PhilHealth employees lauded for record net satisfaction ratings

MANILA – With 94 out of 100 Filipinos expressing satisfaction with the services provided by the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth), PhilHealth President and CEO Emmanuel R. Ledesma Jr. praised the agency's workforce for obtaining a record-high net satisfaction ratings in 2022.

"We have 7,088 dedicated employees who work every day to serve the Filipino people, particularly our over 104 million registered beneficiaries," Ledesma said in a news release on Thursday.

In a survey con-

ducted by Novo Trends PH, PhilHealth obtained a net satisfaction rating of 93.75 percent in 2022, higher than the 90.19 percent it received the previous year.

"Lumalabas sa latest survey na tapat ang empleyado ng PhilHealth sa core values ng ahensya, tulad ng agarang serbisyo, taos-pusong paglilingkod, at pagmamalasakit. The latest survey shows that PhilHealth employees are loyal to the agency's core values, such as prompt service, sincere service and compassion," he said.

The agency also obtained "excellent ratings" from three other stakehold-

ers. These include employers (86.34 percent), health care institutions (86.82 percent), and health care professionals (79.38 percent).

"We shall continue to remain true to our values so we will be able to successfully fulfill our mandate: to provide affordable, acceptable, and accessible health care services to our countrymen," Ledesma said.

He said PhilHealth continues to provide personnel with training and education opportunities "in order to contribute to their personal growth, and to aid in the development of the skills necessary to make them

more effective and efficient in addressing the needs of our clients."

"The feedback provided by the surveys that have been conducted serve as a guide for us; to see what we are doing right, and to determine the areas that need improvement," he added.

PhilHealth personnel work in more than 360 PhilHealth stations nationwide. These include 17 regional and five branch offices, 114 local health insurance offices, 69 PhilHealth Express stations, 14 satellite offices, 19 business centers, 26 service desks and 104 Malasakit Centers. source: (PNA)

“SIM Registration Law will protect us” - DICT

The Department of Information and Communications Technology (DICT) reminded the public about the importance of the Subscriber Identity Module (SIM) Registration Law in making cyberspace safer and in harnessing the benefits of technology.

In a webinar for Local Government Unit (LGU) executives on Wednesday, DICT Undersecretary Anna Mae Y. Lamentillo emphasized that the law will be the subscribers' protection against fraudulent calls, and scams through text messages and even mobile applications.

According to Lamentillo, it is also a step forward to secure digital transactions, allowing more citizens to be part of e-commerce, and providing safer and more efficient access to e-government services.

"We know there are also concerns on data privacy. But we want to assure the public that the SIM Registration Law is being implemented in conjunction with the Data Privacy Act. The PTEs are responsible in ensuring that data from the SIM registration are secured, encrypted and protected at all times," Lamentillo explained.

DICT strongly advised the subscribers to be mindful of fake websites, phishing, and other scams that may take advantage of people trying to register their SIMs. The department urged the public to visit only the official websites of their telco provider for accurate information.

To report any issues related to SIM card registration, the public can reach DICT's 24/7 Complaint Center Hotline 1326 under the Cybercrime Investigation and Coordinating Center (CICC).

Meanwhile, to facilitate the registration in geographically isolated and disadvantaged areas (GIDAs) an Inter-Agency Ad Hoc Committee was organized.

The committee is composed of DICT, the National Telecommunications Commission (NTC), the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), the Department of Justice (DOJ), the Department of Education (DepEd), the Philippine National Police (PNP), Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP), other government agencies and the public telecommunication entities (PTEs).

DICT also tapped the Department of Justice (DOJ) to set up a one-stop-shop in remote areas so the public can secure their NBI clearances, which they can use in registering their SIM to solve the problem of lack of valid government-issued ID.

Lamentillo called on the Local Government Units (LGUs) to help their agencies to disseminate information about the importance of SIM Registration to their constituents.

"We call on everyone's cooperation, because the sooner we are able to accomplish the SIM registration, the sooner we can experience the protection of the law and its other benefits," Lamentillo said. (JAED/PIA-PMD)

FREE HEALTHCARE SERVICES FOR RESIDENTS OF IMUS

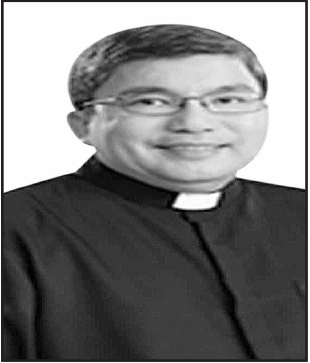

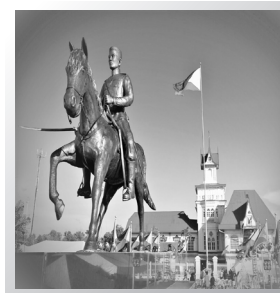

— The provincial government of Cavite is recalibrating its programs and services for senior citizens as it continues to improve the welfare and development of the country's elderly sector.

Through the Provincial Social Welfare and Development Office (PSWDO), the provincial government gathered heads and representatives of the Office of Senior Citizens Affairs (OSCA) from 23 towns and cities for a one-day consultation dialogue.

The PSWDO has partnered with the National Commission of Senior Citizens in facilitating the dialogue and aligning the programs and services for the elderly sector.

Recognizing the senior citizens' integral role in society, Vice Governor Athena Bryana D. Tolentino, in a statement, stressed the importance of pushing for the enhancement and alignment of various programs that will cater to their needs and further improve their welfare.

During the dialogue recently, NCSC Com-

missioner Ricardo Rainier S. Cruz III discussed the gains and challenges of the existing programs, particularly the social pension for indigent senior citizens, carried out by the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD).

Cruz stressed that more senior citizens would soon enjoy the social pension as they push to rationalize the selection of the beneficiaries.

Meanwhile, Com-

missioner Reyman R. Mansilungan presented Republic Act 11350, or the National Commission for Senior Citizens Act, along with other legislations implemented by the national government to ensure the welfare of senior citizens.

Ms. Jhoana M. No-dora of DSWD-Region IVA provided an update on the programs and services for senior citizens offered by their agency, including so-
