DA projects in Laguna, Quezon to boost food production, reduce poverty

LIPA CITY, Batangas - The Department of Agriculture- Philippine Rural Development Project (DA-PRDP) Regional Project Advisory Board (RPAB) in Calabarzon region has approved two new infrastructure projects in Laguna and Quezon provinces under the Scale-up program.

In an interview, RPAB chairperson Fidel Libao said these projects --a farm-to-market road (FMR) in San Francisco, Quezon and a Level II potable water system in Majayjay, Laguna-- are expected to further develop food production and help reduce poverty once completed.


