INNOVATION IS NOT JUST TECHNOLOGIES, SAYS NAT'L ACADEMICIAN

“It is an innovation of systems, not just technologies,” Academician Willam G. Padolina, said during the turnover ceremonies of the Pagtanaw 2050 at the 2021 National Science and Technology Week (NSTW) celebration, when asked how the science, technology and innovation (STI) strategic plan can be operationalized.

Padolina explained that innovation has to be understood in the context wherein it is composed of systems and not merely technologies – that there’s a need to change the systems. There’s a need to innovate in governance, and businesses has to innovate its processes and manage its risk, and that everyone will have to do their part.

Pagtanaw 2050: The Philippine Foresight on science, technology, and innovation, a 360-page compendium of technologies with 550 bibliographic references, is a product of the collective wisdom of the Academician of Filipino scientists and the

SSS opens Short-Term Member Loan Condonation Program from November 15-Feb. 14, 2022

Member-borrowers with past due short-term loans may apply for the Social Security System's (SSS) Penalty Condonation Program via online using their My.SSS accounts starting November 15, 2021 up to February 14, 2022.

SSS President and Chief Executive Officer Aurora C. Ignacio said that the Short-Term Member Loan Penalty Condonation Program (STMLPCP) is part of the Pandemic Relief and Restructuring Programs being offered by SSS.

“We continue to respond to the needs of our members who were greatly affected during this pandemic. Through the STMLPCP,SSS offers conditional loan condonation by waiving their accumulated penalties once their loan principal and interest are fully paid.” Ignacio said.

Included in the program are those with outstanding Salary, Calamity, Salary Loan Early Renewal Program (SLERP), Emergency Loans and Restructured Loan under the Loan Restructuring Program (LRP) implemented in 2016 to 2019.

Qualified to apply are the following:

- Members with short term member loans that are past due for at least six (6) months as of the first day of the condonation availment period;
- Members who have not been granted any final benefit such as permanent total disability or retirement;
- Members who have not been disqualified due to fraud committed against the SSS;
- Members who will file their final benefits application for permanent total disability or retirement, whose contingency date is on or before the last day of the availment period of the condonation program;
- Heirs or beneficiaries of deceased member borrowers who will file the death benefit application, whose contingency date is on or before the last day of the availment period of the condonation program; and
- For member-borrowers who will pay their consolidated loan under installment basis, their age must be under 65 years old at the end of the installment term.

“We encourage our member-borrowers to avail of our short-term member loan condonation program. With this program, they can update their loans and avoid further accumulation of penalties,” Ignacio added.

Foresight 2050 cited initial courses of actions, as well, one of which is to initiate new maritime-and-archipelagic-oriented programs. Another is to accelerate the gathering of critical mass of STI Human Resources. And to create a separate Philippine Council for Maritime and other Aquatic Resources

Research and Development. The third course of action is strongly suggested by the developers of the Foresight 2050.

Also present during the turnover were Senator Aquilino Pimentel III and Karl Kendrick Chua, Secretary of socio-economic planning and director general of the National Economic and Development Authority (NEDA).

“To attain our 2040 vision of eradicating extreme poverty and becoming a high-income country, we need to continuously innovate and make our systems resilient against

future crisis. To this end it is crucial as it demonstrate our resolve to chart a better future through foresight planning,” Chua said, acknowledging the importance of Foresight in the country’s development.

Several nations like Malaysia, South Korea, and Japan have already adopted foresight into their science technology and innovation or STI planning and institutionalized this concept into their policy-making process.

These countries, Chua added, recognized this need for innovative products and technol-

NCR, most of PH remains under Alert Level 2 until Dec. 15

MANILA – Most of the areas in the country, including Metro Manila, will remain under Alert Level 2 from Dec. 1 to 15 to prevent the entry of new Omicron variant of Covid-19, Malacañang announced in a statement on Monday night.

“The Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) approved on Monday, November 29, 2021 the recommendation to place the National Capital Region under Alert Level 2,” Cabinet Secretary and acting Presidential Spokesperson Karlo Nograles said in a press statement.

Also placed under Alert Level 2 are:

Region 3: Angeles City, Aurora, Bataan, Bulacan, Nueva Ecija, Olongapo City, Pampanga, Zambales, and Tarlac;

Region 4-A: Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, Quezon, and Lucena City;

Region 4-B: Occidental Mindoro, Oriental Mindoro, Puerto Princesa City, Marinduque, Romblon, and Palawan;

Region 5: Albay, Camarines Norte, Camarines Sur, Catanduanes, Sorsogon, Masbate, and Naga City;

Region 6: Aklan, Antique, Bacolod City, Capiz, Guimaras, Iloilo, Iloilo City, and Negros Occidental;

Region 7: Bohol, Cebu, Cebu City, Lapu-Lapu City, Mandaue City, Negros Oriental, and Siquijor;

Region 2: Batanes,

Region 8: Biliran, Eastern Samar, Leyte, Northern Samar, Ormoc City, Southern Leyte, Tacloban City, and Western Samar;

Region 9: City of Isabela, Zamboanga City, Zamboanga del Norte, Zamboanga del Sur, and Zamboanga Sibugay;

Region 10: Bukidnon, Cagayan de Oro City, Camiguin, Iligan City, Lanao del Norte, Misamis Occidental, and Misamis Oriental;

Region 11: Davao City, Davao del Norte, Davao de Oro, Davao del Sur, Davao Occidental, and Davao Oriental;

Region 12: General Santos City, North Cotabato, Sarangani, South Cotabato, and Sultan Kudarat;

Region 13 (Caraga): Butuan City, Surigao del Norte, Agusan del Sur, Surigao del Sur, Dinagat Is-

lands, and Agusan del Norte; and Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao: Basilan, Cotabato City, Tawi-Tawi, Sulu, Lanao del Sur, and Maguindanao.

Meanwhile, the province of Apayao shall be placed under Alert Level 3 from Dec. 1 to 15.

Last Monday, the Department of Health (DOH) reported 665 additional cases of Covid-19—the lowest single-day tally in over 16 months—bringing the total number of cases in the Philippines 2,832,275.

First detected in Botswana, Southern Africa, the Omicron variant has since cropped up in South Africa, Israel, Germany, Italy and Britain, and Hong Kong

tional resources more accessible to the learners through the various media channels used by Knowledge Channel in distributing content for basic education," SEI chief science research specialist, Ruby Cristobal, told the Philippine News Agency (PNA).

She said the partnership was signed on November 29, but the turnover of the first batch of materials will be slated in the coming days.

Among the initial video programs to be turned over are "Radyo Eskwela" and "TuklaSyensya". "Radyo Eskwela" is for elementary students and has 20 episodes, while "TuklaSyensya" has 15 video presentations for high school students.

“Our STEM modules and educational resources will be shown in their (Knowledge Channel) programs and distributed for free in their beneficiary schools,” Cristobal said.

This partnership will help contribute to the SEI's goal of promoting STEM careers and enhancing interest in mathematics and science.

It also aims to improve the students' performance in these areas, she said.

According to SEI, Knowledge Channel develops, acquires, and distributes Department of Education K-12 curriculum-based multimedia learning resources on-air, online, and offline to supplement the effective and relevant delivery of basic education.
