

MANILA-- Proper shading and avoiding overvoting are the two things a registered voter needs to do for a hassle-free poll sa UHC.' process this May, the Commission on Elections (Comelec) reminded Tuesday.

On May 13, from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m., the national and local elections will commence following a four month-long campaign period that started on February 12 for the national positions and March 29 for the local bets.

In a voter's education lecture in Quezon City, election officer Stephanie Bag-In said voters must remember to fully shade

the circle beside the name of her/his candidate and avoid overvoting or else their ballots would be voided by the vote counting machine (VCM).

For senators, a voter could only pick 12 candidates or less. And while there are 59 seats available for party lists, a voter could only choose one

This year, there are a total of 61,843,750 active registered voters in the Philippines.

Voting process

The voting process starts from the voter looking into his/her name in the Posted Computerized Voters List (PCVL) at the polling place, which would determine the precinct number and

State health insurance agency Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) has concluded a successful two-day activity dubbed as Health Care Financing Summit which focuses on the theme: "Multiple Lenses, One Collective Stand on Health Financing: A Framework for Action." This was held last March 18-19, 2019 at the Crowne Plaza Manila Galleria Hotel as part of PhilHealth's 24th anniversary celebration.

The summit provides a multi-stakeholder platform for collective action towards effectively implementing reforms in health care financing which is a key element in achieving universal health care.

Aside from key officers from PhilHealth, around 200 participants from partner-stakeholders representing the academe, health administrators, professional organizations, health care providers, private sectors, migrant groups, Local Chief Executives, Indigents, development partners, civil societies, media partners, and other government agencies, attended the event.

PhilHealth Acting President and Chief Executive Officer Dr. Roy B. Ferrer expressed his optimism that the gathering of hearts and different perspectives and viewpoints in which the end goal is always

"Nakasalalay po sa atin ang kinabukasan sa pagseseguro sa kahihinatnan ng batas na ito," Ferrer said. "If we want this to be successful, then we must act and work together for our goals to be achieved successfully especially where our vision of 'Bawat Filipino, Miyembro, Bawat Miyembro, Protektado, Kalusugan ng Lahat, Segurado is concerned" says the PhilHealth Chief.

Meanwhile, Health Secretary Francisco T. Duque III delivered his inspirational message that drew excitement due to the passage of the Universal Health Care Act through Republic Act 11223. He stressed on the essence of the law by simply ensuring that all Filipinos are guaranteed equitable access to quality and affordable health care goods and services, much more, provides protection against financial risks.

According to Duque, "We need a bolder and braver PhilHealth in order to drive universal health care." He added that, "Let us implement responsively. Bagamat hindi biro ang hamon ng UHC, pero kaya natin ito! Katuwang ng PhilHealth ang DOH tungo

PhilHealth also invited two distinguished guests both tagged as UHC champions. One of them is Congresswoman Dr. Angelina DL. Tan, Chairperson of the House Committee on Health who firmly believes "that there is a lot of work to be done but if we do it all together, we can hit our targets. Moving forward tungo sa kalusugan ng bayan para sa kalusugang pangkalahatan," Tan said.

> On the other hand, Senator Joseph Victor "JV" G. Ejercito lauded this landmark legislation as he deeply expressed his gratitude to the people involved who painstakingly worked day and night in the crafting of the UHC law. "I know this is another milestone that history itself cannot erase. Once implemented, the UHC legacy will be forever in the hearts of the Filipino people. Thank you all for the support! Mabuhay ang PhilHealth!" Ejercito declared in his keynote speech.

LRT Line 1 Cavite extension construction begins Tuesday PARAÑAQUE CITY – After three administrations

and two decades of waiting, the construction of the LRT Line 1 Cavite Extension, envisioned to provide a safe and efficient public transportation system between Cavite and Manila finally commenced on Tuesday, May 7.



Department of Transportation (DOTr) Secretary Arthur P. Tugade led officials from the DOTr, Light Rail Transit Authority (LRTA), Light Rail Manila Corp (LRMC) and project partners in witnessing the official start of construction, which took place in a property in San Dionisio village here where a station is expected to rise.

This proves that "totoo ang project na ito (this project is for real)," said Tugade as he addressed issues regarding the supposed two-year gap since the project broke ground in 2017. He cited some matters that needed to be ironed out such as right of way issues, relocation of various utilities, and completion of the acquisition of light rail vehicles (LRVs), among others.

A major infrastructure under the Duterte administration's Build, Build, Build Program, the project seeks to provide enhanced mobility and connectivity from Cavite to Greater Manila Area – in line with the Presidential directive to provide a comfortable life for every Filipino.

The project will extend the existing line by 11.7kms, stretching its current 20kms to 32.4kms. and will add eight brand new stations (from its last station in Baclaran, crossing the cities of Parañague and Las Piñas, leading to the city of Bacoor in Cavite. These stations will be located at Redemptorist. MIA. Asiaworld, Ninoy Aquino, Dr. Santos, Las Piñas, Zapote and Niog.

Partial operations, from Baclaran to Dr. Santos station is targeted by the 4th quarter of 2021, Tugade said.

Upon completion travel time from Baclaran to Cavite will be reduced from 1 hour and 10 minutes to just 25 minutes and is projected to double the average daily ridership from the current 458,000 to 800,000 passengers.
