

DOH, DEPED LAUNCH HEALTHY LEARNING INSTITUTIONS TO STRENGTHEN SCHOOL HEALTH PROGRAMS

Aiming to strengthen school health and nutrition programs, the Department of Education (DepEd), together with the Department of Health (DOH), launched healthy learning institutions in the basic education sector through a ceremony held in Quirino High School, Quezon City on October 11, 2022.

Carrying the theme "Pinalakas na Oplan Kalusugan sa DepEd, Pinatatag na Healthy Learning Institutions," the ceremony gathered Executive Committee leaders of both DepEd and DOH, local government representatives of the host city, and selected school health and nutrition personnel from across the country to high-

light the importance of a whole-of-government and whole of society approach to strengthening school health programs. Institutionalized in 2018, Oplan Kalusugan sa DepEd or OK sa DepEd is the convergence of the Department's health and nutrition initiatives for their effective and efficient implementation at the school level, in partnership with various stakeholders.

"I look forward to receiving the results of your consultative workshop summarizing the issues, concerns, and recommendations from regional school health and nutrition personnel, including the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao," Vice President

and Education Secretary Sara Z. Duterte noted in her message as read by DepEd Undersecretary and Chief of Staff Epimaco V. Densing III.

Early this year, DepEd established a partnership with the DOH and other national government agencies to strengthen school health under the basic education sector as Healthy Learning Institutions (HLI), through the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), Department of Education (DepEd), Commission on Higher Education (CHED), Legal Education Board (LEB), Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA), and Depart-

ment of Interior and Local Government (DILG) Joint Administrative Order (JAO) 2022-0001 titled Guidelines on Healthy Settings Framework in Learning Institutions. Pursuant to Section 30 of Republic Act 11223 or the Universal Health Care Act, the JAO operationalizes the designation of schools as healthy settings, based on standards set by the DOH and DepEd.

The DOH manifested its gratitude for the efforts of the DepEd particularly in prioritizing learners' health and well-being. The Department also expressed its commitment to support the DepEd in this endeavor.

Syempre, mga konsumedores ang magdurusa. TAAS NA PRESYO ng gulay, karne, isda, tinapay, bigas, sabon, toyo at kung anu - ano pa.

PNP CALABARZON Confiscates 1.8M Worth of Illegal Drugs

Camp BGen Vicente P Lim – Police Regional Office CALABARZON has confiscated 1.8 Million worth of illegal drugs in the last 24 hours as part of its daily operations regionwide, from 6:00 am to 6:00 pm of October 13 and 14, 2022.

The Regional Director, PBGEN Nartatez said that the illegal drugs, in the form of crystal meth or "shabu" and marijuana products were seized by police anti-drug units in 24 separate operations done in coordination with the Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency 4A.

A total of 31 suspects were arrested during the said operations, significant of which were the arrest of 4 High Value Individuals (HVI) and 3 Street Level Individuals (SLI) that netted 66.79 grams of shabu and 11.01 kilograms

of Marijuana, all valued at P1,879,827.00.

The arrest and seizure with the highest impact was done against Maria Victoria Perito, a HVI from 6:00 am to 6:00 pm of October 13 and 14, 2022, wherein 11 kilograms of Marijuana bricks amounting to P1.3 million was confiscated in her possession, Thursday evening at Brgy. San Roque, Antipolo City, Rizal.

Meanwhile, in a separate operation at Brgy. Parian, Calamba City, Laguna, HVI suspect in the person of Rodel Burgos was arrested and caught in his possession was more or less 50 grams of shabu with estimated value of P345,000.00.

In the nearby province of Rizal particularly in Looc, Cardona, Rizal, two drug peddlers were arrested identified as John Vincent Villaran and Neolan Belle-

za Cardona which yielded 13.99 grams of shabu valued at P95,132.00.

"This is the result of our continuous and intensified campaign against illegal drugs which I have always reiterated in line with my 7-Point Agenda since my assumption of office as the Regional Director of PRO CALABARZON," said RD Nartatez.

"I enjoin all our personnel to keep the momentum in the various programs and operations in our campaign against illegal drugs and other anti-crime efforts. Let us also engage our communities through our KASIMBAYANAN project to draw support from the people and cooperate with us in our objectives towards tranquility and progress in CALABARZON region," PBGEN Nartatez added.

Asia’s Catholic bishops open two-week general conference in Thailand’s capital

Asia’s Catholic bishops opened a two-week general conference in Bangkok on Wednesday, October 12, to mark the 50th anniversary of the Federation of Asian Bishops’ Conferences (FABC).

“The Archdiocese of Bangkok, the Catholic community of Thailand and our friends, extend the warmest welcome to all the delegates of the FABC’s general conference,” read a statement from the organizing body in the Thai capital.

“We proudly and joyously join in the celebration of the 50th Anniversary of the FABC and pray for the guidance of the Holy Spirit for the success of this historic conference,” it added.

At least 270 Catholic Church leaders and guests will be welcomed by Thailand’s Minister of Culture Itthiphol Kunplome, Cardinal Francis Xavier Kriengsak Kovitvanich, archbishop of Bangkok, and Bishop Joseph Chusak Sirisuth, president of the Catholic Bishops’ Conference of Thailand.

“We will start a monumental task of reaffirming, renewing, and revitalizing the Church in Asia,” said Cardinal Oswald Gracias of Bombay, convenor of this year’s celebrations, in a statement during the opening ceremonies that were held in Bangkok on August

22. “We will gather to commemorate, celebrate and chart the direction that we, as Church in Asia, will take on our journey together in the next decades,” said the prelate.

In his message for the occasion, Pope Francis expressed hope that FABC’s general conference will “renew the Churches in Asia in fraternal communion and in missionary zeal for the spread of the Gospel among the richly diverse peoples, cultures and social realities of the vast Asian continent.”

The gathering aims to “reaffirm, renew and revitalize” the Catholic Church in Asia under the theme: Journeying Together As Peoples of Asia, which is inspired by the scripture “then they went another way.”

Italian Catholic news agency Fides reported that some key questions will be asked during the conference, including how the Church in Asia continue to be “Good News” in under “emerging realities.”

“How can the FABC serve and support the bishops and their episcopal conferences in Asia? How can Catholic communities on the continent contribute to a better Asia?” said the report.

The gathering will witness a “multicultural pic-

ture” of prayers and hymns that will be sung in Asian languages.

With the usual reflections and group work for the bishops, special events have been planned, such as a “Talk Show with Asia” where believers from all over Asia participate in a videoconference.

The life and pastoral activity of 14 selected parishes in different Asian nations will also be shared with those present, with a “virtual visit” of the bishops, who will meet online with the faithful of the specific local community.

The FABC is a voluntary association of episcopal conferences in Asia that was established with the approval of the Holy See. Its aim is to foster among its members solidarity and co-responsibility for the welfare of Church and society in Asia.

FABC members include Church leaders from Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Brunei, Cambodia, India, Indonesia, Japan, Kazakhstan, Korea, Kyrgyzstan, Laos, Malaysia, Mongolia, Myanmar, Nepal, Pakistan, Philippines, Taiwan, Singapore, Sri Lanka, Timor-Leste, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Uzbekistan, Vietnam, Thailand, China and its special administrative regions — Macao and Hong Kong.

Under Republic Act 8295, after the deadline for the filing of the COC in a special election, when there is only one qualified candidate for such position, the lone candidate shall be proclaimed by the Comelec without holding the special elections.

thereby shall remain in force and effect,” RA 11935 reads.

All other laws, acts, presidential decrees, executive orders, issuances, presidential proclamations, rules and regulations which are contrary to and inconsistent with any provision of RA 11953 are repealed, amended, or modified accordingly.

RA 11935 is a consolidation of House Bill No. 4673 and Senate Bill No. 1306, which was passed by the House of Representatives and the Senate of the Philippines on Sept. 28, 2022.

Last month, Comelec Chairperson George Garcia said they are considering moving the dates of filing the certificates of candidacy (COC) for the 2022 Barangay SK elections pending the decision on proposals to postpone it.

The COC filing for the 2022 Barangay and SK elections was initially set from Oct. 6 to 13.

Comelec will comply

In a statement on Wednesday, Garcia said Comelec will comply with the law postponing the BSKE.

“As I have said before, the Comelec shall comply with the law. I have conveyed the Comelec position with regard to postponement of the BSKE to the legislature and the President and I

trust that such position was duly noted and considered,” he said.

“With this law, the legislative and the executive departments have seen fit to postpone the Barangay and SK Elections (BSKE) to October of 2023,” he added.

He said the poll body will be coming out with an updated calendar of activities regarding the postponed electoral exercises “the soonest possible time.”

“We shall also revisit our existing and planned procurement contracts related to the BSKE and act accordingly with the best interest of all parties in mind,” he said.

Garcia said the postponement will also give the Comelec “an opportunity to further institute education and information programs for the benefit of our electorate and prospective BSKE candidates.”

He added that the one-year postponement will also allow them to resume voter registration “to ensure the larger participation of the citizenry.”

Garcia said it will give the hopefuls as well as the voting public “to take this time to prepare and reflect on their rights and duties which they will exercise through their ballots and eventual offices.”

Marcos signs law postponing Dec. 2022 Barangay, SK elections

MANILA – President Ferdinand “Bongbong” Marcos Jr. has signed a law postponing the December 2022 Barangay and Sangguniang Kabataan (SK) elections.

Republic Act (RA) No. 11935, signed by Marcos on Oct. 10, postpones the Barangay and SK elections on Dec. 5 this year to the last Monday of October 2023.

“There shall be

synchronized Barangay and Sangguniang Kabataan elections, which shall be held on the last Monday of October 2023 and every three years thereafter,” the law reads.

Under RA 11935, the term of office of the Barangay and SK officials will commence at noon of Nov. 30 following their election.

“Until their successors shall have been duly elected and qualified, all incumbent Barangay and

Sangguniang Kabataan officials shall remain in office, unless sooner removed or suspended,” it added.

Barangay and SK officials who are ex officio members of the Sangguniang Bayan, Sangguniang Panlungsod, or Sangguniang Panlalawigan will continue to serve as such members in the Sanggunian concerned until the next Barangay and SK elections unless removed.



The amount necessary for the implementation of RA 11935 will be taken from the appropriations of the Commission on Elections under the General Appropriations Act and/or supplementary appropriations.
