forward positioning kami ng mga relief goods doon sa areas na nakikita namin na aabutan ng bagyo, which is mostly northern Luzon,” Marcos said.

“We are in constant contact with them also to find out kung ano ‘yung kailangan nila, ano ‘yung nangyayari doon sa lugar nila and then, in that way, we will be able to respond properly. So, it’s a little different from the usual situation kung saan lang dumadaan ‘yung bagyo, ‘yun lang ang inaalala natin, pero iba itong nangyari dito kasi malakas, typhoon eh. Humihila siya ng mga weather pattern, pumasok dito sa Pilipinas. So that’s what we are looking out for.”

Mawar has intensified over the Philippine Sea as it nears the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR), bringing strong to typhoon-force winds that extend up to 550 kilometers from the center.

In its weather advisory Friday, the Philippine Atmospheric, Geophysical and Astronomical Services Administration (PAGASA) said the eye of Mawar was last spotted at 1,740 km. east of southeastern Luzon at 3 a.m., still outside the PAR.

The typhoon packs maximum sustained winds of 215 kph near the center and gusts of 265 kph, moving west at 20 kph.

DPWH to build more rainwater collectors vs. wet season, El Niño

MANILA – The Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) on Thursday said it would build more rainwater collectors systems (RWCs) nationwide as the wet season and El Niño near.

In a statement, DPWH Secretary Manuel Bonoan said it's high time to provide RWCs in public facilities to help mitigate the impact of climate threats.

“The rainy season and the threat of El Niño increase the demand to build disaster-resilient infrastructure that will be beneficial in harvesting rainwater intended for agriculture, commercial, and domestic use,” he said.

The RWCs are expected to aid the country in managing challenges on water supply and flooding.

Bonoan, meanwhile, ordered all the Regional and District Engineering Offices to secure the list of proposed beneficiaries of RWC.

“Using the list of proposed beneficiaries, we will be able to determine the total serving population that will be benefited by the project and reduces the daily burden of people in areas with physical water scarcity,” Bonoan said.

A PHP582.9-million fund has been allocated for RWCs throughout the country this year, under the DPWH's INFRAgenda 2028.

Among the regions, areas with the highest allocations include Calabarzon, Bicol, and Western Visayas with PHP47.64 million each; followed by Central Luzon and Central Visayas with PHP44.84 million each; and PHP42.04 million for Eastern Visayas.

The budget for the remaining regions ranges from PHP25.22 million to PHP39.23 million each./ source:(PNA)

Bascos signed the Memorandum of Agreement on behalf of DENR IV-A, while Regional Director Ma. Cristina C. Arzadon and Laguna Provincial Information Center Manager Christopher M. Hedreyda signed on behalf

of PIA IV-A.

In her message, RD Arzadon extended her gratitude to the DENR IV-A for recognizing the contribution of the PIA IV-A in advancing environmental programs and campaigns in the region and hopes that through this partnership DENR will be able to realize its mandates of helping communities conserve, manage, and utilize the country's natural resources.

RED Tamoria, meanwhile recognizes the reach of PIA IV-A's platforms in disseminating timely and relevant information through its various radio and social media platforms and in countering disinformation. One of the goals of the partnership is to inspire a change in the everyday behavior of the public and to inspire more advocacies in environmental protection, Tamoria added.

The slightly affected barangays have a few residents who use illegal drugs, whereas the more affected barangays have clandestine drug laboratories, warehouses, marijuana plantations, and drug dens.

The Cavite PPO also reported that 16 barangays in Cavite province are active participants in the community mobilization program to fight against drug-related activities, while 17 were declared drug-free from September 20, 2022, until April 20, 2023.




