A Catholic cardinal on Good Friday called on the faithful to face the world's pain with open eyes and compassionate hearts.

Cardinal Pablo

Virgilio David of Kalookan urged people not to look away from scenes of violence and injustice — from bombed-out homes in Gaza to the drug war victims in

the Philippines.

“Who really wants to look at violent images?” David asked during his homily at the annual commemoration of the Passion of Christ at Kalookan Cathedral, before listing atrocities often hidden from public view.

“But sometimes the real intent behind those images is not indecency, but awakening. A call to stir the heart of society,” he said.

Gatchalian: Increase Guidance Designates to Address Bullying Incidents in Schools

Senator Win Gatchalian is proposing to increase the number of guidance designates in public schools to help address incidents of bullying.

Gatchalian made this proposal in a Senate Committee on Basic Education hearing that tackled recent incidents of bullying and violence in schools. Guidance designates are teachers tasked with performing duties related to the implementation of guidance services.

The lawmaker also urged the Department of Education (DepEd) to review the ideal ratio of guidance designates to learners. To

date, one guidance counselor or guidance designate is assigned for every 500 learners. Based on DepEd data, 10,412 out of 45,326 schools have no guidance designates for School Year 2024-2025.

While Gatchalian maintains that teachers should be relieved of non-teaching tasks, he sees the increase in guidance designates as a stopgap measure in the absence of guidance counselors.

"Part of our recom-

mendation to DepEd is to review the role of guidance designates. Maybe we can increase their number depending on the size of the school by adjusting the ratio," said Gatchalian.

Moving forward, Gatchalian pressed the importance of implementing the Basic Education Mental Health and Well-Being Promotion Act (Republic Act No. 12080), which he authored and sponsored. The law mandates the development of a School-Based

Mental Health Program to promote the mental health and well-being of learners. The law also seeks to address the shortage of guidance counselors in public schools.

Batangas, Tagaytay safe for Visita Iglesia – Phivolcs chief

MANILA – Pilgrims or visitors wanting to spend the Holy Week or do the Visita Iglesia in Tagaytay and Batangas could do so as there is no imminent threat concerning the Taal Volcano, the head of the Philippine Institute of Volcanology and Seismology (Phivolcs) affirmed on Wednesday.

"Yes, Batangas and

Tagaytay remain generally safe for visitors and tourists, including those doing Visita Iglesia," Phivolcs Director Teresito Bacolcol told the Philippine News Agency.

He, however, wants to remind the public that Alert Level 1 (low level unrest) is still in effect over Taal Volcano.

Entry into Taal Volcano Island, especially the main crater, is strictly prohibited due to possible steam-driven explosions and high concentrations of volcanic gases.

"As a precaution, we advise tourists to stay informed through official Phivolcs bulletins," Bacolcol said.source:(PNA)

PNP 4A Arrests Top Fugitives in a Single Day Operation

Camp BGen Vicente P Lim- The Police Regional Office CALABARZON led by the Regional Director, PBGEN Paul Kenneth T Lucas apprehended several Most Wanted Persons (MWP) in a series of operations conducted within a single day from the afternoon of April 17, 2025 to dawn of April 18, 2025 across different areas in the region.

The synchronized law enforcement operations were executed by various police units, in collaboration with intelligence operatives, leading to the capture of high-profile fugitives facing serious charges.

Among those arrested were individuals wanted for heinous crimes, including rape, murder, homicide, robbery, direct assault, acts of lasciviousness, illegal drugs, and other crimes.

The Antipolo Component City Police Station together with CIDG Rizal

who led the operation, and Regional Mobile Force Batalililon 4A (RMFB) 404th Manuever Company, arrested alias “ALDRIN”, male, 32, construction worker, and resident of Purok 5, Zone 8, Barangay Cupang, Antipolo City on the night of April 17 at Brgy Cupang, Antipolo City. Alias “ALDRIN” is the region’s ranked number 2 most wanted fugitive for the crime of murder issued by the Regional Trial Court, Fourth Judicial Region, Branch 145, Antipolo City, Rizal dated March 6, 2025.

In Imus City, another fugitive was also arrested by operatives of Imus Component City Police Station together with the members of 401st Manuever Company of RMFB 4A on the afternoon of April 17, 2025.

The cardinal, known for his outspoken stance on human rights and social justice, emphasized that the Cross is not merely a symbol of suffering but a mirror reflecting the state of humanity.

"Every gaze at the cross is an invitation: Don't just look and walk away. Look—and let your heart be broken," said David, who

is also the president of the Catholic Bishops' Conference of the Philippines.

"Every wounded person you draw near to, every victim you choose to help—is the same One who first called to your heart to awaken your mercy," he added.

He recalled brutal images from the Duterte government's bloody drug

PHLPost releases stamps featuring jellyfish species

MANILA — The Philippine Postal Corporation (PHLPost) has issued stamps featuring different species of jellyfish found in the Indo-Pacific and the Philippines, the epicenter of marine biodiversity.

“The Philippines is the home of diverse jellyfish species, which are a part of the country’s natural heritage, with some species potentially being unique in the country,” the PHLPost said in a news release on Wednesday.

Four species — box jellyfish, upside-down jellyfish, lion’s mane jellyfish, and Pacific sea nettle — were presented in the "16 on sheet" containing 16 individual stamps.

The box jellyfish or Cubozoa is the most dangerous of this kind found near the coasts of northern Aus-

tralia and the Indo-Pacific region. Its box-like body with lots of tentacles covered in venom-filled stingers.

The upside-down jellyfish or Cassiopea mayeri scyphozoans is notable for their unusual benthic habit of lying upside-down with tentacles facing upwards.

The lion’s mane jellyfish or Cyanea capitata is one of the largest jelly species in the world, growing to an average length of 1.5 feet (40 cm), but can reach lengths of 6.5 feet (200 cm).

Meanwhile, the Pacific Sea nettle or Chrysaora fuscescens is a vibrant red, gold, and brown bell that may grow up to 3 ft (1 m) in diameter as well as white oral arms and 24 tentacles that may be as long as 15 ft (4.6 m).

The PHLPost also released a special souvenir stamp featuring the spotted jellyfish or mastiagas papua.

It is one of seven lagoon jelly species in the genus Mastigias that also have the species name Papua. It is sometimes called the Papua jelly.

Moreover, the official first-day cover design featured the jellyfish Cassiopea culionensis discovered by an international team of scientists including Filipino marine biologists and taxonomists.

The new endemic species of jellyfish was named after Culion Bay, Palawan where it was originally found. About 10,000 copies of the "16 on sheet" containing 16 individual stamps, and 2,000 pieces of the souvenir sheet were printed by the PHLPost. source:(PNA)

The donated high-powered computers,

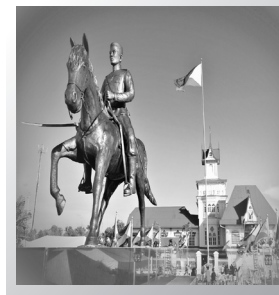

Police to remain non-partisan in May polls

CALAMBA CITY, Laguna (PIA) — The regional chief of the Philippine National Police (PNP) gave his assurance to the public that no personnel will remain nonpartisan in the midterm elections.

In an interview during the Philippine Information Agency's Su-

long Calabarzon program, PRO4A Regional Director Brig. Gen. Paul Kenneth Lucas reaffirmed their commitment that police officers will not engage in any political activities.

"First and foremost, as our Chief PNP has mentioned, the loyalty of the PNP is to the Constitution.

This is something we consistently remind our police officers. True to this, as of now, we have not monitored any police officers who are campaigning or affiliating with candidates, except in cases where they are providing security," Lucas said.

"We assure the people of Calabarzon that our

police officers will remain nonpartisan in the upcoming May 2025 Midterm Local and National Elections," the PNP director stressed.

He also assured the public that police officers in Calabarzon remain committed to maintaining peace, order, and security throughout the campaign season, es-

pecially during the election period.

To ensure peace and order, PRO4A continues to conduct election checkpoints at various locations and boundaries throughout the region to prevent any threats to security during the election period and to ensure public compliance with the

nationwide gun ban, which is in effect from January 12 until June 11.

Lucas also called for public participation in maintaining safety and order during the election, urging everyone to report any suspicious activities and remain vigilant throughout the election period. (CO/PIA4A)
