2,300 Calabarzon schools reopen for face-to-face classes

CALABARZON – More schools in the Calabarzon region are welcoming back their students following the continuous implementation of the “progressive expansion” phase of face-to-face classes.

The Department of Education (DepEd) Region 4-A said it had given the green light to 2,344 public schools and 24 private schools to hold limited face-to-face classes.

These schools

have passed the standards set under the memorandum order jointly issued by the DepEd and the Department of Health (DOH) for the safe reopening of schools.

Among that have reopened for the limited face-to-face classes include schools from major cities of

Antipolo, Bacoar, Batangas, Biñan, Cabuyao, Calamba, Dasmariñas, Lipa, Lucena, Sta. Rosa.

Some schools from other localities, such as General Trias City and Imus City in Cavite; San Pablo City, Laguna; Tanuan City, Batangas; and Tayabas, Quezon, have also resumed in-person classes after passing the government guidelines.

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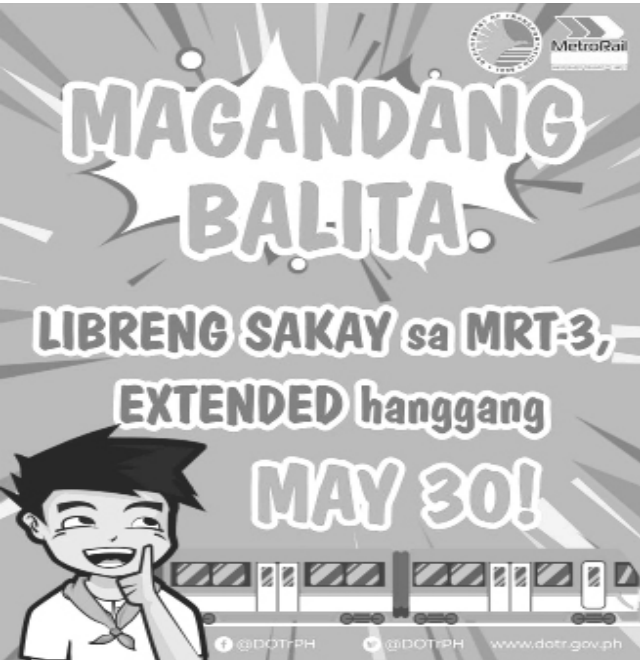

PhilHealth registration needed prior to face-to-face classes

As more colleges and universities gradually resume face-to-face classes, the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) said that registration among studentsin higher education is now beginning to scale up and that they are closely collaborating with various Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) to facilitate the immediate issuance of PhilHealth Identification Number (PIN) to their respective students. This effort is in line with the Commission on Higher Education and Department of Health Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2021- 001, which sets the guidelines on the gradual reopening of HEIs for limited face-to-face classes during the COVID-19 pandemic. The said joint circular requires college students attending the limited face-to-face classes to have the necessary health insurance to cover their medical expenses in case they contract COVID-19. There are two options by which students can be registered under the National Health Insurance Program (NHIP). For students below 21 years old, they can register as dependents

of their biological/foster parents, if not yet registered. This is done by submitting a duly accomplished PhilHealth Member Registration Form (PMRF) together with clear copy of their birth certificate to the nearest PhilHealth office. Meanwhile, students 21 years old and above shall apply either as Direct or Indirect Contributors under the Program. Students with the capacity to pay the contributions shall be registered as Direct Contributors while those belonging to families with no capacity to pay shall register as Indirect Contributors. Students under this category need to secure a Certificate of Indigency from the Local Social Welfare Office where they reside, which is then submitted to PhilHealth together with their filled-out PMRF. Their contributions for the applicable year shall be fully subsidized by the Government through the General Appropriations Act. On the other hand, students who are foreign nationals need to submit acceptable proofs as authorized resident aliens in addition to the PMRF and payment of the prescribed contributions based on PhilHealth Circular No. 2017-0003. PhilHealth reminds the public that registration is free, noting that parents and students should be cautious of online fixers and scammers who offer registration assistance for a fee, which it says is unauthorized. The agency also urged colleges and universities to coordinate with its 22 regional offices and branches for possible in-campus registration arrangements. The State Health Insurer assures Filipino students of immediate eligibility pursuant to the Universal Health Care Law, not only for COVID-19 benefits but for more than 8,000 medical and surgical cases at any accredited healthcare facilities nationwide. ###



Free ride in MRT-3, extended until May 30

MANILA -- To continue providing assistance to the riding public in their commuting needs, the MRT-3 Management and the Department of Transportation (DOTr) have decided to extend for another month the implementation of the FREE RIDE or "LIBRENG SAKAY" program in MRT-3. Passengers will be able to continue enjoying free rides at the rehabilitated MRT-3 line until 30 May 2022, anytime between the rail line's operating hours from 4:40 a.m. and 10:10 p.m. A total of 7,227,434 passengers as of 26 April 2022 have benefitted from the MRT-3 FREE RIDE program, which was launched on 28 March 2022 and set to initially end by 30 April 2022.

DOTr Secretary Art Tugade said the extension of the FREE RIDE program hopes to continue ease the financial burden of commuters amid inflation and rising fuel prices, especially with more workers returning to on-site work. "Gumanda at nagbago ang ridership ng MRT-3. Bago mag-pandemya, 260,000. At bagama't may pandemya, 'yung ridership ay umaabot sa 280,000. 3 OIC-General Manager and Director for Operations Michael J. Capati, the increasing ridership of MRT-3 attributed to the implementation of the FREE RIDE program. The highest single-day ridership was recorded on 8 April 2022 when 335,993 passengers took the MRT-3, a 19.4% increase from the record-high 258,989 ridership logged on 25 March before the FREE RIDE program. The MRT-3 records an average weekday ridership of 250,000 to 300,000 prior to the pandemic. MRT-3 OIC-General Manager Capati added the extension of the FREE RIDE program will further allow the MRT-3 to test its capacity in accommodating up to or more than 350,000 passengers daily.

A Church-labor organization called on voters to consider the labor agenda of candidates as one of the major factors in choosing whom to vote for. The Church People – Workers Solidarity (CWS) said it is important for the public to know the labor programs of the candidates, especially those seeking for national positions. “Voters must consider candidates that prioritize and advance the labor agenda,” said its chairperson Bishop Gerardo Alminaza in his message for this year’s Labor Day. The San Carlos prelate also called on the

nation’s future leaders to remain steadfast in their promise of protecting the rights of workers. He lamented, for instance, how the practice of contractualization remains rampant all over the country despite bold promises of candidates in the past elections to abolish it. Contractualization, he stressed, undermines job security which further results in massive unemployment. “They must immediately scrap anti-labor laws that perpetuate oppression and exploitation and craft more laws that promote and protect the rights and dignity

To augment the rail line’s capacity, the MRT-3 Management will also continue deploying 4-car CKD train sets on the revenue line during peak hours. A 4-car train set can accommodate up to 1,576 passengers.
The MRT-3 Management and its maintenance provider, Sumitomo-MHI-TESP, completed the rehabilitation of the rail line last December 2021. On 22 March 2022, no less than President Rodrigo Duterte led the inauguration of the fully-rehabilitated MRT-3 at the Shaw Boulevard station in Mandaluyong City.
Following its rehabilitation, the MRT-3 now operates at the speed of up to 60 kph from the previous 25 kph. The number of trains have also increased from as few as 15, now up to 23 operational trains. Meanwhile, the headway or the waiting time between trains has been reduced from around 10 minutes to as low as 3.5 minutes.
Under the MRT-3 rehabilitation project, the entire stretch of the line's mainline tracks was replaced and rehabilitated. Also upgraded were the line's power supply, overhead catenary system, rolling stock, communications and signaling system, stations, as well as depot facilities and equipment. (DoTr/MRT3)

Child rights, resolution of cases guaranteed in Family Courts: SC

By Benjamin Pulta/PRESS RELEASE

MANILA – The Supreme Court (SC) on Friday affirmed its commitment to address issues relating to the disposition of child and family cases.

On the 25th anniversary promulgation of the implementing rules of Republic Act 8369 or the Family Courts Act law, Chief Justice Alexander Gesmundo said the judiciary will continue to ensure unhampered access to courts by those who need it most, especially children.

He said the SC will give all the necessary assistance and support to family courts so they can effectively dispense justice and maintain the rule of law when social ills imperil the integrity of the family and rights of the child.

“Today, even as we speak, domestic violence, child abuse and neglect, trafficking of persons and cybercrimes are happening in our midst. We, in the judiciary, cannot close our eyes to these unabated violations of family and child laws,” Gesmundo said in a statement.

The Chief Justice noted that during the pandemic, the judiciary made use of technology so that courts nationwide would continue to function and give attention to cases involving women and children, especially those with applications for protection orders.

He cited decisions which refined family rights, such as the May 11, 2021 ruling in the Tan-Andal versus Andal case, where the tribunal said “psychological incapacity is neither a mental incapacity nor a personality disorder that must be proven through expert opinion”.

Likewise on Dec. 7, 2021 the court revisited the so-called “Iron Curtain Law” and allowed illegitimate children to inherit from blood relatives.

Family Courts have exclusive original jurisdiction to hear and decide on criminal cases where one or more of the accused is below 18 years but not less than nine or where one or more of the victims is a minor at the time of the commission of the offense; petitions for guardianship, custody of children, habeas corpus in relation to the latter; adoption of children and the revocation thereof; complaints for annulment of marriage, declaration of nullity of marriage and those relating to marital status and property relations of husband and wife or those living together under different status and agreements, and petitions for dissolution of conjugal partnership of gains; and petitions for support and/or acknowledgment.

Other cases that should be handled by Family Courts are petitions for declaration of status of children as abandoned, dependent or neglected; voluntary or involuntary commitment of children; suspension, termination or restoration of parental authority; petitions for the constitution of the family home; cases against minors cognizable under the Dangerous Drugs Act; violations of Republic Act No. 7610 (Special Protection of Children Against Child Abuse, Exploitation and Discrimination Act); and domestic violence against women and children.

In cases of violence among immediate family members in the same household, the Family Court may issue a restraining order against the accused or defendant upon a verified ap-

Vaccination Days and also same persons will do, our nurses, midwives, and barangay health workers will roam around the 97 local villages here,” Dr. Mina added.

“Actually during [the] hard lockdown lang naman ito natigil eh, pero kapag nagluwag naman ang Alert Level ay nagpapatuloy ang mga mga bakuna ng mga bata every Wednesdays sa mga health centers, kaya

nga lang, takot ang mga nanay sa Covid kaya ‘di rin nila nadadala ang mga babies kahit open ang mga health centers,” Dr. Mina pointed out.

“Our vaccination team in the communities in our city delivers catch-up immunization to infants ages 0-23 months. At the same time, on the aforementioned days, our #BidaAngMayBakuna COVID-19 vaccination will be temporarily stopped at the health centers of Ve-

larde, Plaridel, and Greengate to make way for the program. COVID-19 vaccinations for the general population and pediatric population can still be done on Mondays and Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays,” said Dr. Mina.
