CARMONA, Cavite - The municipal government modified its coronavirus disease (COVID-19) tracker app called Carmona Digital Contact Tracer (DCT) to cater to residents who don't have regular access to the internet.

The local government unit (LGU) admitted that encouraging residents to download the app has been challenging at first due to several factors, including connectiv-

"Perhaps mainly because not everyone has a cell phone to start with nor access and capacity for mobile data or internet," Information **Technology Department** Head Angelo G. Macha told Manila Bulletin. "Being aware of these gaps, we modified our technology that would suit the landscape that we have in Carmona. We adjusted the DCT app for it to work even offline."

Aside from the modification, the LGU also oriented business establishments to keep logbooks in order to monitor visitors who don't have smartphones.

Originally

launched as Carmona COVID-19 Tracker (CCT) in May, the municipal government updated the app's name last month.

TIRES CITY, Cavite (PIA) -- The 10 extension modular booths along CAVITEX road will no longer serve cash transactions starting Saturday, August 15, 2020.

This was announced August 4 by Cavitex Infrastructure Corporation (CIC) President and General Manager, Mr. Roberto Bontia on the company's move to close the extension lanes, five lanes

Gatchalian calls on government to give financial support to LGUs under MECQ

Senator Win Gatchalian is calling on the government to provide financial support to Local Government Units (LGUs) after Metro Manila, Laguna, Cavite, Rizal, and Bulacan reverted to Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine (MECQ).

Gatchalian said officials of Local Government Units (LGUs) -- from the mayors down to the "barangay tanods" are themselves front liners because they are at the forefront of delivering services to their respective constituents and the most vulnerable to contract the virus.

OFFICIAL STATEMENT: No P15 billion pocketed by senior officials

The Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) categorically denies in strongest terms that its senior officials have "pocketed" some P15 billion as alleged by Thorsson Keith during the Senate hearing on August 4, 2020. Atty Keith was hired as a job order contractor to do staff work under the Office of the President and is in no position to discuss office matters being in the Corporation for only 9 months. His malicious claims not substantiated by evidence were obviously made to malign officers that rejected his ambitions for higher offices which he is not qualified for.

The fund alluded to by Atty. Keith was the Interim Reimbursement Mechanism (IRM) that was released to a total of 711 health care facilities to assure efficient response to the COVID-19 pandemic. There has never been "favoritism" in the release of these funds as earlier alleged; rather the releases followed existing guidelines.

Contrary to reports that hospitals no longer need to account for these funds, the IRM is governed by government accounting and auditing rules, hence, it is subject to liquidation by its recipients. The PhilHealth regional offices have been given the flexibility in the timing of liquidations recognizing the situations in each hospital.

It is worthy to note that in recognition of the crucial help that the IRM plays in the fight against Covid-19, the Philippine Hospital Association, in a Statement, expressed their support to its implementation in all levels of hospitals (including infirmaries) to help them to "financially cope with the demands of increasing its capacity to respond to Covid-19".

volvement in the distribution of cash aid to the people in their localities, community and barangay officials help in the delivery of goods and other essential services. LGUs have also been tasked to carefully issue Quarantine Passes anew just to ensure that only one person per household would be allowed to go out to avail of basic goods and services.

While barangay health workers share in the rigid process of proper contact

tracing, local police commanders have started to man checkpoints round the clock at the boundary of towns and cities under MECQ or within the National Capital Region (NCR), Rizal, Bulacan, Laguna and Cavite in order to contain the movement of the people.

"They are always in the first line of defense that is why it is important that the national government recognizes the significant role of the LGUs in the COVID-19 response and recovery," Gatchalian stressed.

B. Distor, the step was meant to fast-track its approval on App Store and Google Play Store, with both platforms cracking down on apps with COVID in its title to prevent the spread of misleading programs.

Privacy was another concern that previously caused hesitation over downloading the app. However, the LGU's assurance that the information will only be used for contact-tracing purposes seemed to have quelled residents' skepticism.

In fact, around 92,000 users have already installed and registered, which is around 80% of Carmona's population. As a result, contact-tracing measures have become smoother over the past weeks.

"DCT app somehow addresses the bottleneck in conducting contact tracing," Municipal Health Officer (MHO) Dr. Homer L. Aguinaldo told Manila Bulletin. "We still do actual visits in the community but it became more precise since the DCT app provides information on travel and interaction histories of users."

The boost in contact-tracing efforts is much needed, with Carmona experiencing a surge in its COVID-19 cases along with other areas in Cavite.

ti-Cybercrime Unit Region 4A (RACU 4A) proves its commitment to uphold cyber safety as it bested two awards in the national and regional

RACU 4A bagged the Best Regional Anti-Cybercrime Unit award in the national level besting 16 other regions during the 7th PNP Anti-Cybercrime Group (ACG) Anniversary 2020 last July 24 and the Best Regional Operational Support Unit in the regional level conquering other operational support units in Calabarzon during the 119th Police Regional Office 4A (PRO4A) Police Service Anniversary on August 6,

RACU 4A Regional Chief PCol. Julius C. Suriben stated that the RACU 4A has obtained these awards through

Team RACU4A Commitment as an active partner of PRO4A in crime prevention, crime solution and in increasing public safety awareness in CALA-BARZON by ensuring a safer and more secured cyberspace which is vital in the attainment of sustainable security and development in the region."

RACU4A achieved many of their goals and commitments in 2019 that sufficed to qualify them for the two noble awards.

They had significant improvements in terms of promoting community cyber safety awareness, strengthening community partnership, cybercrime prevention, and cybercrime solution.

In 2019, RACU 4A had a total of 601 reported crimes which shows 47.67% increase from the previous

"the attainment of the 2019 year, where 93 of the 601 cases were filed while 57 were resolved.

> Such increase, he explained, can be attributed to the enhanced crime recording and intensified awareness campaign on the existence of RACU 4A.

The Unit also obtained a Cybercrime Solution Efficiency of 15.31% which is a 790.12 % increase from 2018, while their Cybercrime Clearance Efficiency reached 30.78% or a 256.66% rise from 2018.

The Chief expressed that "the significant improvement in the investigation of cases is a result of the intensified law enforcement operations, Project i-C.A.R.E. or monthly case reviews, Court or Prosecutor Visitations, the continuing training of investigators and the close coordi-
