# P10.00 PER COPY DA agri interventions awarded to Cavite farmers, fisherfolks

Silang, Cavite (PIA) – The Department of Agriculture (DA) headed by Secretary William D. Dar led the Awarding and Distribution of Agricultural Interventions activity on Tuesday, November 9, 2021 at the Cavite State University (CavSU) - Silang covered court.



More than a year after the Taal Volcano erupted on January 12, 2020, the DA thru the IV-A regional office

had continuously supported the fisherfolks and farmers in Cavite that were heavily affected by the natural disaster with P 176M funds allocated for the province under the Taal Rehabilitation and Recovery Program.

During the event, DA Secretary William D. Dar awarded P 144.5M of the funds to the province with a certificate of the grant received by Provincial Administrator Alvin Mojica. A total of 103 farm-

ers' associations or 6,384 registered farmers in twelve (12) cities and municipalities in the province benefit from the program with their representatives receiving the certificates during the event. The beneficiaries

were from the cities of Dasmariñas with 12 farmers' associations, 517 farmers; General Trias with 7 farmers' associations, 316 farmers; Tagaytay city with 9 farmers' associations, 269 farmers; Trece Martires with

3 associations, 400 farmers; and the from the municipalities of Silang with 11 farmers' associations, 1,417 farmers; Amadeo with 10 associations, 274 farmers; Alfonso with 7 associations, 492 farmers; Gen. MANILA - President Rodrigo Duterte has named Lt. Gen. Dionardo Carlos as the next chief of the Philippine National Police (PNP), Malacañang announced last Wednesday.

Duterte signed Carlos' appointment paper on Wednesday, Presidential Spokesperson Harry Roque said in a press statement.

Roque said Carlos' appointment will take effect on Nov. 13.

"We confirm that President Rodrigo Roa Duterte signed today, November 10, 2021, the appointment of Dionardo Bernardo Carlos as the new Chief of the Philippine National Police (PNP), effective November 13, 2021," Roque said.

Roque said the Palace is confident that Carlos could lead the police force.

"We are confident that Gen. Carlos will continue making the PNP a professional, capable and reform-oriented organization that we envision it to be. We wish Gen. Carlos all the best as the new PNP Chief," he said.

Carlos will replace PNP chief Gen. Guillermo Eleazar who will bow out of the service on Nov. 13 upon reaching the mandatory re-

tirement age of 56. Prior to his new stint, Carlos served as the PNP chief of the Directorial Staff.

He is holding the fourth highest position in the PNP before being named as the country's top cop.
