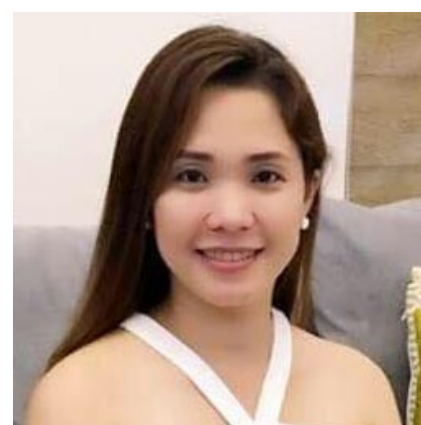


LGU Trece Martires goes digital for New Normal government system

Tax, Real Property Tax, Birth Certificate, Cedula, Local Civil Registry, Occupational Rents and Health Certificate, and other payments.

Angara bats for the naturalization of Angelo Kouame

Senator Sonny Angara has endorsed the proposed entry of Angelo Kouame to Gilas Pilipinas with the filing of a bill calling for the grant of Philippine citizenship to the standout from the Ivory Coast.

Angara, who is chairman of the Samahang Basketbol ng Pilipinas (SBP), filed Senate Bill 1892 last Thursday as part of the country's ongoing efforts to build up its national team in time for the 2023 World Cup.

Senate Bill 1892 is a counterpart of House Bill 5951 filed by SBP vice chairman, Antipolo City Rep. Robbie Puno.

"We have seen what Kouame has accomplished as a member of the Ateneo Blue Eagles in the past three years and his game continues to develop. We have not seen the full potential of Kouame yet and his desire to continue developing his game here in the Philippines is something that is worth supporting," Angara said.

"Ange has also shown a strong desire to continue living in the Philippines, which has been his home since 2016. I have no doubt he will provide an invaluable contribution to Philippine hoops for many years to come," he added.

At age 20, Kouame is expected to be part of the pool of naturalized players of Gilas Pilipinas and should be available to play for the national squad until he turns pro.

Standing at a little under 7 feet, Kouame averaged 12.5 points, 11.8 rebounds, 2.9 blocks and 1.4 assists a game in Season 82 of the UAAP, which saw a 16-0 sweep by Ateneo.

This is not the first time that the Philippines has sought

Southeast Asian center intensifies development support to Laguna province

LOS BAÑOS, Laguna (PIA) --The Southeast Asian Regional Center for Graduate Study and Research in Agriculture (SEARCA) has formalized its ties with the Provincial Government of Laguna (PGL) this month to jointly pursue capacity development activities and exchange knowledge resources, including publications.

Laguna Governor Ramil L. Hernandez said SEARCA's focus on scientific inquiry, agricultural extension, and rural development is vital to Laguna's growth and development.

"We believe that SEARCA has the technical knowledge and skills to address the plight of our community. The Provincial Government of Laguna is willing to participate," he said.

This was affirmed by Congresswoman Ruth Mariano Hernandez of the Second District of Laguna, who said "we are looking forward for an open-collaboration to help our farming communities here in Laguna to add yield on their crops especially with your research on rice fortified with iron and zinc."

SEARCA Director Glenn B. Gregorio said the partnership with the Province of Laguna is an essential move to help the farmers and farming communities in the province.

Moreover, SEARCA also began a community gardens project in Los Baños, Laguna to help flower farmers in Brgy. Bayog, a major aster-growing area, to shift to growing good-quality food for their consumption and as an alternative source of income now that there is little demand for aster because of the COVID-19 pandemic.

In a launch event attended by Los Baños government officials led by Mayor Cesar Perez, SEARCA turned over seeds, fertilizer, and other farm inputs to Marcelino Aragon, Gerardo Banasihan, and Salvador Tordacilla, the three aster farmers involved in the project.

"As a post-crisis strategy, the project will be piloted on three farm lots sized 3,800 sq.m., 2,800 sq.m., and 2,000 sq.m. with a grant provided through the SEARCA Grants for Research towards Agricultural Innovative Solutions (GRAINS)," said Dr. Rico C. Ancog, SEARCA Emerging Innovation for Growth program lead.

"SEARCA will also provide technical support in terms of land and site preparation, planning the community garden design, and setting up and monitoring of the community garden," Dr. Ancog said. (PIA-4A/SEARCA)

IMUS, Cavite (PIA) ---Celebrating the elderly's role and contributions highlighted the Senior Citizens' Week, featuring the programs and projects launched by the city government.

The pilot episode of the Mayor Emmanuel L. Maliksi's (ELM) Facebook Live featured Ms. Luzviminda 'Minda' Elbinias, President of the Imus Senior Citizens Association, Inc. (IMUSCAI) as discussant.

Among these programs was the EON ImusCAI,

a membership card that also serves as a debit card where cash subsidies from the LGU will be credited directly and used to pay for transactions in groceries, supermarkets, and drugstores.

CALABARZON RDC prepares its communities for BP2 Program

On October 23, 2020, the CALABARZON Regional Development Council's Balik Probinsya, Bagong Pag-asa (BP2) Committee held its first meeting via videoconference to prepare the Region-

al BP2 Action Plan. The plan will guide the region in planning, implementing, and monitoring programs and projects that will develop communities to become a highly-livable environment for immediate re-

catees and voluntary migrants in the medium to long-term period.

Opening the meeting, NEDA Regional Director and BP2 Vice-Chairperson Luis G. Banua emphasized that the purpose of the BP2 Program is to ensure balanced regional development and improve quality of life in the countryside. While CALABARZON has one of the lowest number of BP2 applicants across regions, Dir. Banua mentioned the need to plan ahead to prepare the receiving LGUs and allocate the needed resources for the program.

Representing DILG Secretary Eduardo M. Año who is the region's Officer for Regional Development and Security (CORDS), Undersecretary Epimaco V. Densing

III highlighted that the action planning activity is an important first step in implementing the BP2 Program. With the Action Plan, the region will be able to assess its capacities to accept new residents from highly-urbanized cities. Undersecretary Densing also underscored that the BP2 Program, unlike past programs, is envisioned to address the perennial problem on urban congestion and is meant to be a long-term and sustainable program. Thus, he called for the active involvement of all stakeholders to ensure the effective planning and implementation of the BP2 program.

Part of the program was a workshop on the preparation of BP2 Action Plan which yielded initial programs

112 ARRESTS MADE BY CAVITE POLICEIN DAILY ANTI-CRIMINALITY AND QUARANTINE OPERATIONS

Camp BGen Pantaleon Garcia, Imus City, Cavite- Cavite Police Provincial Office under the leadership of PCOL MARLON R SANTOS, Provincial Director arrested 30 individuals in an overnight anti-criminality campaigns and recorded 82 Community Quarantine Violators from October 23.-24, 2020.

Out of 4 police operations executed against wanted persons, 4 were arrested by virtue of warrant of arrest for the crime of Grace Coercion, RIR in Damage to Property, Failure to Appear in Court for the crime of RA 9995 Anti-Photo and Video Voyeurism, and crime in the

use of Falsified Document.

On eight operations conducted against illegal drugs, 21 drug personalities were arrested in Cavite City, GMA, Tagaytay City, Bacoor City and General Trias City and confiscated a total of 54 pieces of small heat-sealed transparent plastic sachets of shabu.

Five individuals were arrested after they involved in crime incidents in Magallanes for hacking, in Dasma for Theft, in Kawit for Violation of Article 281 of RPC, and in Bacoor City for Theft.

Cavite Police accosted 82 MGCQ Violators for not wearing face mask, no

quarantine pass, violation of social distancing and violation of curfew hours.

The arrested suspects were apprised of their Constitutional Rights provided in the Miranda Rule and RA 9745 (Anti-Torture Act of 2009) and were brought to the stations to prepare criminal charges for Inquest Proceedings to be filed before the Office of the Provincial Prosecutor.

PCOL Santos said that Cavite Police will sustain the momentum and work hand-in-hand to bring their anti-criminality efforts successful to encourage a progressive community to live, work, sustain and do business. (Cavite PIO)

Filipinos sweep South east Asian 'Youth COVDeo Contest'

CALAMBA CITY, Laguna, (PIA) --Three Filipinos won the top prizes of the Youth COVDeo Contest of the Southeast Asian Regional Center for Graduate Study and Research in Agriculture (SEARCA). Their videos bested 72 other entries from five countries.

The contest aimed to showcase how the youth played a part in local food production during the COVID-19 pandemic as part of SEARCA's Young Forces for Agricultural Innovation (#Y4AGRI) program.

Themed "Youth and Locally Grown Food," the contest sought video stories from Southeast Asian youth on how and why young people grow their food at home, in school or in the community during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Frontliner-turned-farmer Marcelino Padilla of Northern Samar bagged the top prize with his story of how he transitioned from being a nurse to pursuing his passion for farming. His winning video shows his re-

markable journey and skill in practicing and promoting environmentally friendly, circular, and zero waste integrated farming system. At the onset of the community quarantine, he germinated his reserved seeds and distributed seedlings to neighboring communities together with the members of 4-H Club, a youth organization. His video also showcased the benefits of home gardening to his family and how he encouraged the youth in his community to engage in agricultural activities during the pandemic.

The second prize went to Myka Fragata of Nueva Vizcaya, who, along with her sister, told the story of Ara-paap Farm, her family's passion project during the quarantine period. To ensure food and nutrition security for their family and community amid the COVID-19 crisis, they developed an idle land into a productive vegetable garden within three months. Her video gives a quick rundown of starting and sustaining a family farm.

Mr. Benson Cariña-ga, a son of Albay, won both the third prize and the Popularity Award for the entry that garnered the most Facebook reactions. His video features the communal garden of Tinago Youth Volunteers (TYV) which was established during the community quarantine to promote local food security. His video shows TYV members providing practical tips in growing vegetables, composting, and harvesting.

The entries were evaluated by multimedia experts, agriculturists, and SEARCA experts and officials.

The top three winners and other finalists in the top 10 received cash prizes. A smart tablet was the prize for the Popularity Award.

"We are happy to see through your videos the different practices in growing food with your family and friends, and in promoting youth engagement in your community through productive activities in agriculture amidst the pandemic," said SEARCA Director Glenn B. Gregorio during

DOLE to roll out 'free bikes project' for informal workers

MANILA – Around 900 informal sector workers who were displaced due to the coronavirus disease (Covid-19) pandemic are set to benefit from the initial rollout of the "free bicycles project" of the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE).

"We will be giving free bicycles, which is called 'free bisikleta (bicycles) project' since many of us are patronizing on-line delivery services. This is the reason for the concept of the project," Ma. Karen Trayvilla, director of the DOLE Bureau of Workers with Special Concerns (BWSC), said in a Laging Handa briefing on Thursday.

Under the program, beneficiaries would be tapped as riders providing food and non-food delivery services.

Trayvilla said they will start giving free bicycles in four cities in Metro Manila and in four regional offices.

"Starting Monday (October 26) to Wednesday (October 28), we will be awarding, it will be held at the DOLE. We will also be joined by the launching by the local government of Mandaluyong, Muntinlupa, Pasig, and Manila. The DOLE regional offices in Region 2 (Cagayan Valley), 3 (Central Luzon), 4-A (Calabarzon), and 5 (Bicol) will also join. So we will be giving a total of 900 free bikes for the initial implementation of this project," she said.

She added that they are also looking to include Cebu and other regional offices in the country.

"Perhaps by next month or December, we will also give free bicycles in Cebu and to our other regional offices," Trayvilla said. (PNA)

Aside from the bicycles, recipients would also receive cellphone and e-loading wallet. Also included in the package are an isolation bag, helmet, reflectorized vest, and bicycle rack.

Applicants are advised to go to the DOLE field office



or Public Employment Service Office (PESO) to avail of the program.

Trayvilla said applicants would undergo profiling and those who would qualify would be given a "social preparation training".

"In this training, the MMDA (Metropolitan Manila Development Authority) would provide training on traffic regulations. On the business side, the Regional Tripartite Wages and Productivity Board would provide training and productivity and financial literacy. In terms of occupational health and safety standards, we have tapped the DOLE's Occupational Health and Safety Center," she added.

Trayvilla said they have also enrolled the project's beneficiaries into a "group personal accident insurance" program of the Government Service Insurance System. (PNA)

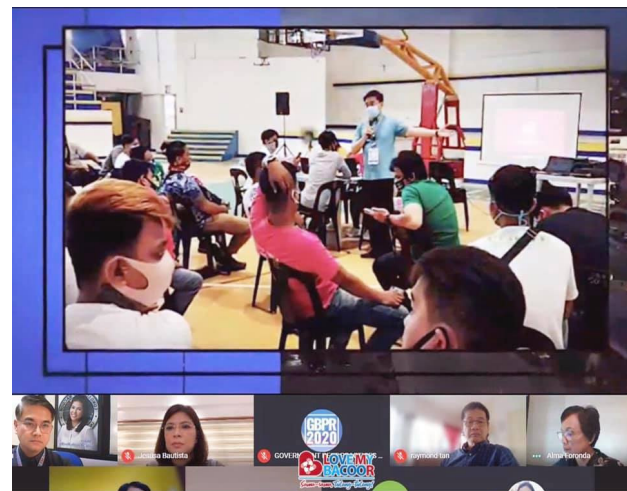

DTI releases new guidelines for malls and commercial spaces

MANILA (PIA) – As the country slowly opens up economic activities, the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) released the Guidelines on “Easing of Control Measures in Mall and Commercial Centers Upon Strict Implementation of the Seven Commandments” Memorandum Circular (MC) 20-55.

On October 22, the MC enumerates the seven commandments that should be strictly implemented in commercial spaces namely: (1) wearing of proper face masks; (2) wearing of face shields; (3) no talking and no eating in public transportation and confined or crowded areas; (4) provision of adequate ventilation; (5) frequent and proper disinfection; (6) isolation of symptomatic or COVID-19 positives; and (7) appropriate physical distancing.

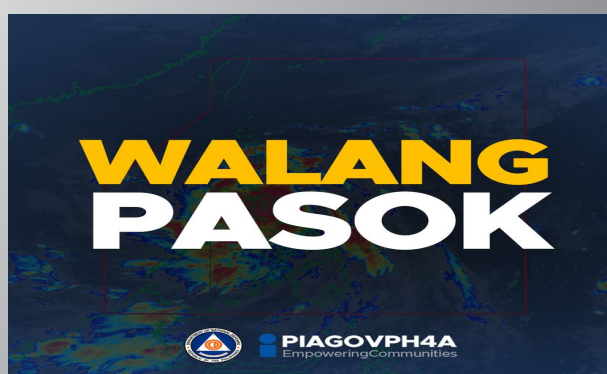

3 suspects yield P88-M shabu in Cavite buy-bust

MANILA – Authorities have seized more than PHP88 million worth of shabu and arrested three suspects in separate operations in Bacoor City, Cavite over the weekend, the Philippine National Police (PNP) said..

In a presser in Camp Crame, PNP chief, Gen. Camilo Cascolan, identified the suspects as Javier Mala, 43; Bino Sampaco, 43; and Mira-ato Macarampat, 27, who were arrested by the PNP Drug Enforcement Group.

Sampaco and Mala yielded around five kilograms of shabu worth PHP34 million during the operation in Barangay Molino 2 on Sunday morning.

At around noon on the same day, a follow-up operation in Barangay Mambog 2, also in Bacoor City, led to the arrest of Macarampat. Authorities recovered from him around eight kilograms of shabu worth PHP54.4-million
