





te P Lim – Police Regional P1,879,827.00. Office CALABARZON has confiscated 1.8 Million worth of illegal drugs in the last 24 hours as part of its daily operations regionwide, from 6:00 am to 6:00 pm of and 14, 2022. wherein 11 ki-October 13 and 14, 2022.

The Regional Director, PBGEN Nartatez said that the illegal drugs, in the form of crystal meth or "shabu" and marijuana products were seized by police anti-drug units in 24 separate operations done in coordination with the Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency 4A

A total of 31 suspects were arrested during the said operations, significant of which were the arrest of 4 High Value Indi-Level Individuals (SLI)

The arrest and seizure with the highest impact was done against Maria Victoria Perito, a HVI from 6:00 am to 6:00 pm of October 13 lograms of Marijuana bricks amounting to P1.3 million was confiscated in her possession, Thursday evening at Brgy. San Roque, Antipolo City, Rizal

Meanwhile, in a separate operation at Brgy. Parian, Calamba City, Laguna, HVI suspect in the person of Rodel Burgos was arrested and caught in his possession was more or less 50 grams of shabu with estimated value of P345. 000.00

## Asia's Catholic bishops **IMUS CITY** MAAYOS NA open two-week general conference in Thailand's **PABAHAY PARA** capital

Asia's Catholic 22 bishops opened a two-week general conference in Bangkok on Wednesday, October 12, to mark the 50th anniversary of the Federation of Asian Bishops' Conferences (FABC).

"The Archdiocese of Bangkok, the Catholic community of Thailand and our friends, extend the warmest welcome to all the delegates of the FABC's general conference," read a statement from the organizing body in the Thai capital.

"We proudly and joyously join in the celebration of the 50th Anniversary of the FABC and pray for the guidance of the Holy Spirit for the success of this historic conference," it added.

At least 270 Catholic Church leaders and guests will be welcomed by Thailand's Minister of Culture Itthiphol Kunplome, Cardinal Francis Xavier Kriengsak Kovitvanich, archbishop of Bangkok, and Bishop Joseph Chusak Sirisuth, president of the Catholic Bishops' Conference of Thailand.

"We will start a monumental task of reaffirming, renewing, and revitalizing the Church in Asia," said Cardinal Oswald Gracias of Bombay, convenor of this year's celebrations, in a statement during the opening ceremonies that were held in Bangkok on August

"We will gather to commemorate, celebrate and chart the direction that we,

as Church in Asia, will take on our journey together in the next decades," said the prelate.

MANILA - President Ferdinand "Bongbong"

Marcos Jr. has signed a law postponing the December 2022 Barangay and Sangguniang Kabataan (SK) elections.

Republic Act (RA) No. 11935, signed by Marcos on Oct. 10, postpones the Barangay and SK elections on Dec. 5 this year to the last Monday of October 2023.

synchronized Barangay and Sangguniang Kabataan elections, which shall be held on the last Monday of October 2023 and every three years thereafter," the law reads.

Under RA 11935, the term of office of the Barangay and SK officials will commence at noon of Nov. 30 following their election.

"Until their successors shall have been duly elected and qualified, all "There shall be incumbent Barangay and Sangguniang Kabataan officials shall remain in office, unless sooner removed or suspended," it added.

Barangay and SK officials who are ex officio members of the Sangguniang Bayan, Sangguniang Panlungsod, or Sangguniang Panlalawigan will continue to serve as such members in the Sanggunian concerned until the next Barangay and SK elections unless removed.



The amount necessary for the implementation of RA 11935 will be taken from the appropriations of the Commission on Elections under the General Appropriations Act and/or supplementary appropriations.

# Special polls for Cavite congressional seat eyed in February 2023

MANILA – The Commission on Elections (Comelec) is looking at holding the special polls at the 7th District of Cavite province in the early part of 2023.

In a press briefing on Thursday, Comelec chairperson George Erwin Garcia said they will be using an automated system for the special polls.

"We will need less funds if we use the automated elections. And we have 90,000 voting machines to spare. There are only about 500 precincts there," he added.

At the same time, Garcia noted that they are looking to set the filing of the Certificate of Candidacy (COC) sometime in December.
