

GCQ status in Cavite extended until July 31

PASAY CITY -- President Rodrigo Roa Duterte approved the extension of the General Community Quarantine (GCQ) in the National Capital Region (NCR) and part of Region 4-A starting July 16, 2021 until July 31, 2021.

Also under GCQ from July 16, 2021 to July 31, 2021 are Baguio City and Apayao in the Cordillera Administrative Region; City of Santiago, Isabela, Nueva Vizcaya and Quirino in Region 2; Bulacan in Region 3; Cavite, Rizal, Quezon and Batangas in Region 4-A; Puerto Princesa in Region 4-B; Guimaras and Negros Occidental in Region 6; Zamboanga Sibugay, City of Zamboanga and Zam-

boanga del Norte in Region 9; Davao Oriental in Region 11; General Santos City, Sultan Kudarat, Sarangani, Cotabato and South Cotabato in Region 12; Agusan del Norte, Surigao del Norte, Agusan del Sur, Dinagat Islands, and Surigao del Sur in CARAGA; and Cotabato City in BARMM.

Cagayan in Region 2; Laguna and Lucena City in Region 4-A; Naga City in Region 5; Negros Oriental in Region 7; Zamboanga del Sur in Region 9; and Davao City in Region 11 will be under GCQ with heightened restrictions from July 16, 2021 until July 31, 2021. *Aklan, Bacolod City, Antique, and Capiz in Region 6 shall also

be placed under GCQ with heightened restrictions until 22 July 2021.*

Meanwhile, Bataan in Region 3; Cagayan de Oro City in Region 10; Davao Occidental, Davao de Oro, Davao del Sur, and Davao del Norte in Region 11; and Butuan City in CARAGA will be under Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine (MECQ) beginning July 16, 2021 until July 31, 2021. *Iloilo City and Iloilo in Region 6 shall also be placed under MECQ but only until 22 July 2021.*All other areas in the country will be placed under Modified General Community Quarantine (MGCQ) from July 16, 2021 until July 31, 2021. MANILA - Senator Francis 'Tol' N. Tolentino is pushing for the gradual resumption of face-to-face classes in low-risk island provinces in the country for the upcoming opening of school year in September amid the current global coronavirus pandemic.

In an interview with ANC's Headstart on Tuesday, Tolentino stressed that island provinces such as Guimaras,

PhilHealth releases guidelines
for COVID-19 vaccine injury
and death compensation

The Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) recently announced its compensation package for those who will develop serious adverse effects (SAEs) following inoculation for COVID-19 that will lead to hospitalization, permanent disability or death. The said package and its guidelines are contained in its PhilHealth Circular No. 2021-0007 published on June 18, 2021.

In a recent media forum of the Department of Health, the state health insurer said that the compensation package is only available to those who received COVID-19 jabs through the Philippine COVID-19 Vaccination Program.

The package is capped at P100,000 for hospitalizations to cover remaining charges after deduction of PhilHealth benefits, mandatory discounts, and other coverage provided by private health insurance companies and health management organizations (HMOs).

Similarly, a lump sum of P100,000 per beneficiary in case of permanent disability or death. However, PhilHealth clarified that it will cover patients who received inoculations through other initiatives, especially in the private sector, if the vaccines were sourced from the country's Philippine COVID-19 Vaccination Program.

The compensation covers claims filed from March 3, 2021 to March 2, 2026 or until completion of the vaccination program, whichever comes first. Those who will avail of this package must have had at least one vaccine received through the said Vaccination Program.

In addition, it must also be established that the vaccine does not have a Certificate of Product Registration at the time of inoculation; the beneficiary has not received compensation from COVAX no-fault compensation program; and the result of the causality assessment must be "vaccine product-related reaction" or vaccine quality defect-related reaction".

Hospitalization benefits can be availed of more than once if the cap of P100,000 has not been reached yet. However, coverage for permanent disability or death can only be claimed once.

Among the requirements for compensation claims for hospitalization are proof of COVID-19 vaccination (vaccine card or slip); vaccine injury assessment survey; statement of account; medical certificate; and official receipt indicating deductions of PhilHealth benefits, private insurers/HMOs, and out-of-pocket expenses.

Other supporting documents such as duly signed physical examination report describing the disabling manifestation or death certificate should also be included for permanent disability and death claims, respectively.

The LRT-1 Cavite Extension UPDATE



The LRT-1 Cavite Extension was first approved by the NEDA Investment

Coordination Committee on August 25, 2000. It was first given the green light by the NEDA Board on January 22, 2002.

Right of Way (ROW) acquisition started in 2007, with Congress giving budget for the project. Based on the 4th attempt to implement the project and its 3rd NEDA Board approval in 2013, ROW acquisition for Phase 1 should have been completed in April 2015, Phase 2 in August 2015, and Phase 3 in March 2016.

substantial phenolic and flavonoid content.

He added that the antioxidant content and activities of the blanched berry samples registered higher than the unprocessed and steamed berries.

The second project component, "Philippine Indigenous Berries: In Vivo Studies on Toxicity and Effects on Biomarkers of Obesity and Associated Metabolic Disorders (Dyslipidemia, Inflammation, and Oxidative Stress" has been probing the in vivo oral toxicity of Philippine indigenous berries such as big-nay and lipote, and the effects of these berries on biomarkers of obesity and associated metabolic disorders including dyslipidemia, inflammation and oxidative stress in vivo.

"Upon investigation of the nutritional content, lipote contains high amounts of vitamins C and E, minerals (boron, calcium, chromium, copper, iron, potassium, magnesium, manganese, nickel, lead, and zinc) per 100 grams of freeze-dried sample," de la Peña said.

Phytochemical screening showed presence of cardiac glycosides, coumarins, flavonoids, phenols, phlobatannins, quinones, terpenoids, and saponin, he added.

Acute and sub-chronic toxicity were also examined. The big-nay varieties and lipote were fed to animal models, and no clinical and behavioral signs of toxicity were observed," according to de la Peña.

"It was observed that repeated oral administrations of freeze-dried duhat and lipote fruits for 28 days are safe for consumption. The project team is still completing the nutritional property evaluation and efficacy studies against metabolic syndrome," he said.

Over PHP13 million was allocated for the second project component.

"(After completing the project, researchers would) publish the findings, file for IP (intellectual property) where applicable, and present (the results) to different conferences/fora," Tamayo said.

Tamayo added that they have informed the researchers that they could apply for product development funding.

four waste nets erected along various rivers in CALABARZON as of June 30, 2021.

Cynthia N. Rozaldo, DENR-MB-SCM04 Deputy Regional Coordinator, said trash traps were first installed in 2014 along the Imus River in Dasmariñas, Cavite, and the Hinulugang Taktak River in Antipolo, Rizal.

In 2018, four trash traps were built along the Labac River in Naic, Cavite, and two along the San Diego River in Nagcarlan.

In addition, from 2019 to June this year, 74 trash traps and waste nets were installed through the DENR province and community offices as part of the Manila Bay Rehabilitation Program and another 11 trash traps are scheduled to be installed in the coming months.

DENR CALABARZON Regional Executive Director Nilo B. Tamoria is urging local governments to remain engaged in ensuring that solid waste management is priority and waterways are protected from various causes of contamination.

He also encouraged people to stop tossing trash anywhere because it will eventually end up in the streams and the seas.

beneficiaries that they may visit any of the 26 Malasakit Centers across Metro Manila out of the 129 established nationwide if they may need any assistance for their hospital bills.

The Malasakit Centers Act of 2019 was principally authored and sponsored by Go in the Senate. resume its face-to-face classes for students while still abiding with existing minimum health protocol guidelines by the Inter-Agency Taskforce (IATF).

According to Tolentino, there should be selected areas across the archipelago wherein face-to -face classes should be allowed and should not solely rely on the current blended learning curriculum being imposed by the Department of Education (DepEd), noting that distance learning modality—a combination of online and modular learning—isn’t effective at all, considering the current connectivity problem of the country’s telcos.

Education Sec. Leonor Briones last Friday announced that school year 2021-2022 will start on September 13, amid the existing threat of the global pandemic and the emerging Delta variant strain of the COVID-19 virus which has badly affected neighboring Southeast Asian countries.

The senator said that since some teachers are already vaccinated, the national government should explore the possibility of allowing the gradual resumption of face-to-face classes in those safe and low-risk areas.
