



2 drug peddlers killed, P1.5-B shabu seized in Cavite

MANILA – Two drug suspects were killed while two others were arrested in separate operations in Cavite on Thursday (Sept 9) night that yielded around PHP1.5 billion worth of shabu.

In a report on Friday, Brig. Gen. Remus Medina, chief of the Philippine National Police Drug Enforcement Group (PNP-DEG), said suspects Basher Bangon and Danilo Untavar, were killed during the buy-bust in Springville Executive 1, Barangay Molino 3, Bacoor City at around 9:30

p.m.

Seized from the operation were 181 kilograms of shabu worth PHP1.25 billion.

Bangon, who is a top-level drug personality, had direct contact with a Chinese drug syndicate and is mainly operating in areas in the Visayas and Mindanao.

Meanwhile, suspects Lani Micoleta and Aldwin Micoleta were arrested in a separate operation in Barangay Magdalo, Bahayang Pag-Asa, Imus, City at 9:15 p.m.

The suspects yielded more or less 48 kilos of shabu valued at PHP331.2 million. They are among cohorts of Bangon and are known distributors of illegal drugs in Metro Manila and Calabarzon.

The suspects will be charged with violation of Republic Act 9165 or the Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002.

In a statement, PNP chief, Gen. Guillermo Eleazar said the two police operations were part of the follow-up operations in Zambales and Bataan on

Tuesday, which resulted in the confiscation of close to PHP4 billion worth of shabu.

The operations resulted in the death of four Chinese drug suspects and the arrest of three others. source(PNA)



Hybrid world tourism summit in PH moved to 2022

MANILA – The Philippines is set to host the World Travel & Tourism Council (WTTC) Global Summit in the first quarter of 2022, Tourism Secretary Bernadette Romulo-Puyat said Thursday.

The event was supposed to be held in the Philippines in October 2021.

Romulo-Puyat said hosting the event would not only strengthen Manila's position as a competitive meetings, incentives, conferences & exhibitions (MICE) destination in Asia, but also serve as a "major stepping stone"

towards the full recovery of the country's travel and tourism industry.

"We are proud to share that the Philippines has been chosen to host the 21st World Travel and Tourism Council Global Summit, which is targeted to take place in the first quarter of 2022," she said during the Hotel Outlook: The Road Back to Business forum.

Tourism Assistant Secretary Verna Buensuceso said around 650 delegates are expected to attend the event, with over 30,000 people participating virtually.

"We're looking at the first quarter of 2022 because we would like to make sure that international borders are a bit easier to navigate so that we get to have more people coming in," she said in the same forum.

The WTTC Global Summit is widely considered the most influential event for travel and tourism professionals and stakeholders, providing opportunities for industry leaders to meet with policymakers and address the most pressing issues faced by the industry.

International tourists

While borders remain closed due to a rise in coronavirus cases, Buensuceso said the department continues to work with partner agencies for the country's eventual reopening to foreign leisure travelers, especially those fully vaccinated.

She said the agency was specifically looking at Asian markets like South Korea, Taiwan and Japan for "specialized charters" that would bring in various tour groups straight into destinations.

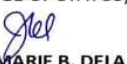

REVILLA NAGPAHAYAG NG SUPORTA NA ITAAS ANG EDAD NG STATUTORY RAPE

Co-sponsor ka-makailan si Sen. Ramon Bong Revilla, Jr. sa Senate Bill 2332 na naglalay-ong itaas ang edad para madetermina ang statu-tory rape at iba pang akto ng pang-aabuso at ex-ploitation, mula labingda-lawa hanggang labing-an-im na taon.

Si Revilla na isa sa may akda ng naturang panukala ay isinumite ang Senate Bill 1258 upa-ng maisama sa ilalim ng Committee Report 279 ng Senate Committee on Justice and Human Rights.

Sa kaniyang sponsorship speech, sinabi ng butihing Senador na noong nakaraang bu-wan lumaganap ang kam-panyang #ENDChildRape sa social media na nilahu-kan ng ilang celebrities at advocates na nananawa-gan sa mga mambabatas na bigyang prayoridad ang pagsusumite ng bat-as na mag-aamyenda sa Anti-Rape Law of 1997 at palakasin ang proteksi-yon sa mga bata laban sa pang-aabusong sekswal at exploitation.

CAVITE PNP MADE 43 ARRESTS IN DAILY ANTI-CRIMINALITY OPERATIONS AND RECORDED 8,170 MECQ VIOLATORS

Camp BGen Pantaleon Garcia, Imus City, Cavite – Cavite Police Provincial Office arrested 43 individuals in Daily Anti-Criminality Drive and recorded 8,170 MECQ violators over the last 24 hours.

In the campaign against illegal drugs, nineteen (19) individuals were arrested in 6 buy-busts and 4 other drug related operations in Cavite City, Bacoor City, General Trias City, Trece Martires City, GMA, Naic, Noveleta, Carmona, GMA, and confiscated a total of 33 pieces of small heat-sealed transparent plastic sachets containing white crystalline substance suspected as

shabu, 11 SHTPS of dried leaves suspected as Marijuana, drug money, 1 unit of Norinco caliber .45 pistol with 1 piece of magazine and 1 live ammunition, 1 unit of caliber .38 loaded with 4 pieces of live ammunitions, 1 set of playing cards, and other drug paraphernalia.

On the campaign against wanted persons, Cavite Police arrested seven (7) other wanted person by virtue of warrant of arrest for the crime of RA 9165 (Dangerous Drug Act of 2002) in Carmona; Violation of RA 9262 (Violence against Women and Children) in Tagaytay City; Attempted Murder in General Trias

City; Attempted Homicide in Imus City; RIR in Damaged to Properties in Bacoor City; and Qualified Trespass to Dwelling in Dasmariñas City.

In the campaign against illegal gambling, Cavite Police arrested three (3) individuals while playing illegal card games “Tongits” in Rosario, Cavite.

Fourteen (14) suspects involved in various cases were arrested for the crime of Frustrated Homicide in Bacoor City; Road Crash incident (RIR to Physical Injuries and Damage to Property) in Kawit, Cavite; Theft (shoplifting) in Imus City; Theft and Trespass



to Dwelling in Dasmariñas City; Oral Defamation in Tanza; Alarms and Scandal in General Trias City.

On the implementation of Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine, a total of 8,170 were recorded comprising the following data; 1,054 of them violated no face masks, 1,449 wore improper face masks, 3,209 without face shields, 1,862 wore improper face shields, 230 violated the social distancing, and 366 violated the curfew hours. Cavite Police gave warning to 8,127 violators, 38 paid fines, and 5 were charged for other offenses.

Cavite Police continuously strengthen its efforts in crime prevention program and anti-criminality operations to lessen crime incidents in crime prone areas in the province. (Cavite PIO)

Japan agri agency wants to build cold storage facility in Benguet



MANILA – A solar-powered cold storage facility in Buguias, Benguet will help Filipino farmers improve their production.

The Japan Agricultural Exchange Council (JAEC) proposed the solar-powered facility that will include the purchase of refrigerated cooling trucks, to improve post-harvest handling, storage, and delivery of farmers’ produce.

The proposed PHP82-million project will be funded by Japan’s Ministry of Foreign Affairs under its Safe Vegetable Produc-

tion with Marketing Technology Improvement project in the Philippines.

The proposal is under review by the National Economic and Development Authority, according to the Department of Agriculture (DA) on Tuesday.

It will go through the Department of Finance and the Department of Foreign Affairs before being approved by the Office of the President.

"[This is] aimed to capacitate farmers to improve production through the Safe Vegetable from Rich Soil (SAVERS) technology, which enriches the soil by using organic matter such as mokusaku (wood vinegar)," the DA said on Tuesday, referring to the details of its discussion with JAEC the day before.

Once approved, a memorandum of agreement will be drafted and signed by the DA and JAEC.

In a statement, JAEC senior local coordinator Toshihiro Sato said he wishes to have the project implemented at the soonest possible time, as “many Filipino farmers are waiting for [the] project”.

DA Secretary William Dar is hoping for its approval before the end of the Duterte administration.

He called for the creation of a steering committee to facilitate the approval process.

The DA chief also instructed JAEC representatives to review its procurement process and to prepare the project design for immediate implementation once approved. (PNA)

Inanunsyo ng Cavitex Infrastructure Corporation (CIC), isang subsidiary ng Metro Pacific Tollways Corporation (MPTC), kasama ang Joint Venture (JV) partner nito na Philippine Reclamation Authority (PRA), ang 20% completion rate ng Cavitex C5 Link na nakatakdang matapos sa 4th quarter ng 2022.

Ang Cavitex C5 Link ay isang 7.7-kilometer 2x3 lane expressway na magkokonekta sa Cavitex R1 patungo sa C5 Road sa Taguig.

Ito ay P15-bilyon project na binubuo ng Segments 2 at 3. Simula pa taong 2019, bukas na sa motorista ang Segment 3A-1 (Merville to C5 Road); habang ang Segments 3A-2 (E. Rodriguez to Merville) at Segment 2 (R1 Interchange to Sucat Interchange) ay patuloy na kinukumpuni. Ang Segment 3B (Sucat to E. Rodriguez) naman ayon sa CIC, ay sisismulang gawin sa 1st quarter ng 2022.

MANILA – Presidential Communications Operations Office (PCOO) Secretary Martin Andanar said on Thursday that improving the operations of the PCOO and its attached agencies in terms of broadcasting and information dissemination has made the President visible to the public.

Filipinos to tune in to their social media pages for real-time updates on the current situation that the country is facing.
