The Sangguniang Panlalawigan ng Cavite recently passed Resolution no. 1944-2022 that urged the Regional Tripartite Wages and Productivity Board IV-A to approve the petition and enact a provincial ordinance for a wage increase.

An extensive consultation was also held between concerned establishments and the labor sector to determine the fair amount of wage increase.

The discussion gave due consideration on prevailing prices of basic commodities as well as Basic Necessities and Prime Commodities of NEDA.

Moreover, a Public Hearing with the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) is set on May 16 at the Provincial Legislative Building to discuss the petition with results expected to be released after 30 days. (Ruel Francisco)

## PCG modernization Project

# Naming and Commissioning of BRP Teresa Magbanua (MRRV-9701)

Today is a day of celebration!

Approximately two (2) months before the end of the Duterte Administration, the Philippine Coast Guard (PCG) conducts the formal commissioning of its first 97-meter multi-role response vessel (MRRV) into the Coast Guard service – the Barko ng Republika ng Pilipinas (BRP) Teresa Magbanua, named after one of the strongest and bravest female warriors in Philippine history.

On behalf of President Rodrigo Roa Duterte, Department of Transportation (DOT) Secretary Arthur Tugade leads the commissioning ceremony at Pier 15 within Port Area, City of Manila on May 6, 2022.

Embassy of Japan Charge D’ Affaires Yasushi Yamamoto, Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) Chief Representative Takema Sakamoto, and Mitsubishi Shipbuilding Co. Ltd. President and Chief Executive Officer Toru Kitamura also grace today’s momentous event.

The BRP Teresa Magbanua (MRRV-9701) has a maximum speed of not less than 24 knots, an endurance of not less than 4,000 nautical miles, and is capable of conducting sustained maritime patrols in the country’s maritime jurisdictions.

It is modeled after the Japan Coast Guard (JCG) Kunigami-class vessels and is expected to improve the PCG’s maritime



security and maritime safety operations in the vast exclusive economic zone of the country.

The second 97-meter MRRV that will be commissioned as BRP Melchora Aquino (MRRV-9702) is slated to arrive in Manila next month.

The BRP Teresa Magbanua (MRRV-9701) and BRP Melchora Aquino (MRRV-9702) are part of the DOT’s Maritime Safety Capability Improvement Project (MSCIP) Phase II to intensify the modernization of the PCG.



Seventy two (72) soldiers are now part of the Philippine Marine Corps after graduating from the Marine Basic Course at The Basic School in Ternate, Cavite last April 29.

These soldiers belonging to Class 485 have undergone six (6) months of training and are expected to be assigned to Philippine Marine Corps units in Luzon and Mindanao.

“Learning doesn’t stop in the training center but is a continuous and progressive quest,” said Maj. Gen. Nestor C. Henrico of the Philippine Marine Corps as he welcomed the graduates in attendance. | via Ruel Francisco, Philippine Marines Corps

## Former rebels in Laguna receive E-CLIP benefits

SANTA CRUZ, Laguna (PIA) — At least six former members of the New People’s Army (NPA) from Laguna received their benefits under the Enhanced-Comprehensive Local Integration Program (E-CLIP) of the government.

Each former rebel received cash benefits worth P65,000 during the Laguna Provincial Task Force to End Local Communist Armed Conflict (PTF-ELCAC) Meeting held on Monday, May 2.

The cash benefits personally awarded by the task force’s officials include P15,000 immediate assistance and P50,000 livelihood assistance to help the former members of the communist terrorist group as they go back to mainstream society.

In a statement, former NPA member alias “Ka Sonny” said he appreciated the government’s effort in facilitating their integration back into their communities. He added that the amnesty and assistance they received would help them as they start their life anew with their loved ones.

For his part, Brigadier General Cerilo C. Balaoro Jr, 202nd Unifier Brigade Commander, said the E-CLIP assistance manifests the government’s promise and commitment to help rebel returnees as they restore their allegiance to the government.

Balaoro also commended the concerted efforts of the member agencies of the Laguna PTF-ELCAC for their continuous and relentless assistance to the former rebels.

“The main strategy to end the local communist armed conflict is “whole-of-nation approach. Your presence here is a manifestation of your commitment to contributing to providing opportunities to former rebels to start a new life and be productive citizens of the community,” Balaoro said.

“There is still a long road ahead of us, and despite the unexpected challenges that come our way, I have faith that in the passing of years, we will see the growth of success in ending the decades-long communist insurgency in our country through our concerted efforts” he added.

The 202nd Brigade Commander also appealed to the remaining active members of the NPA to lay down their arms and rejoin the mainstream society.

The Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) Laguna also supported the call of Balaoro.

Aside from the E-CLIP benefits, former rebels may also qualify for additional benefits such as access to government services, medical assistance, housing, and legal assistance, among others, according to Cerezo. — FC, PIA Laguna

“Our target really is the marginalized sector, the poor families in Visayas and Mindanao. We want to continue to provide them with these services so they don’t have to

go to Metro Manila to seek better opportunities and even ask for assistance,” she said.

ities and putting up interven-tions to improve water quality in the adopted water body.

With Aseana City, interventions have included providing boats and setting up steel floaters and biofences as aid in collecting trash trapped in waterways, to complement the cleanups by its environ-mental and security personnel.

Its efforts in the Channel have paid off, as the DENR observed a significant decrease in annual fecal coli-form levels from 716 million in 2017 to 132 million most probable number per 100 mil-liliters (mpN/100mL) in 2021. It was further down to 54,000 in the first quarter of 2022.

The developer has also been coordinating with the DENR’s Metropolitan Environmental Office (MEO)-South for other areas of col-laboration within Parañaque City.

In one of their meet-ings, which was also attended by the LGU, over 50 pollution control officers (PCOs) of dif-ferent locator establishments within the business park were able to clarify requirements and policies related to waste-water discharge and compli-ance with environmental laws.

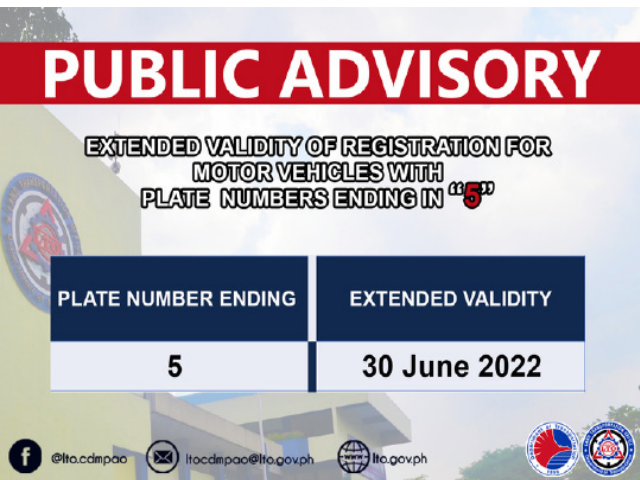

# DENR, Parañaque, private sector to rehab Manila Bay

**MANILA – Efforts to fast track the rehabilitation of the southern part of Manila Bay are now underway following the sealing of a partnership between the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) and Parañaque City.**

The stakeholders include Aseana City's business establishments and lot owners, who will endeavor to clean up the bay's tributaries.

As part of its commitment under the DENR's Adopt-a-Waterbody or Adopt-an-Estero Program, the Aseana City - through its Aseana Business Park Estate Association (ABPEA) - has been leading dredging activities along the Redemptorist Water Channel in Parañaque City.

The Metropolitan Manila Development Authority (MMDA) provided the dredging equipment for the activity that started in April.

DENR Acting Secretary Jim O. Sampulna welcomed the dredging efforts showing continuous environmental cooperation with Aseana City and the city government of Parañaque.

"Such partnerships highlight the importance of our partnership with the private sector and local government unit (LGU) in the realization and success of our programs, especially a priority program such as the Manila Bay Rehabilitation,"

Sampulna said in a statement.

Aseana City is a 107-hectare business district in a reclaimed area that hosts several establishments, such as the Ayala Malls Manila Bay, City of Dreams, and the Passport Center of the Department of Foreign Affairs.

Aseana City, through ABPEA - the official organization of locators or lot owners in Aseana City - adopted the 1,404-meter stretch of the Redemptorist Water Channel in June 2013 in response to the government's call for assistance from the private sector to improve the state of waterways across the country.

The artificial channel, which spans Barangays Baclaran and Tambo in Parañaque City, was created to ease flooding, particularly in reclaimed areas.

Assistant Secretary Gilbert Gonzales, who supervises the DENR's Metropolitan Environmental Offices or MEOs, said the channel was considered a priority waterway in the area since it is a tributary of Manila Bay.

"Cleanup and dredging the Redemptorist

Water Channel would not only improve the quality of the water, but also reduce, if not prevent, flooding in the area and in surrounding communities especially when rains come," he said.

Aside from the dredging, the ABPEA has been working towards having more establishments within its complex join the

government's Adopt-a-Waterbody program to improve water quality in the tributaries of Manila Bay and speed up its rehabilitation.

Under the program, adopters commit to starting coordination with other sectors, the community, and other government agencies in conducting cleanup activities.
