ORDER

The newspaper "CAVITE NGAYON", represented by its publisher Bayani N. Zoleta, filed a petition dated September 20, 2018, praying for the renewal of its accreditation to publish legal and judicial notices issued by the Regional Trial Court of Cavite City.

It appears that "CAVITE NGAYON" had been previously granted accreditation to publish legal and judicial notices as per Order dated July 2, 2013 issued by Executive Judge Agapito S. Lu; that pursuant to Supreme Court A.M. No. 01-1-07 dated October 16, 2001 re: "Guidelines in the Accreditation of Newspapers and Periodicals in the Distribution of Legal Notices and Advertisements for Publication", said accreditation is valid only for a period of five (5) years, unless sooner revoked and/or suspended in accordance with Section 16 of said Guidelines.

Finding merit in this petition for re-accreditation and since "CAVITE NGAYON" has complied with all the requirements set forth in S.C. Administrative Matter No. 01-1-07, the same is hereby **GRANTED**.

WHEREFORE, "CAVITE NGAYON" is hereby re-accredited and authorized to participate in the weekly raffle of legal and judicial notices issued by this Court.

This accreditation shall be valid for a period of five (5) years from date hereof, unless sooner suspended or revoked in accordance with said circular.
